AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING VARIOUS PROVISIONS OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATED TO (A) THE NAME CHANGE OF THE HUMAN SERVICES AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; (B) AMENDED FUNCTIONS OF THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; AND (C) CLERICAL CHANGES TO UPDATE REFERENCES TO THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT AND HOUSING DEPARTMENT

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. This ordinance, due to its length and corresponding cost of publication, will be published by title and summary as permitted by Section 508 of the Pasadena City Charter. The approved summary of this ordinance is as follows:

"Summary

This ordinance amends the Pasadena Municipal Code to amend various provisions of the Pasadena Municipal Code related to (a) the name change of the Human Services and Recreation Department to the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department; (b) amended functions of the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department; and (c) clerical changes to update references to the Planning Department and Housing Department.

Ordinance no. _____ shall take effect upon publication."

SECTION 1. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 1.26 (Administrative Penalties – Citations), Section 1.26.120 (Appointment of administrative hearing officer) is amended as follows:

"The planning and permitting department director or his or her designee shall select an administrative hearing officer. The administrative hearing officer may be, without

limitation, a member of the staff of the department through which the administrative citation was issued. In no event, however, shall the enforcement official who issued the administrative citation be the administrative hearing officer."

SECTION 2. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 2.55 (Code Enforcement Commission), Section 2.55.140 (Hearing Procedures), subdivision (C), first sentence, is amended as follows:

"Whenever in the course of any proceeding taken hereunder, the commission shall require additional evidence, it may request that the premises be inspected by the planning, housing and development services department, fire department or the health officer."

SECTION 3. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 2.75 (Historic Preservation Commission), Section 2.75.045 (Duties), subdivisions (e) and (i) are amended as follows:

- "(e) Review and make recommendations on environmental reports, zone changes, master development plans, planned developments and other land use entitlements as requested by the director of planning **and development** and as they are applicable to historic resources in the city;
- (i) Assign, at its discretion, duties for administration of this title to the director of planning **and development**."

SECTION 4. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 2.80 (Design Commission), Section 2.80.060, third and fourth sentences, is amended as follows:

". . . The director of planning, housing and development services or his designee shall act as the nonvoting secretary to the commission. The city council, through the planning <u>department</u>, housing and development services, shall provide the commission with adequate staff to perform the duties prescribed in this chapter."

SECTION 5. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 2.265 (Human Services and

Recreation Department), is amended as follows:

"Chapter 2.265 – Human Services and Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Department

2.265.010 - Created - Direction.

There is created a functional unit of city government known as the human services and parks, recreation and community services department, under the general administration of the city manager, which shall be under the direction and control of the director of human services and parks, recreation and community services.

2.265.020 – Department Functions

The department shall:

- A. Facilitate collaborative efforts and a coordinated approach to improve and expand the delivery of quality **human-community** services in the city;
- B. Administer various programs in the city designed to protect, improve and restore the personal welfare and well-being of city residents of all ages;
- C. Develop strategies to respond to unmet **human-community** service needs and gaps within the city;
- D. Provide staff services and support to <u>the accessibility and disability commission</u>, <u>the human relations commission</u>, the human services commission, <u>the northwest commission</u>, the recreation and parks commission, the commission on the status of women, and the senior commission;
- E. Coordinate with public and private sectors to address the social and economic needs of the residents of the city;
- F. Operate and maintain all parks (including park areas, park improvements, and facilities), the grounds in the civic center, the grounds of the public library and all branch libraries, and such city-owned property as shall be provided by ordinance or as directed by the city manager;
- G. Operate and maintain the Arroyo Seco, including Hahamongna Watershed Park, Brookside Park, and the Lower Arroyo, and provide administrative coordination of programs and other major activities in the Arroyo;
- H. Plant, maintain and remove trees and shrubs within all parks, as described in subdivision (F)) and the Arroyo Seco, as described in subdivision (G);
- **IF**. Operate community and recreation services programs for the city consistent with the city charter, ordinances and administrative policy;
- **<u>JG</u>**. Develop and conduct a comprehensive recreation program to meet the needs and interests of the residents of the city;
- **<u>K</u>H**. Perform such other related duties as shall be required by law, ordinance or the city manager."

SECTION 6. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 2.268 (Housing and Career Services Department), Sections 2.268.010 and Section 2.268.020, subdivisions (A) and (B), are amended as follows:

"Chapter 2.268 - HOUSING AND CAREER SERVICES DEPARTMENT 2.268.010 - Created—Direction.

There is created a functional unit of city government known as the housing career services department, under the general administration of the city manager, which shall be under the direction and control of the city's director of housing.

2.268.020 - Department functions.

The department shall:

- A. Administer and implement city policies and programs pertaining to affordable housing production, rehabilitation, and preservation; **career services**; rental assistance; supportive housing services addressing homelessness; community development; and related housing matters.
- B. Provide staff services to the city manager, city council, relating to the development and implementation of programs and plans for housing, **career services**, and housing production with emphasis on very low, low and moderate income housing.

SECTION 7. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 2.270 (Planning and Community Development Department), and Section 2.270.010 (Created – Direction) are amended as follows:

"Chapter 2.270 - PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT 2.270.010 - Created—Direction.

There is created a functional unit of city government known as the planning **and community development** department, under the general administration of the city manager, which shall be under the direction and control of the director of planning and community development."

SECTION 8. Pasadena Municipal Code, Title 2, Chapter 2.300, Section

2.300.020 (Department functions) is amended as follows:

"The department shall:

- A. Construct and maintain all public streets, street lights, storm drains, sewers, traffic signals, alleys, rights-of-way, park improvements and facilities; construct park improvements; control the temporary occupation or use thereof; and inspect work not performed by the city;
- B. Provide staff support to the recreation and parks commission and other commissions or committees related to public works projects;

- **BC**. Perform all civil engineering, excluding traffic and transportation engineering, for the city as directed by the city manager;
- **<u>C</u>D**. Manage the city's solid waste collection operation and administer solid waste disposal and recycling strategies;
- **<u>D</u>E**. Perform all duties imposed on the city engineer by the assessment acts and procedures of the state or of the city;
- **E**F. Prepare or review and approve all legal descriptions involving transactions related to the city's acquisition or disposal of interests in land, or related to zone changes, and subdivision approvals;
- G. Plan, develop, operate and maintain all parks, park areas, the grounds in the civic center, the grounds of the public library and all branch libraries, and such city-owned property as shall be provided by ordinance or as directed by the city manager;
- **FH**. Plant, maintain and remove trees and shrubs within all public street rights-of-way, **public parks**, and such other landscaping as the city shall place in city median strips, public squares and similar public areas; **and**
- I. Manage the Arroyo Seco, including Hahamongna, Brookside Park and the Lower Arroyo, and provide administrative coordination of programs involving the Rose Bowl Operating Company, the Rose Bowl Aquatics Center, and other major activities in the Arroyo; and,
- **G**J. Perform all duties of the city engineer, and such other related duties as shall be required by law, ordinance or the city manager."

SECTION 9. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 3.12 (Tournament of Roses -

Grandstands), Section 3.12.020 (Definitions), subdivision (B) is amended as follows:

""Building and development services administrator" means the administrative head of the building and development services division of the **planning community development**department."

SECTION 10. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 3.24 (Parks and Public Grounds), Section 3.24.030 (Administrative jurisdiction), subdivision (B) is amended as follows:

"All neighborhood centers (Villa Parke, Jackie Robinson Center), recreation centers, (Victory Park, Robinson Park), the Pasadena Senior Center, and municipal swimming pools in Villa Parke and Robinson Park, and other facilities and structures in parks and open spaces are placed under the administrative jurisdiction of the human servicesparks, recreation and neighborhoods community services department, or other department designated by the city manager in writing. All facilities and structures in parks and open space areas not identified above are under the administrative jurisdiction of the public works and transportation department, or other department designated by the city manager in writing. The Rose Bowl and

buildings and structures located on the municipal golf course are intentionally excluded from this subsection.

SECTION 11. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 4.32 (Construction Tax),

Section 4.32.020 (Rates), subdivision (A) is amended as follows:

"Every building, swimming pool or similar permit issued by the planning, housing and development services department shall be subject to a construction tax at the rate of 1.5% of the value of the structures included in said permits, or as may be subsequently adjusted by permit modifications."

SECTION 12. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 5.78 (Commercial Cannabis Activity), Section 5.78.080 (Permittee selection process), subdivision (F) is amended as follows:

"The top applicants in each permit category (or applicants applying for vacated permits) based on points are required to secure a viable business location if one has not been secured and apply to the planning **and community development** department to obtain any required land use approvals or entitlements for the permittee's location after being notified that their application has been accepted and ranked as one of the top applicants. Land use approvals shall include compliance with all applicable provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA")."

SECTION 13. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 8.79 (Childhood Lead Hazards Reduction Ordinance), Section 8.79.050 (Lead hazard reduction procedure), first sentence, is amended as follows:

"If lead hazard reduction measures are necessary in a historically significant building, the order to eliminate the hazard must be reviewed and approved by the director of planning **and permitting** in advance of corrective actions. . . "

SECTION 14. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 9.62 (Abandoned Shopping Carts), Section 9.62.030 (Definitions), subdivisions (E) and (H), are amended as follows:

"E. "Director" shall mean the director of planning **and development** for the city of Pasadena, or such other city official designated by the city manager to administer this chapter.

H. "Physical containment system" shall mean a disabling device on all shopping carts which prevents them from being removed from the business premises by locking the wheels or otherwise preventing the movement of the carts, or any other system of equipment approved by the director of planning **and development** which physically contains shopping carts on premises."

SECTION 15. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 13.20 (Water Service and Rates), Section 13.20.200 (Cross connections, second paragraph, is amended as follows:

"Pasadena Municipal Code Title 14, Buildings and Construction, Chapter 14.20 creates the cross-connection control board consisting of the general manager of the water and power department, the **administrator director** of planning **and permitting**, and the health officer of the city or their duly appointed representatives."

SECTION 16. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 14.03 (Administrative Code), Section 14.03.030, is amended as follows:

"There has been established heretofore in this jurisdiction a code enforcement agency entitled, the Planning **and Community Development** Department which employs a Building Official who shall be authorized to enforce the provisions of this code."

SECTION 17. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 14.05 (Excavation and Grading in Hillside Areas), Section 14.05.210 (Grading inspection and supervision), subdivision (F), is amended as follows:

"Plans for engineered grading and engineered slopes shall be submitted for approval to the director of planning and development and to the city's building official. Landscaping approved by the director of planning and permitting shall be installed on such graded slopes and provisions shall be made in such grading to accommodate the planting and maintenance of such landscaping."

SECTION 18. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 14.05 (Excavation and Grading in Hillside Areas), Section 14.05.250 (Retaining walls), subdivision (C)(6), is amended as follows:

"Plans for such walls shall be submitted for approval to the director of planning and permitting, and only upon approval of such, a permit issued."

SECTION 19. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 14.12 (Housing Code),

Section 14.12.340 (Inspection of buildings) is amended as follows:

"All buildings within the scope of this code and all construction or work for which a permit is required shall be subject to inspection by the **housing and community development planning** department in accordance with and in the manner provided by this code and Sections 304 and 305 of the Pasadena building code."

SECTION 20. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 14.16 (Quadrennial Certificate of Inspection), Section 14.16.020 (Definitions), subdivision (A) is amended as follows:

""Administrator" means the housing and neighborhood services administrator of the planning, housing and development services department of the city."

SECTION 21. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 14.17 (Presale Self-Certification Program), Section 14.17.020 (Definitions), subdivision (A) is amended as follows:

"Administrator" means the director of the planning **and community development** department of the city or designee."

SECTION 22. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 14.20 (Cross-Connection Control Board), Section 14.20.010 (Established) is amended as follows:

"There is created the cross-connection control board consisting of the general manager of the water and power department, the **administrator director** of planning **and permitting**, and the health officer of the city or their duly appointed representatives. These officials will be referred to in this chapter as "the board.""

SECTION 23. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 14.27 (Floodplain Management Regulations), Section 14.27.050 (Basis for establishing flood-prone areas) is amended as follows:

"The floodplain administrator shall obtain, review, and reasonably utilize any base flood data available from federal or state agencies or other source to identify flood-prone areas within the boundaries of the city of Pasadena. This data will be on file at the city

of Pasadena department of planning **and development**, 175 North Garfield Avenue, Pasadena, California 91101."

SECTION 24. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 16.08 (Definitions), Section 16.08.087 (Director) is amended as follows:

"Director" means the director of planning and permitting, any successor official, or the director's designee."

SECTION 25. Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 16.46.060 (Relocation counseling), subdivision (A), first sentence in indented paragraph, is amended as follows:

"The assistance plan shall include provisions for relocation counseling to qualified tenants by a qualified agency approved for this purpose by the director of housing-and community development, and such other steps as may be undertaken by the developer to mitigate the impact of relocation on tenants qualified for assistance."

SECTION 26. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published by title and summary.

SECTION 44. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.
