We are concerned about the health and welfare of our community and appreciate the way our public health department has navigated this crisis.

As we begin reopening, please enable businesses to open safely and quickly. It is imperative that the City of Pasadena not place impediments in the way of anyone safely conducting business and succeed now and into the future. Please allow them to reopen quickly.

Other jurisdictions are allowing certifications of restaurants via email, online forms and over the phone, for example. We can do that, too.

What businesses need is direction on how to operate in a way that keeps their customers and employees safe, not inspections, added costs or delays to opening.

Studies show that as many as 25% of local small businesses may close across the US. Most will fail for lack of \$10,000 to \$15,000. The City of Pasadena can be the lifeline for those that did not qualify or did not receive PPP loans by seeding a fund to support them with no-interest loans or grants. A small investment now could be repaid to the City in future sales tax and more.

**Comments** The Linda Vista-Annandale Association Board OPPOSES simply opening the Central Arroyo Recreational Loops without a full, scientifically based, enforceable Plan to protect Pasadena's residents and adjacent neighbors from "community spread" of COVID 19. Prior to the close, we observed uncontrollable crowds from all over LA following NO infection protocols, and, arguably bringing COVID 19 with them. This time, it would be unconscionable to expose Pasadena residents and vulnerable adjacent neighbors in high risk groups to "spread" without such regulations as face coverings, social distancing, random temperature checks, maybe proof of recent negative testing -- whatever, in enforceable detail, is recommended by Dr. Goh. Our Board voted unanimously not to accept or risk uncontrolled Loop crowds, and any re-opening must control community spread and involve a detailed enforceable plan no matter how many staff or Police are needed, and no matter the cost.
