




## Project Scope of Work

 Installation of 40-foot tall safety netting along the first and third base foul lines to protect spectators sitting in the bleachers

- Two (2) vendors submitted proposals
- Lowest Responsive and Responsible Bid

#### Department of Public Works

- Find the contract proposed herein to be categorically exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines in accordance with Title 14, Chapter 3, Article 19, Section 15301, Class 1 – Existing Facilities, which exempts minor alteration of existing public facilities where no expansion of the use will take place and that there are no features that distinguish this project from others in the exempt class, and therefore, there are no unusual circumstances; and
- i) Accept the bid dated October 15, 2020, submitted by Judge Netting, Inc. in response to the project plans and specifications for the Jackie Robinson Baseball Field Foul Ball Netting Improvements, ii) reject all other bids, and iii) authorize the City Manager to enter into contract for an amount not to exceed \$180,000 which includes the base contract amount of \$148,146, and a contingency of \$31,854 to provide for any necessary change orders.
