
Of all Pasadenans 16 years and older:

- 51.2% have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine
- More than 30% are fully vaccinated

Total vaccines ordered	# Pasadenans with at least one dose	# of Pasadenans fully vaccinated	Total Vaccines received/administered by PPHD
67,220	60,356	35,944	20,530/18,232

≈ 40% of people vaccinated in Pasadena are not Pasadena residents

 More than 94% (21,229 out of 22,536) have at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine

Mass Vaccination Strategies

Public Health Department

Medical Point of Dispensing (MPOD)

- Up to 2000 people per day (230/hr)
- Pasadena City College & Victory Park

Huntington Hospital

2,000 people vaccinated per week

Populations:

- Healthcare workers/LTCF staff and residents
- Work-eligible individuals (emergency services, educators/childcare providers, food/agriculture, etc.)
- People with chronic conditions
- Age-eligible individuals (50+ and 16+ after April 15)

- Multiple options for appointments and vaccine type
 - > Call center (CSC) for appointments, other services, & proactive outreach
- Multi-department effort
 - Parks & Recreation, Public Works, PD, FD, disability coordinator, City volunteers and borrowed staff from all departments
- Outreach Committee
 - Over 35 community-based organizations doing active promotion, referrals, and appointment sign-ups
- Multi-lingual contact tracers re-deployed to do vaccine outreach
 & sign-ups
