Commissioner Allen Shay, work with the youth in Northwest Pasadena to ensured results in youth learning their history in today's society with a project initiated in 2017 called Youth for Peace. The objective is to raise awareness of Black history in Pasadena, create a repository, incorporating the history into an academic program and use the information to have an outcome in activism, democracy and police accountability.

The most recent project from members of Youth for Peace was Day of advocacy which recorded 163 day of posting history and advocacy. For Black history month 2021, democracy was the focus called Corruption and Conspiracy in the Anthony McClain murder by Pasadena Police. The members learned the law under AB 392, how successful it was applied in the case of Nichols Bil v. City of San Diego, the officer was terminated two days after shooting Bil in the back, arrested after 45 days for second degree murder with a million-dollar bail. The police's video determined that: (1). McClain was unarmed and shot twice in the back, (2). The hand gun was planted by police (3). The DNA report was the product of the conspiracy and (4). Chief Perez is contradicted by the video.
