SUBJECT: Ordinance Suspending Pasadena Municipal Code Sections 9.36.220 (amplified sound) and 9.36.230 (general noise source) for Three UCLA College Football Night Games

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the RBOC approve and recommend that the City Council pass an ordinance suspending Pasadena Municipal Code Sections 9.36.220 (amplified sound) and 9.36.230 (general noise source) for three potential UCLA night games – September 9th/Fresno State, September 30th/Arizona State, and October 21st/Oregon State, until 11:00 p.m., rather than the current 10:00 p.m. time limit.

BACKGROUND:

Traditional college football games have a running time of approximately three hours, however, if one or all of the above mentioned night games should last longer than three hours and/or go into overtime, suspension of the Pasadena Noise Ordinance may be necessary.

FISCAL IMPACT:

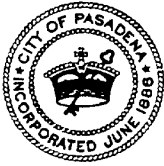
There is no fiscal impact to suspending the noise ordinance.

TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON THE OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR SPECIFIED HOURS AND AREAS ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2000 AND OCTOBER 21, 2000.

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:

This proposed ordinance is to provide an exemption from the Noise Ordinance for two (2) potential UCLA college football night games at the Rose Bowl from the hours of 10:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. The enactment of this proposed ordinance is needed for these events to take place should scheduling necessitate. Traditional college football games have a running time of approximately three hours; however, if one or both of the potential college football night games should last longer than three hours and/or go into overtime, suspension of the Noise Ordinance may be necessary.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:

The Noise Ordinance was enacted by ordinance and can only be suspended by an ordinance of the City Council.



AN UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON THE OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR SPECIFIED HOURS AND AREAS ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2000 AND OCTOBER 21, 2000.

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 9.36.220 and 9.36.230 of the Pasadena Municipal Code are suspended from the hours of 10:00 p.m. to 11:01 p.m. on September 30, 2000 and October 21, 2000, for events at the Rose Bowl for which a valid license agreement is in force and effect.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance to be published in full text.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.


