

Specifications LD-00-3 for the B-3 reheater tube replacement were sent to six prospective bidders. Four bids were received; however, one of these bids was determined to be non-responsive. The three responsive bids received and bid prices are as follows:

<u>BIDDERS</u>	<u>BID PRICE</u>
Complete Plant Maintenance, Inc.	\$169,146
Irwin Industries, Inc.	\$221,891
Foster Wheeler Energy Services, Inc.	\$278,000

Complete Plant Maintenance is the lowest qualified bidder and is therefore recommended for award of the proposed contract.

The proposed contract amount of not-to-exceed \$195,000 includes the bid price of \$169,146 and a contingency amount of \$25,854 (approximately 15 %) for possible additional tube replacement and to accommodate any necessary change order.

The proposed contract complies with the Affirmative Action in Contracting Ordinance, Pasadena Municipal Code, Chapter 4.09 and the Living Wage Ordinance, Pasadena Municipal Code 4.11.

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
