SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR AN OCTOBER 24, 1999 EVENT ("MAKING STRIDES AGAINST BREAST CANCER" 5K WALK TO BE HELD AT AREA H AND THE ARROYO SECO).

TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR SPECIFIED HOURS AND AREAS ON OCTOBER 24, 1999.

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:

This proposed ordinance is to provide an exemption from the Noise Ordinance for a 5K Walk ("Making Strides Against Breast Cancer") at Area H and the Arroyo Seco. The enactment of this proposed ordinance is needed for the event to take place. This event was approved by the City Council at its meeting held June 7, 1999.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:

The Noise Ordinance was enacted by ordinance and can only be suspended by an ordinance of the City Council.


FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The goal of the American Cancer Society is to raise \$1 million to fight breast cancer, a portion of which would stay in Pasadena. The American Cancer Society has indicated that they will apply for City Co-Sponsorship, agreeing to pay all City costs whether or not the application is approved.


ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT:

The Environmental Administrator has determined that the proposed suspension of noise ordinance and Temporary Use Permit necessary to hold the American Cancer Society 5K walk is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15323, normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings. Actions to allow walks sponsored by non-profit organizations in the Central Arroyo are normal operations for public gatherings in this area.



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR SPECIFIED HOURS AND AREAS ON OCTOBER 24, 1999.

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 9.36.220 and 9.36.230 of the Pasadena Municipal Code are hereby suspended from the hours of 8:00 a.m. until 12:01 p.m. on October 24, 1999, as to events held at Area H and the Arroyo Seco, as such areas are defined in the Arroyo Seco Public Lands Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published in full text.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.


