SUBJECT: AMENDMENT CONCERNING MEMBERSHIP OF
CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEES.

TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING SECTIONS 2.05.160 (B), 2.05.170 (B), 2.05.180 (B), 2.05.190 (B), AND 2.05.200 (B) OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE COMPOSITION OF CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEES

PURPOSE OF THE ORDINANCE:

The purpose of this ordinance is to increase the number of councilmembers who may serve on some city council committees.

REASON WHY THIS LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:

At the City Council retreat of July 9, 1999, the City Council directed the City Attorney's Office to prepare an ordinance amending the municipal code to permit up to four councilmembers to serve on some City Council Committees. Section 410 of the Pasadena City Charter requires that an ordinance be drafted to amend the municipal code.

PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENTS OR GROUPS AFFECTED:

This ordinance will affect the administrative functioning of City Council committees and staff to those committees.


FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

It is not anticipated that this ordinance will have a fiscal impact on the general fund.


POLICY CHANGE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING
SECTIONS 2.05.160 (B), 2.05.170 (B), 2.05.180 (B), 2.05.0190 (B), AND
2.05.200 (B) OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING
THE COMPOSITION OF CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEES

The People of the City of Pasadena do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection B of Section 2.05.160 is hereby amended to read:

“B. The finance committee shall be composed of up to 4 members of the city council appointed by the mayor. If 4 members are appointed, 3 members shall constitute a quorum. No action of the committee shall be valid without the affirmative vote of at least 2 members.”

SECTION 2. Subsection B of Section 2.05.170 is hereby amended to read:

“B. The business enterprise committee shall be composed of up to 4 members of the city council appointed by the mayor. If 4 members are appointed, 3 members shall constitute a quorum. No action of the committee shall be valid without the affirmative vote of at least 2 members.”

SECTION 3. Subsection B of Section 2.05.180 is hereby amended to read:

“B. The legislative committee shall be composed of up to 4 members of the city council appointed by the mayor. If 4 members are appointed, 3 members shall constitute a quorum. No action of the committee shall be valid without the affirmative vote of at least 2 members.”

SECTION 4. Subsection B of Section 2.05.190 is hereby amended to read:

“B. The public safety committee shall be composed of up to 4 members of the city council appointed by the mayor. If 4 members are appointed, 3 members shall constitute a quorum. No action of the committee shall be valid without the affirmative vote of at least 2 members.”

SECTION 5. Subsection B of Section 2.05.200 is hereby amended to read:

“B. The deregulation committee shall be composed of up to 4 members of the city council appointed by the mayor. If 4 members are appointed, 3 members shall constitute a quorum. No action of the committee shall be valid without the affirmative vote of at least 2 members.”

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.


