SUBJECT: RECOGNIZE REVENUE FROM THE 1998/1999 PUBLIC EDUCATION & AMNESTY GRANT AWARD TR12-98-2682 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,875 FROM THE CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the California Integrated Waste Management Board to promote tire recycling and the collection of up to 4,000 tires in the City of Pasadena.
2. Approve a journal voucher recognizing and appropriating \$13,875 in revenue from the State of California Integrated Waste Management Board to Account #6461, Fund #406, Organization #764200, Project # 93002, Tire grant.

BACKGROUND

On November 16th, 1998, the City Council approved submittal of a grant application to the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) for the 1998/1999 PUBLIC EDUCATION & AMNESTY GRANT (City of Pasadena Resolution Number 7693).

On March 3, 1999, the City of Pasadena was notified that a grant for the promotion of tire disposal/recycling and the collection of up to 4,000 tires was approved for funding in the amount of \$13,875. The grant will allow the City to:


- Collect and properly dispose of up to 4,000 tires during the neighborhood cleanup program
- Promote tire recycling at community outreach events
- Distribute promotional items
- Design and print an informational brochure
- Mail brochure to 27,000 household units

The grant funds will be used for tire recycling during fiscal year 2000 and will be an additional component of the annual neighborhood cleanup program. The grant funds expire April 1, 2001.


FISCAL IMPACT

The Public Education & Amnesty Grant Award is \$13,875 for fiscal year 2000. This action by City Council increases FY2000 Refuse Collection Fund revenues and appropriations in Account #6461, Fund #406, Organization #764200, Project #93002, Public Education & Amnesty Grant, by \$13,875.


