TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR PERMITTED EVENTS AT CENTENNIAL SQUARE FOR SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2000; FOR PERMITTED EVENTS AT AREA H AND THE ARROYO SECO FOR SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2000; AND FOR PERMITTED EVENTS AT AREA H AND THE ARROYO SECO FOR SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2000.

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:

This proposed ordinance is to suspend the Noise Ordinance for permitted events at Centennial Square on specified times on October 1, 2000, specifically, the proposed American Diabetes Association Walk-A-Thon; for permitted events at Area H and the Arroyo Seco on specified times on October 15, 2000, specifically the Race for the Cure; and for permitted events at Area H

and the Arroyo Seco on specified times on October 29, 2000, specifically the American Cancer Society 5K Walk, all as to general noise and amplified sound. The enactment of this proposed ordinance is needed for these events to take place.

These events were approved by the City Council at its meeting held April 24, 2000.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:

The Noise Ordinance was enacted by ordinance and can only be suspended by an ordinance of the City Council.


FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Any City costs that may be incurred for each event (i.e., sound meter reading, park clean up, etc.) are to be paid by the respective non-profit association sponsoring that event.


ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT:

The Environmental Administrator has determined that the Temporary Use Permit and the ordinance necessary to hold the three non-profit events is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines Section 15323, Normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings. Actions to allow walks sponsored by non-profit organizations are normal operations for public gatherings in Area H, the Arroyo Seco, and Centennial Square.



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR PERMITTED EVENTS AT CENTENNIAL SQUARE FOR SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2000; FOR PERMITTED EVENTS AT AREA H AND THE ARROYO SECO FOR SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2000; AND FOR PERMITTED EVENTS AT AREA H AND THE ARROYO SECO FOR SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2000.

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 9.36.220 and 9.36.230 of the Pasadena Municipal Code are hereby suspended from the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on October 1, 2000, for events at Centennial Square for which the City has issued a Special Event permit.

SECTION 2. Sections 9.36.220 and 9.36.230 of the Pasadena Municipal Code are hereby suspended from the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on October 15, 2000, for events at Area H and the Arroyo Seco for which the City has issued a Special Event permit.

SECTION 3. Sections 9.36.220 and 9.36.230 of the Pasadena Municipal Code are hereby suspended from the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on October 29, 2000, for events at Area H and the Arroyo Seco for which the City has issued a Special Event permit.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published in full text.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.


