SUBJECT: Council District 7 Crime Stats for First Half 1998 Compared to First Half 1997

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

There is no recommendation. This item is for information only.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The following is a comparison of Part 1 crimes in City Council District 7 during the first half of 1998 compared to the first half of 1997. Part 1 crimes are those that the FBI regularly tracks "because of their seriousness and frequency in nature."

With regard to District 7 statistics, the most significant increase is in Assaults, by 33%. While the percentage reflects a high increase, the actual number rose from 6 to 8. Robberies decreased 38% from last year, and Motor Vehicle Thefts decreased 41%. The Homicide that occurred in 1998 was on May 4 at 104 S. Oak Ave. The "N/C" in the Homicide and Forcible Rape rows mean that division by 0 is "Not calculable". Over all, Part 1 Crimes have decreased in Council District 7 by 8%.
