- Around any of the horses at the site, please remember:
 1. Parents and children will have the most fun and be safest if they stay together.
 2. Walk in front of the horse. Horses can get scared if you walk behind them because they can hear you, but they cannot see you.

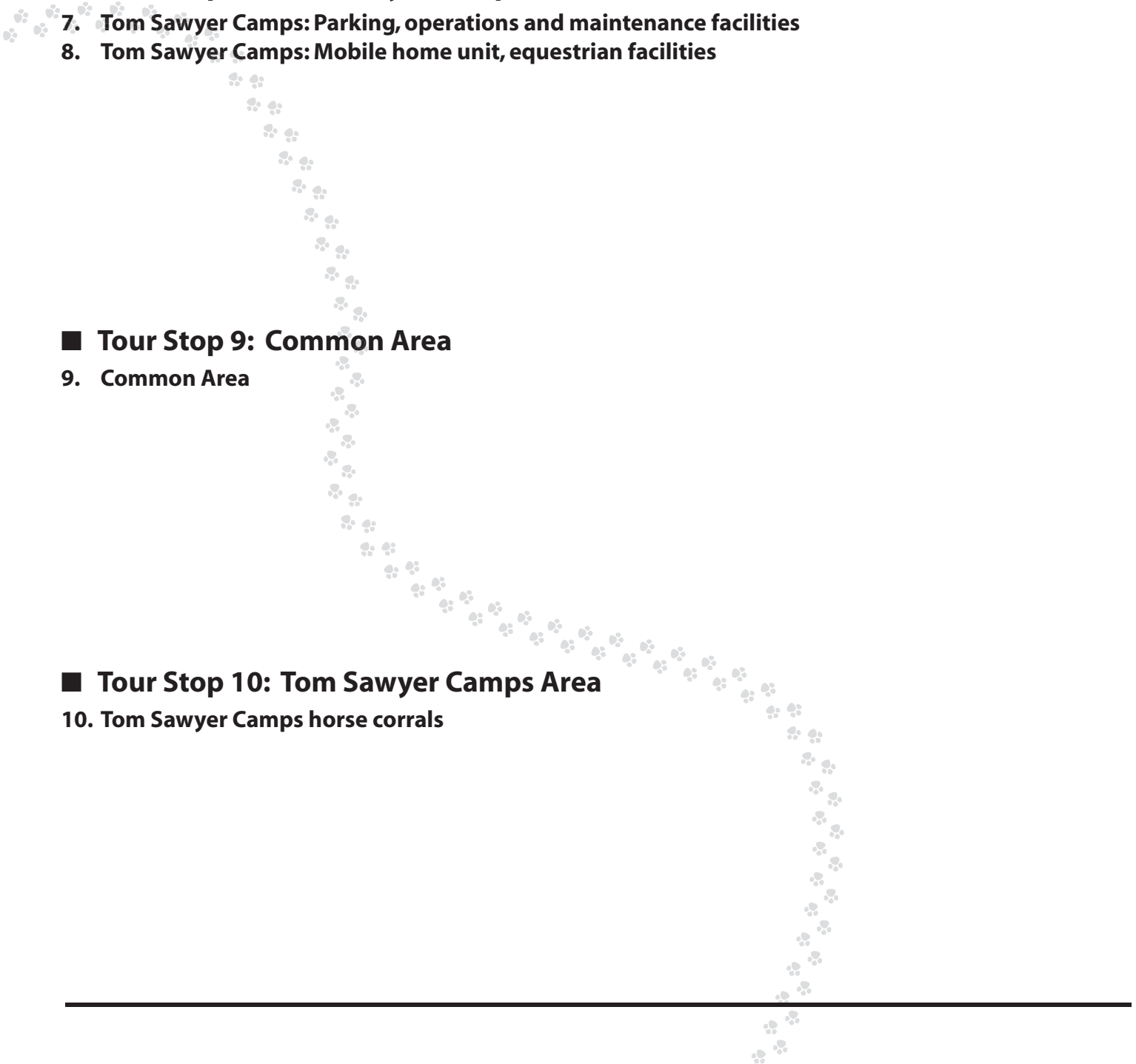

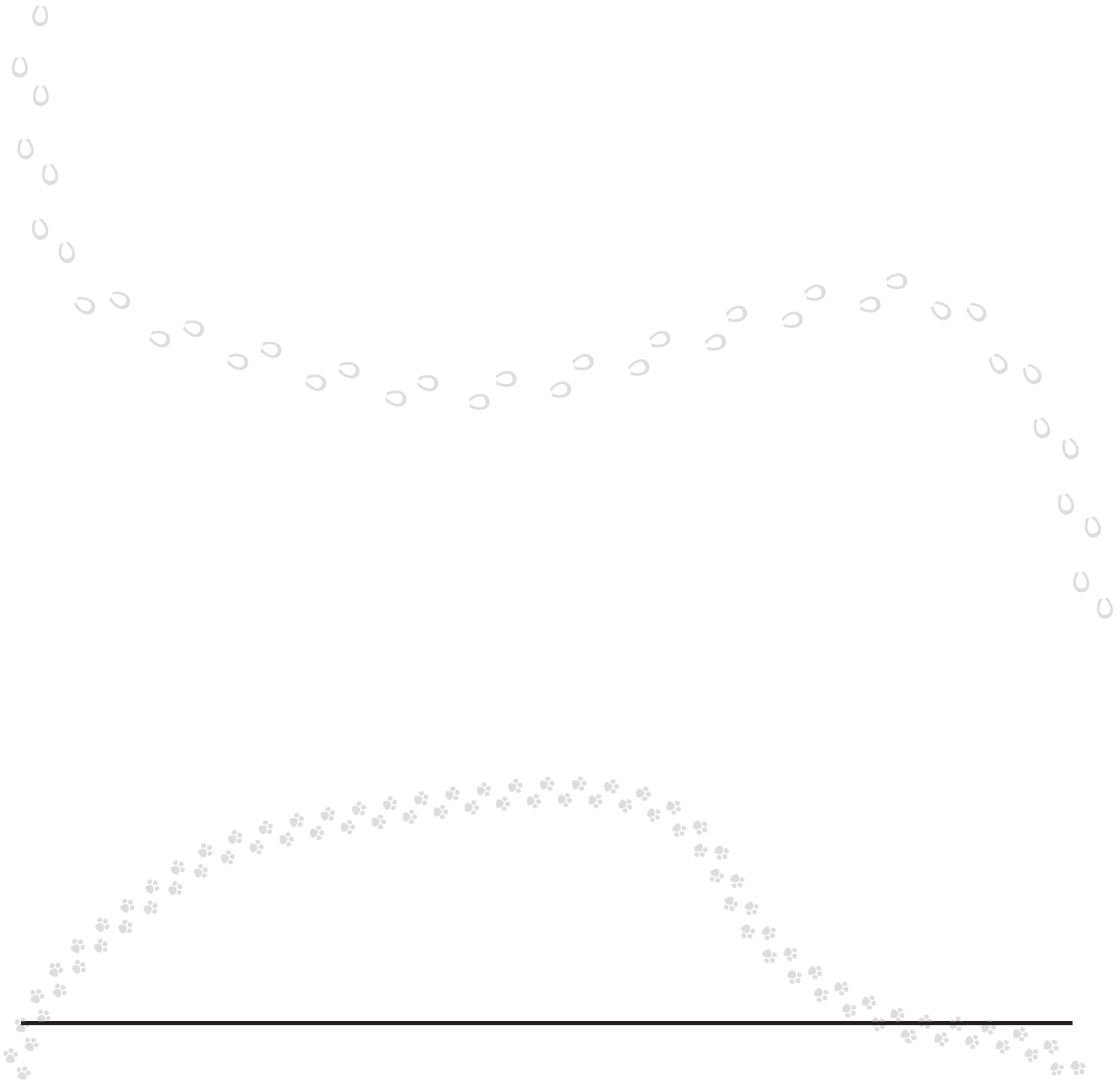
