Franchise Agreements That Expire June 30, 2004:

When we review franchisees past performance we will be considering:

- Compliance with your recycling plan, franchise agreement and Pasadena Municipal Code 8.61.
- Best efforts in meeting 50% recycling goal.
- Tonnage reports and fee submittals, etc.

Construction and Demolition Ordinance:

A Construction and Demolition (C&D) Recycling Ordinance was adopted on November 4, 2002, that requires 50% of debris from construction and demolition projects be diverted from the landfill.
