### Construction & Demolition Debris Reporting:

Please remember that if you contract for C&D hauling, verify with your customer whether the project is subject to Chapter 8.62 of the Pasadena Municipal Code. Chapter 8.62 requires that 50% or greater of the debris generated by certain projects be diverted from landfill disposal. The customer must provide documentation of the disposition of the debris. You, as a hauler, may be required to provide receipts. Customers that do not provide documentation of C&D diversion and disposal may be subject to prosecution and/or lose a substantial deposit. Please make sure you understand your customers needs prior to contracting for C&D work.

### Franchise Yearly Renewal Criteria:



The following list is considered when reviewing past performance for yearly franchise renewals:

- Not meeting AB 939 50% recycling.
- Collection status.
- Late franchise fee payments.
- Late tonnage reports.
- Late insurance certificates.
- Pasadena business license status.



### Be Aware SB 420!

SB 420: Consideration of modified legislation requiring 75% diversion after January 1, 2015.

Pasadena Franchisees are required to pick up Christmas trees so please inform your customers about your company's holiday tree collection/recycling options and ask their support in properly disposing of unwanted Christmas trees. Do not mail any franchise fee payment checks or tonnage reports to the Finance Department or to Maria Zapata.

Please note that franchise fee payment checks are different from business license checks. Business license checks should be mailed to Finance Dept/Business License Section.
