SUBJECT: Resolution Requesting County Aid-to-Cities Funds for the Improvement of Sierra Madre Boulevard from Sierra Madre Villa Avenue to Michillinda Avenue

## RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Adopt a resolution requesting County Aid-to-Cities (ATC) funds in the amount of \$41,075 for the subject project.
2. Approve a journal voucher amending the FY 2001-2005 Capital Improvement Program as described herein.

## BACKGROUND:

The Public Works and Transportation Department is in the process of developing plans and specifications for the subject project as part of the Preventive Maintenance of Streets – 2001 construction project.

Sierra Madre Boulevard from Sierra Madre Villa Avenue to Michillinda Avenue is classified as a principal arterial roadway on the 1992 Functional Classification System of the Federal Highway Administration. The project involves the grinding of existing asphalt paving adjacent to the concrete gutter, resurfacing with 1.5 inches of asphalt concrete, repainting all traffic striping and pavement markings, and adjusting existing utility manhole frames and covers to new grade.


The Los Angeles County Department of Public Works formerly provided cities with County Aid-to-Cities (ATC) Funds for the improvement of streets of county-wide significance. This program was suspended in 1990. The County has advised that a remaining balance of \$41,075 is available to the City. The subject project meets the requirements for the use of these funds. In order to receive these funds, it is necessary that a resolution be adopted requesting ATC funds from the County.

Staff is requesting that a journal voucher be approved recognizing \$41,075 of ATC funds and appropriating them to Budget Account Number 73710, Preventive Maintenance of Asphalt Streets.


FISCAL IMPACT:

Adoption of the Resolution will enable the City to receive an allocation of \$41,075 for this project.




