RE: Salary Resolution Amendment to Establish Parks Safety Specialist

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt a Salary Resolution Amendment to establish a new classification entitled Parks Safety Specialist in the Technical/Administrative Section of the Salary Resolution effective June 25, 2001.

Background:

The Public Safety Committee has identified the parks security program under the Public Safety Plan as a priority for implementation. At the Council meeting of March 26, 2001, City Council approved the addition of six full-time positions to provide security and safety at the public parks, and directed the City Manager to include the funding for the program in the FY 2002 budget. Council also directed staff to begin the recruitment of these positions so that this program is in place on July 1, 2001. This has been accomplished.

The classification title for the security positions is Parks Safety Specialist. The salary range recommended is \$16.59 up to \$20.72 per hour. Council adoption of the attached Salary Resolution Amendment is necessary to establish this classification and salary in the Technical/Administrative Section of the Salary Resolution.


Fiscal Impact:

The projected cost to fund six full-time Parks Safety Specialist positions is \$312,888 per year in salary plus benefits. These positions are funded in the Police Department budget for FY 2002.
