**SUBJECT:** AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR A PERMITTED EVENT AT VICTORY PARK FOR SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, APRIL 15, 2001.

**TITLE OF THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE:**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA SUSPENDING SECTIONS 9.36.220 AND 9.36.230 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO LIMITATIONS ON HOURS OF OPERATION OF AMPLIFIED SOUND AND NOISE SOURCES FOR A PERMITTED EVENT AT VICTORY PARK FOR SPECIFIED HOURS ON SUNDAY, APRIL 15, 2001.

**PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:**

This proposed ordinance is to suspend the Noise Ordinance for a permitted event at Victory Park on specified times on Sunday, April 15, 2001 as to general noise and amplified sound. The enactment of this proposed ordinance is needed for this event to take place.

This event was approved by the City Council at its meeting held March 12, 2001.

**REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:**

The Noise Ordinance was enacted by ordinance and can only be suspended by an ordinance of the City Council.

**FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:**

Any City costs that may be incurred for this event (i.e., sound meter reading, park clean up, etc.) are to be paid by the event promoter.




**ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT:**




