AN UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA ADDING A TEMPORARY ENERGY CONSERVATION INCENTIVE MECHANISM TO THE LIGHT AND POWER RATE ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 13.04 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE)

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. A temporary energy conservation incentive mechanism is hereby adopted.

SECTION 2. Terms. Terms used in this ordinance, unless otherwise defined herein, shall have the definitions assigned to them under Section 13.04.020 of the light and power rate ordinance (Chapter 13.04 of the Pasadena Municipal Code). All references to sections shall relate to the Pasadena Municipal Code unless otherwise specified.

SECTION 3. Eligibility. Except as herein provided, all customers taking electrical service from the Department who have had an account with the Department using the same meter for a minimum period of one year shall be eligible to receive a rate discount. Direct access customers shall not be eligible.

SECTION 4. Applicability. The rate discount hereby provided shall apply only to the Energy Charge and Transmission Charge components of the eligible customer's rates.

SECTION 5. Rate Discounts. Eligible customers reducing electricity service from the Department as compared to their electricity consumption one year ago shall receive a rate discount in the form of a billing credit or a rebate, in the Department's discretion, as follows:

- i. For a reduction between one and five percent: five cents for each K. W. H. reduced.
- ii. For a reduction greater than five percent: ten cents for each K. W. H. reduced.
- iii. City council may from time to time by resolution adopt different percentages and amounts from those set forth above in order to adjust the total amount of conservation or Department revenues realized by operation of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. The rate discount provided herein shall apply to all electric meters read by the Department during the period commencing June 1, 2001 and ending October 31, 2001.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall expire on November 1, 2001.

SECTION 8. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published in full text.

SECTION 9. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.
