SUBJECT: Acceptance of State of California Law Enforcement Equipment Program Grant Funds for Technology

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council approve a journal voucher recognizing \$72,314 in revenue from the State of California Law Enforcement Equipment Program and appropriate it to the Police Department, account number 8506-228-407110.

BACKGROUND:

In the State of California's FY 2002 Budget, the legislature provided for the funding special grant funds for the California Law Enforcement Equipment Program (CLEEP) Grant Program that is administered by the State Controllers Office.

All law enforcement agencies in California received FY 2002 funding. The amounts varied depending upon population. The Pasadena Police Department was awarded \$72,314. There are no matching funds or other restrictions on the funds. The only requirement is that they must be spent on technology – Equipment for Law Enforcement.

The Police Department will add the CLEEP funding to the account established to provide funding to replace the records management and mobile computer systems of the Department.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of the recommendation will increase the fiscal year 2002 revenue and appropriations in budget account 8506-228-407110 by \$72,314, bringing the total to \$221,314 available for the purpose of enhancing public safety through the purchase of new technology.




