SUBJECT: Approval of Resolution and Agreement Requesting Federal Funds for Sierra Madre Boulevard Improvements from Hermanos Street to West of Washington Boulevard

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt a resolution approving Program Supplement No. M049 to Administering Agency-State Agreement No. 07-5064 between the City of Pasadena and the State of California for the Sierra Madre Boulevard Improvements from Hermanos Street to West of Washington Boulevard. (Project Number STPLG-5064[008]); and authorize the City Manager to execute the same on behalf of the City.

BACKGROUND:


The State of California acting through the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), administers certain Federal transportation funds. These funds are paid to the City of Pasadena pursuant to the provisions of Administering Agency-State Agreement No. 07-5064 (City of Pasadena Agreement No. 16,298) entered into by the parties on April 3, 1997. To obtain funds for a specific project it is necessary to execute a separate supplemental agreement for the project after it has been approved for funding by Caltrans and the Federal Highway Administration.

Program Supplement No. M049 will provide reimbursement of up to \$758,400 in Federal Surface Transportation Program funds for preliminary engineering, construction, and construction engineering for the Sierra Madre Boulevard Improvements from Hermanos Street to West of Washington Boulevard.


FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of Program Supplement No. M049 to Administering Agency-State Agreement No. 07-5064 will enable the City to obtain Federal reimbursement of eligible project costs.




