
Police service demands and permitted events were evaluated to determine appropriate deployment patterns. Based upon the evaluation of those factors there are four parks where the Park Safety Specialists will be assigned on a regular basis; La Pintaresca, Robinson, Villa, and Victory. It is envisioned that a Park Safety Specialists will be present within these parks for at least 2-3 hours daily. Other parks will receive various levels of attention, again based upon service demands and permitted events. Each park will be visited at least every other day.

As of this date, park safety specialists have met with representatives from the Parks and Recreation Commission, various City departments, and neighborhood associations. They will continue to work closely with each of these parties to ensure maximum effectiveness of the program.
