SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING CHAPTER 2.140 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE UTILITY ADVISORY COMMISSION

TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

An ordinance of the City of Pasadena amending Chapter 2.140 of the Pasadena Municipal Code relating to the Utility Advisory Commission.

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:

The City Council directed preparation of this ordinance which allows the City Council or the Municipal Services Committee to assign the Utility Advisory Commission specific areas for study and to remove the Utility Advisory Commission from routine review of various Water and Power Department items. The purpose of this ordinance is also to make this Commission permanent by repealing its sunset date.

REASONS WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:

The purpose and functions of the Utility Advisory Committee are established by ordinance and codified in Chapter 2.140 of the Pasadena Municipal Code.

PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENTS OR GROUPS AFFECTED:

The Utility Advisory Committee, and the Water and Power Department, which handles the workload associated with supporting the activities of the Utility Advisory Committee, are both affected by this ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING
SUBSECTION 2.140.110 (B) OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE
RELATING TO THE PURPOSES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE UTILITY
ADVISORY COMMISSION

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection 2.140.110 (B) of the Pasadena Municipal Code is
amended to read:

“B. The commission shall advise and make
recommendations to the city council concerning problems or
policy matters as directed by the Municipal Services
Committee or the city council.”

SECTION 2. Section 2.140.120 is repealed.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this ordinance and shall
cause this ordinance to be published in full text.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.
