SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF A TEMPORARY STORAGE FACILITY IN THE LOWER ARROYO FOR THE PASADENA ROVING ARCHERS

RECOMMENDATION

The Recreation and Parks Commission unanimously recommends that the City Council:

1. Allow a temporary storage facility in the Lower Arroyo Seco for use by the Pasadena Roving Archers; and
2. Allocate up to \$500 of Arroyo Park maintenance funds to pay for the costs of the temporary storage facility.

BACKGROUND

The conceptually approved Lower Arroyo Seco Master Plan includes the Roving Archers as a designated park use. Approval or disapproval of the various proposed elements of the plan, including the future of the Roving Archers facility, will come before the City Council in January 2003.

The Roving Archers Clubhouse, located in Pasadena's Lower Arroyo Seco, burned in a fire on Saturday, April 13 at 2 a.m. and is considered a total loss. The building was used as a clubhouse for the members of the Pasadena Roving Archers and served as a storage facility for equipment used to maintain the range and equipment used to give archery classes to the community.

The City owns the land within the range as well as the building which has been destroyed. However, an Operating Agreement between the City and the Pasadena Roving Archers designates the Roving Archers as the Operating Manager of the facility. It appears that the building was not covered by the City's insurance policy, as its value was below the City's deductible of \$25,000.

Staff will take appropriate action in regards to any environmental action that is necessary should this action be approved.


