SUBJECT: Ordinance Suspending Pasadena Municipal Code Sections 9.36.220 (amplified sound) and 9.36.230 (general noise source) for Three 2003 Scheduled UCLA College Football Night Games

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the RBOC approve and recommend that the City Council pass an ordinance suspending Pasadena Municipal Code Sections 9.36.220 (amplified sound) and 9.36.230 (general noise source) for five potential UCLA night games – September 27th versus San Diego State, October 4th versus Washington, October 18th versus California, October 25th versus Arizona State, and November 15th versus Oregon, until 11:00 p.m., rather than the current 10:00 p.m. time limit.

BACKGROUND:

Currently UCLA's schedule related to times is established for Illinois, San Diego State & Arizona State. Although not likely it is possible that the 7:00 p.m. start times may end after 10:00 pm.

In addition, the Washington, California, & Oregon games do not have game times established as of yet.

Traditionally these games would occur in the day, however, there is a possibility that these games may happen at night as well.

Hence, the suspension of the noise ordinance is being requested.

UCLA's 2003 scheduled is as follows:

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT:

The impacts of suspending Pasadena Municipal Code Sections 9.36.220 and 9.36.230 are categorically except from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under CEQA guidelines section 15323 Normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings.

FISCAL IMPACT:


There is no fiscal impact to suspending the noise ordinance.
