SUBJECT:

Approve the resolution amending the General Fee Schedule to allow for the imposition of a false alarm response fee upon the second and all subsequent responses in a twelve-month period.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended the City Council approve the resolution amending the General Fee Schedule to allow for the imposition of a false alarm response fee upon the second and all subsequent responses in a twelve-month period.

BACKGROUND

The City Council, at its June 30, 2003 meeting, directed preparation of an ordinance amendment to allow for the assessment of fees for false alarms on the second and all subsequent false alarms occurrences in a twelve-month period. The General Fee Schedule can only be amended by way of resolution. Approval of the resolution would make the General Fee Schedule consistent with the ordinance amendment and would allow the Police Department to recover costs for services related to false alarm responses, as well as encourage the prevention of false alarms.

FISCAL IMPACT

Approval of the resolution will result in an increase to the General Fund in an amount estimated to be \$126,524.
