The summary of the 2000 census data for Pasadena will be presented in two sessions. The second session, to be held around the end of July, will include further analysis of census data within nine census-defined geographic areas and discuss the implications on City services.

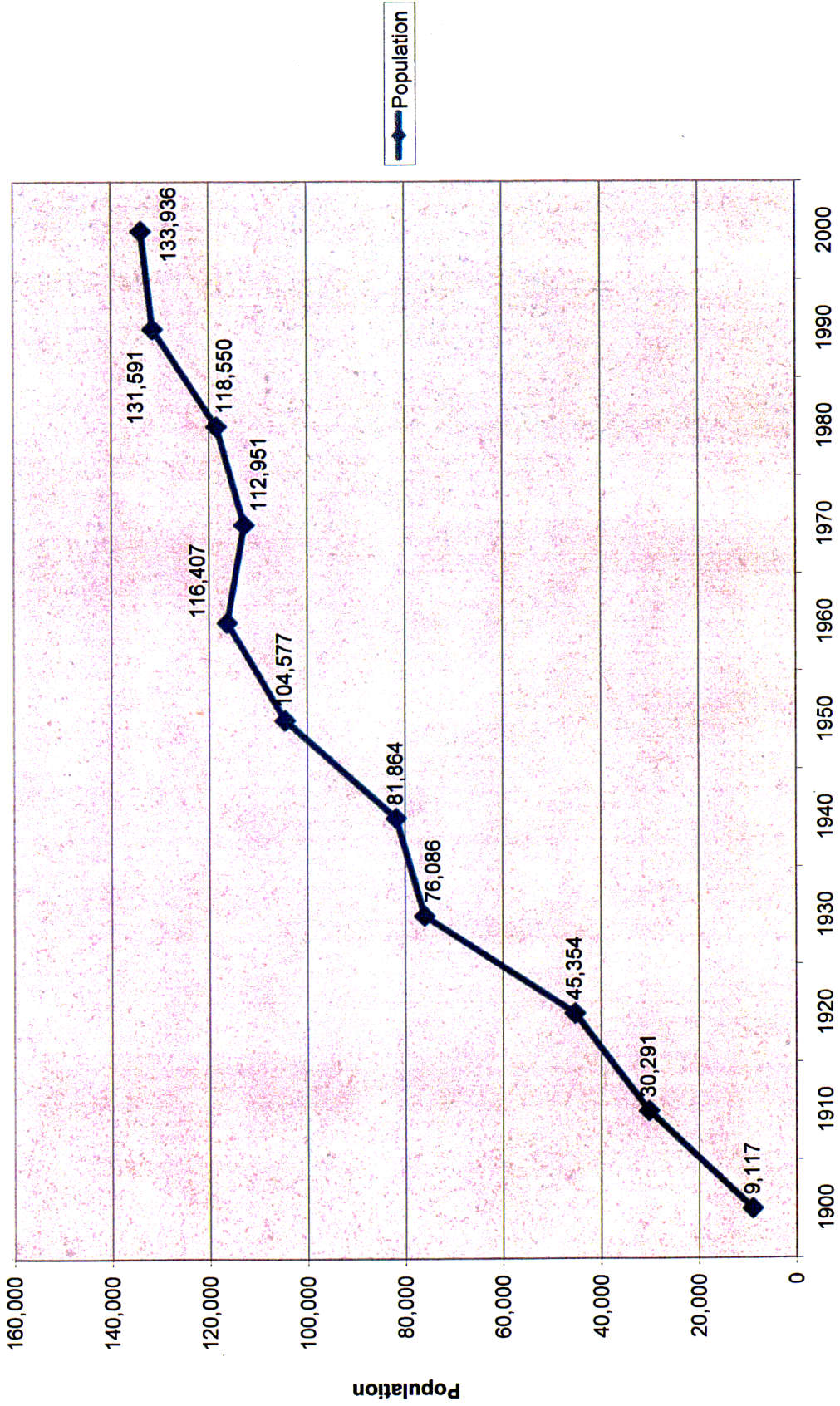

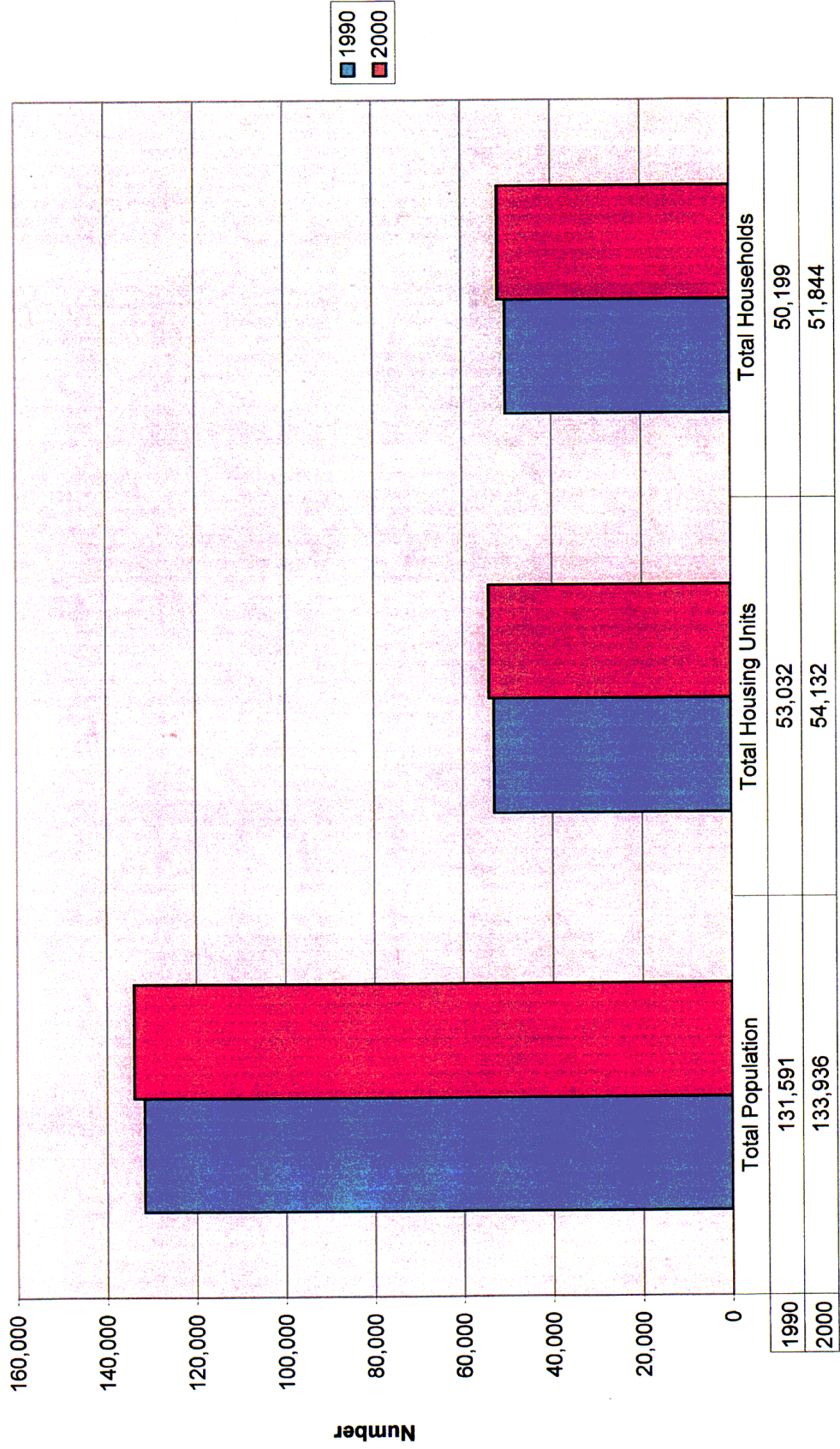

Pasadena Population 1900 - 2000



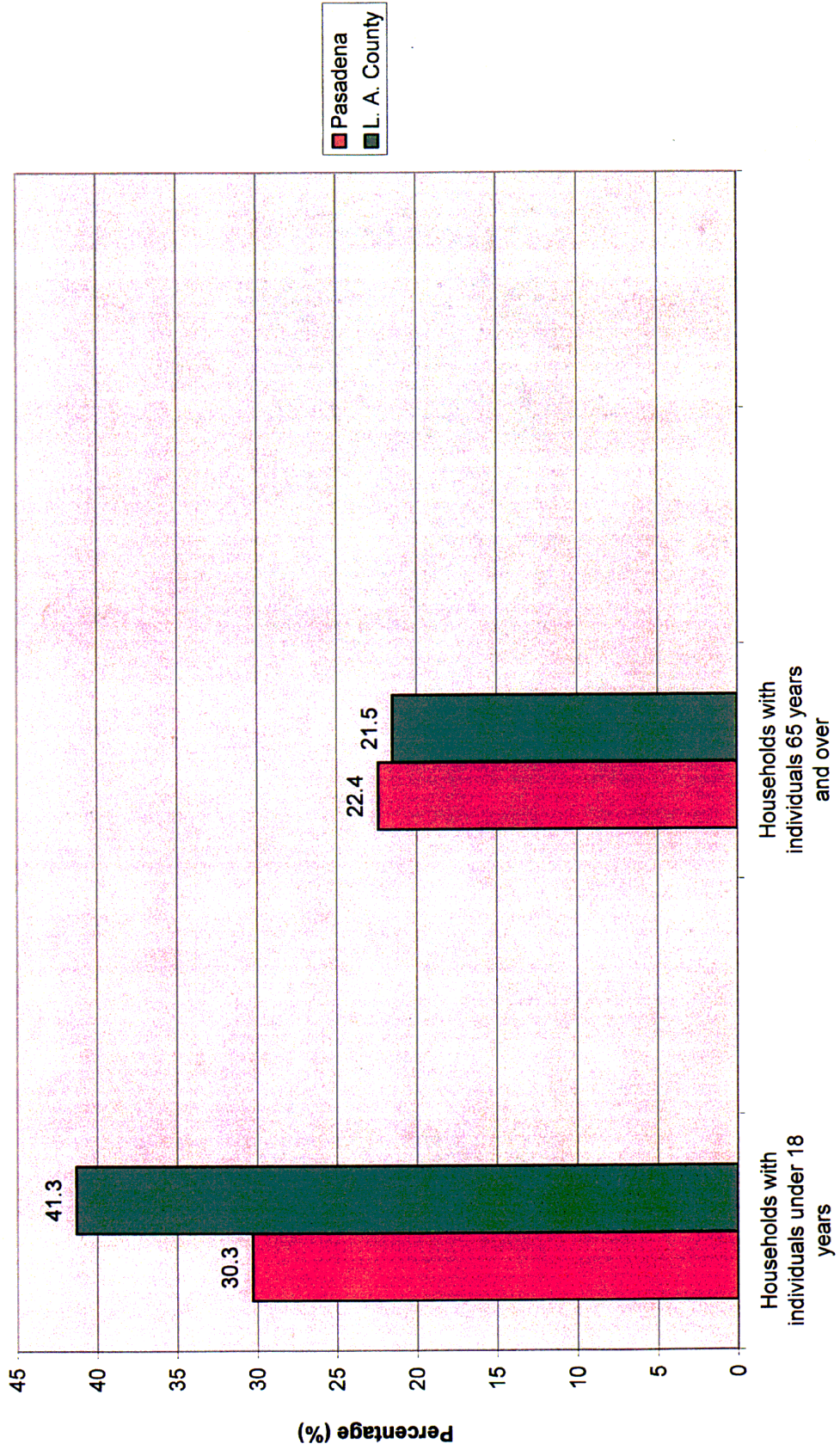
**Population, Housing Units, and Households

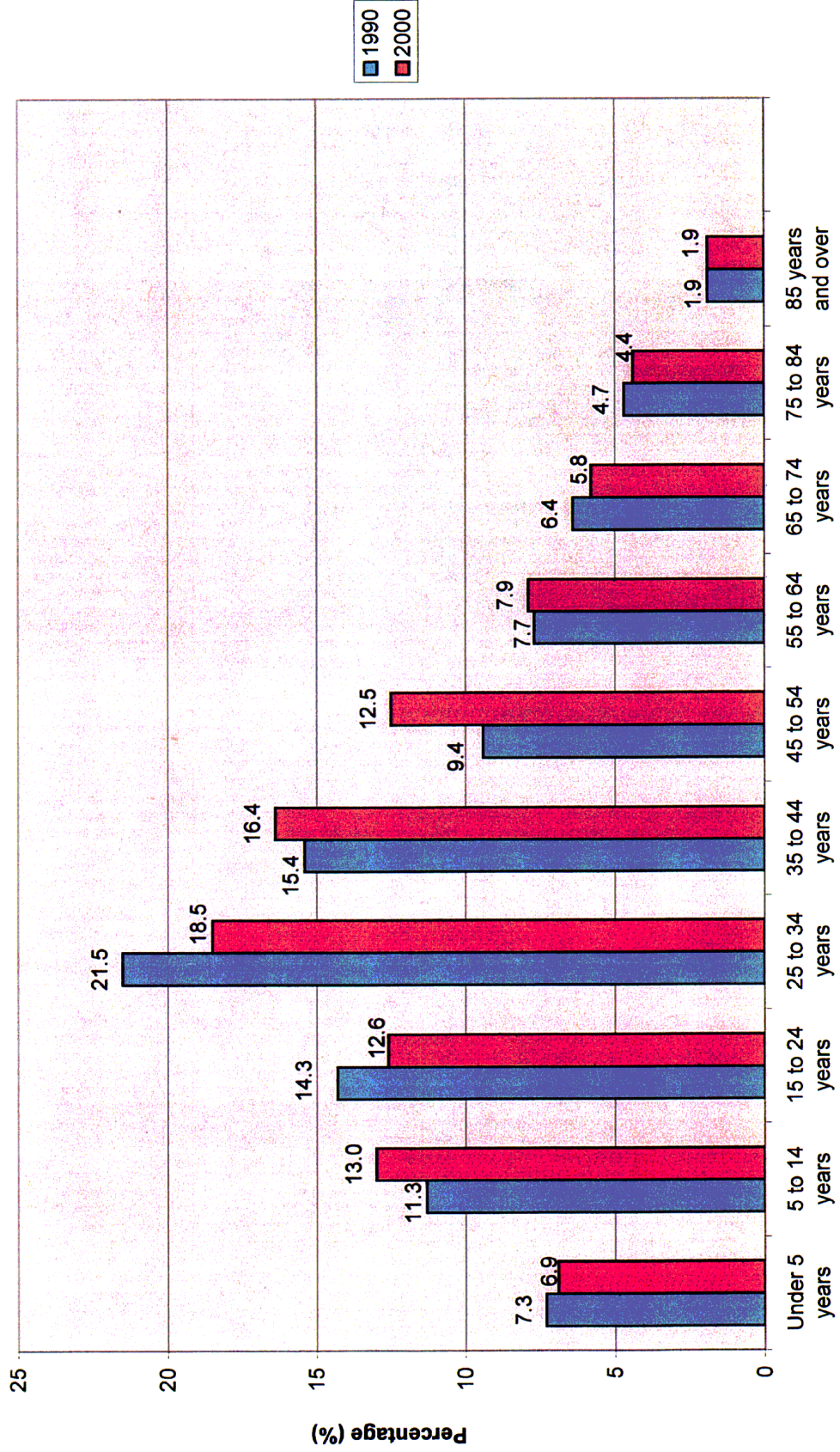

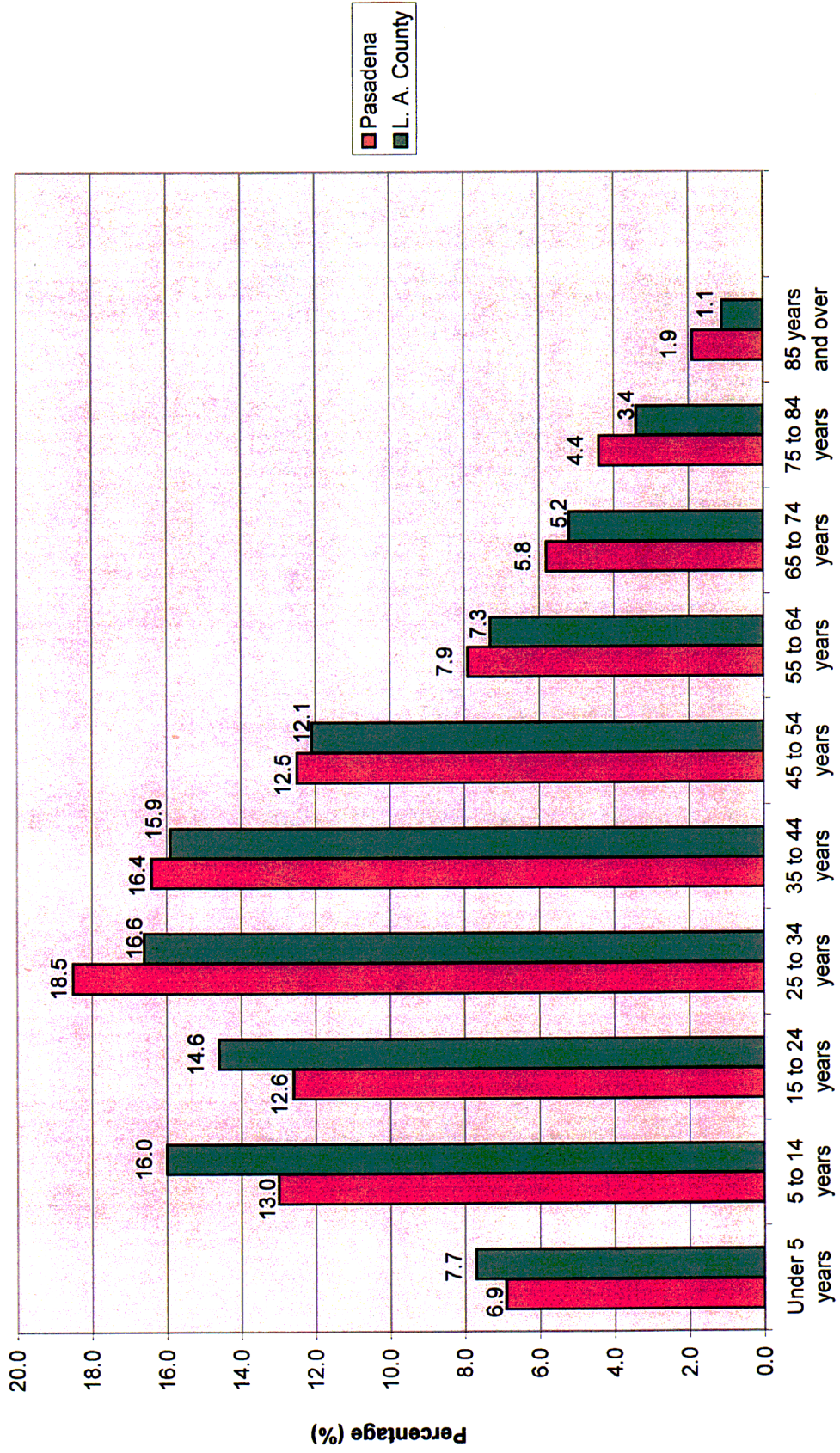

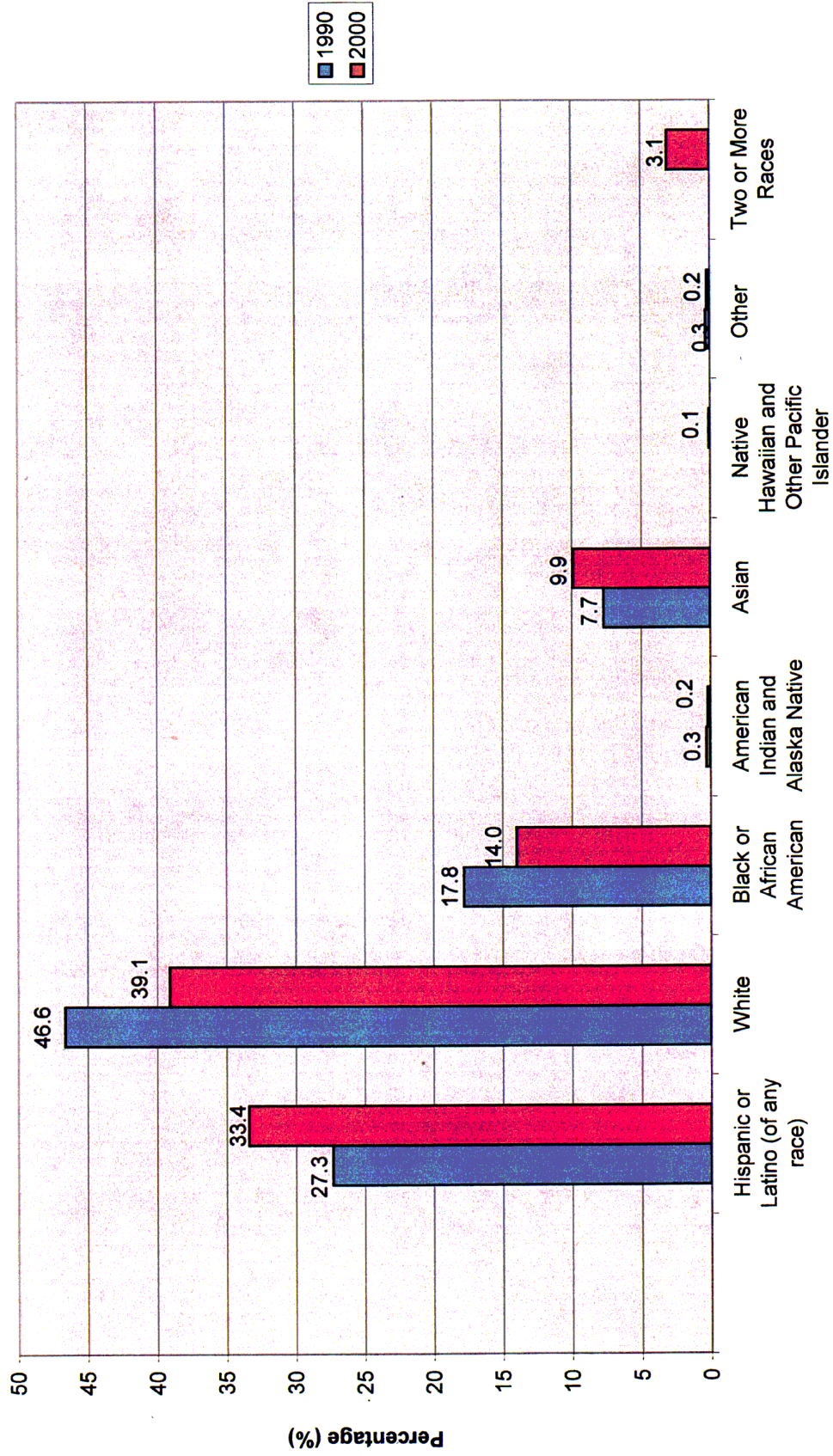

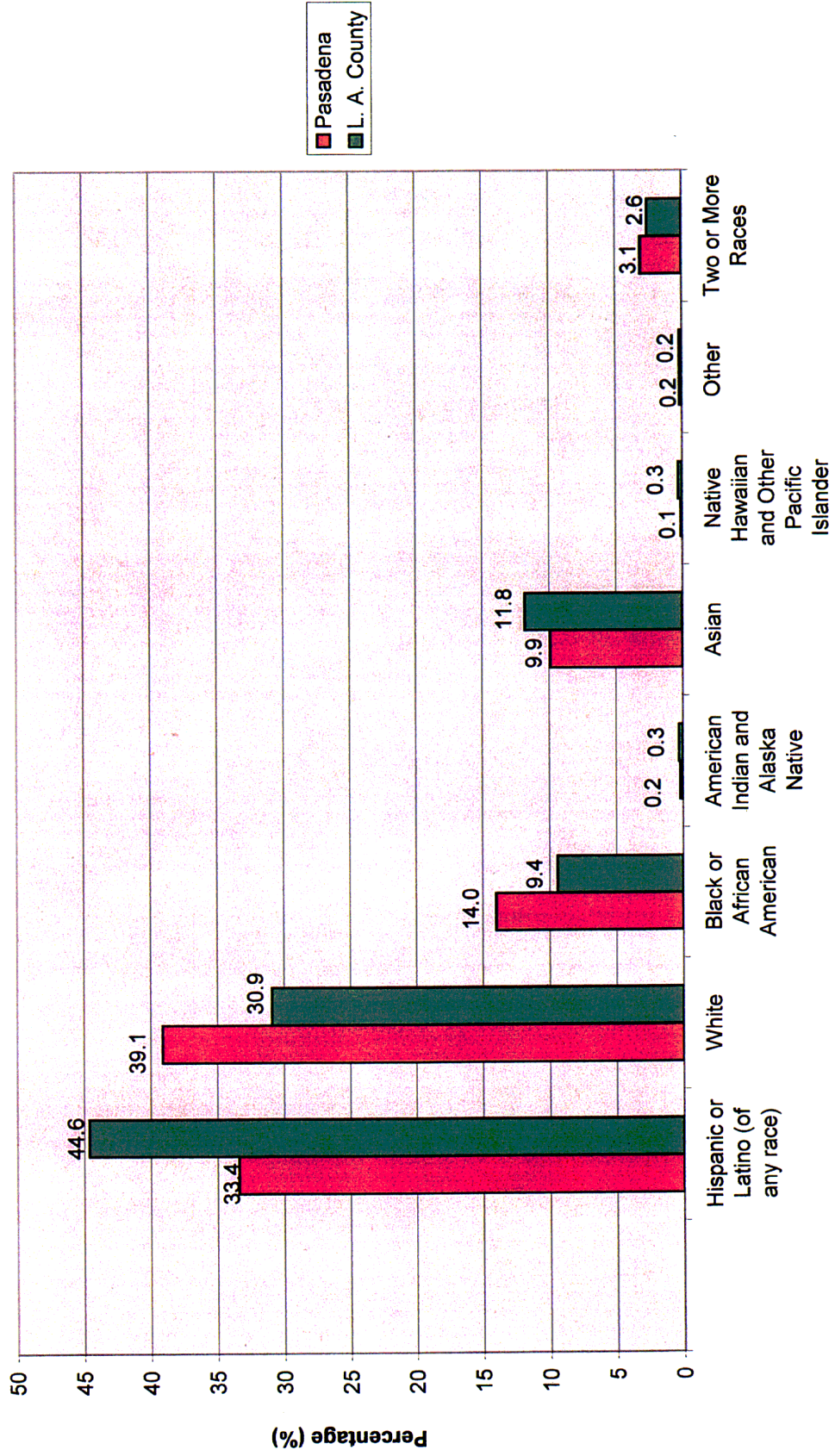

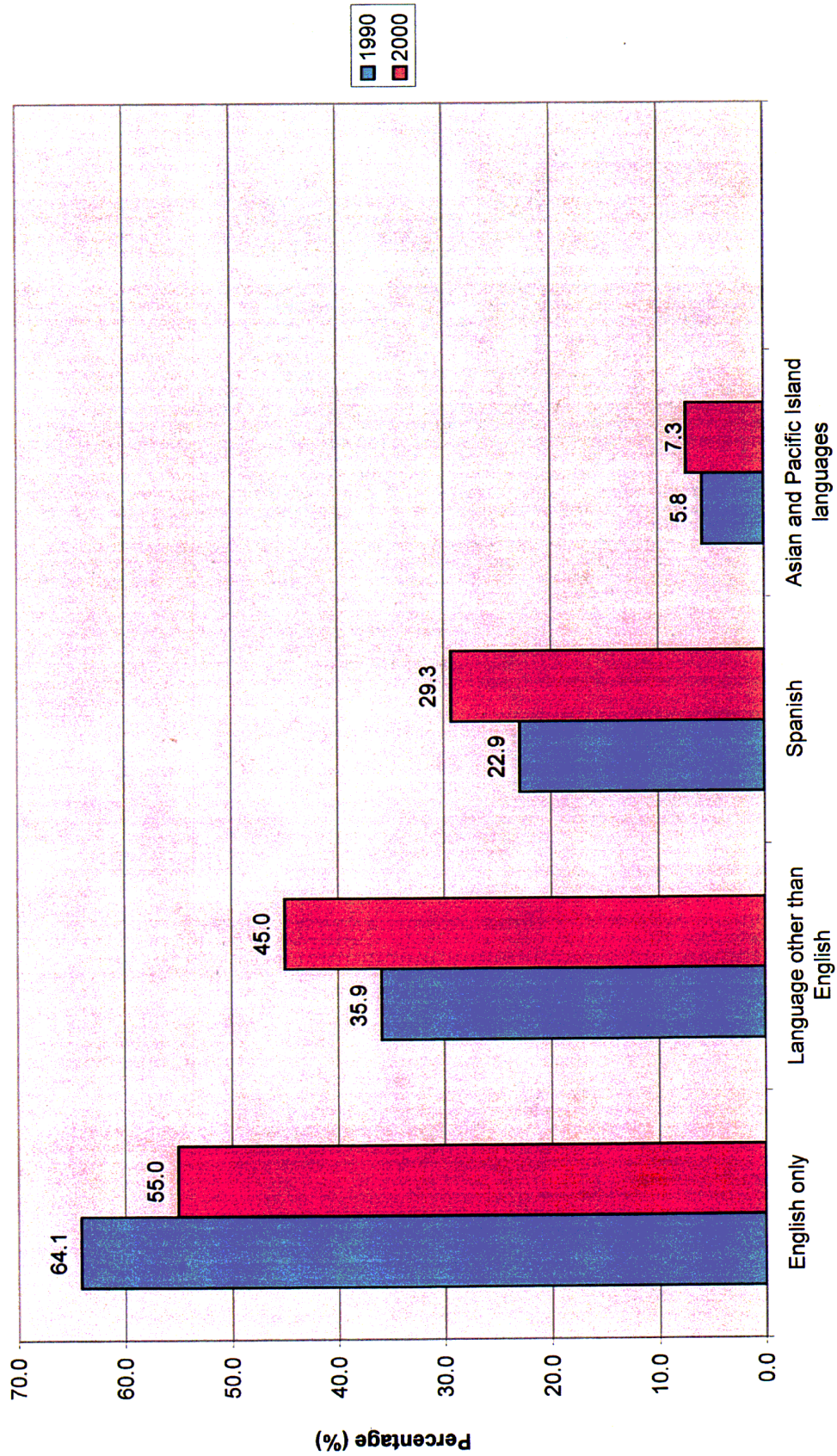

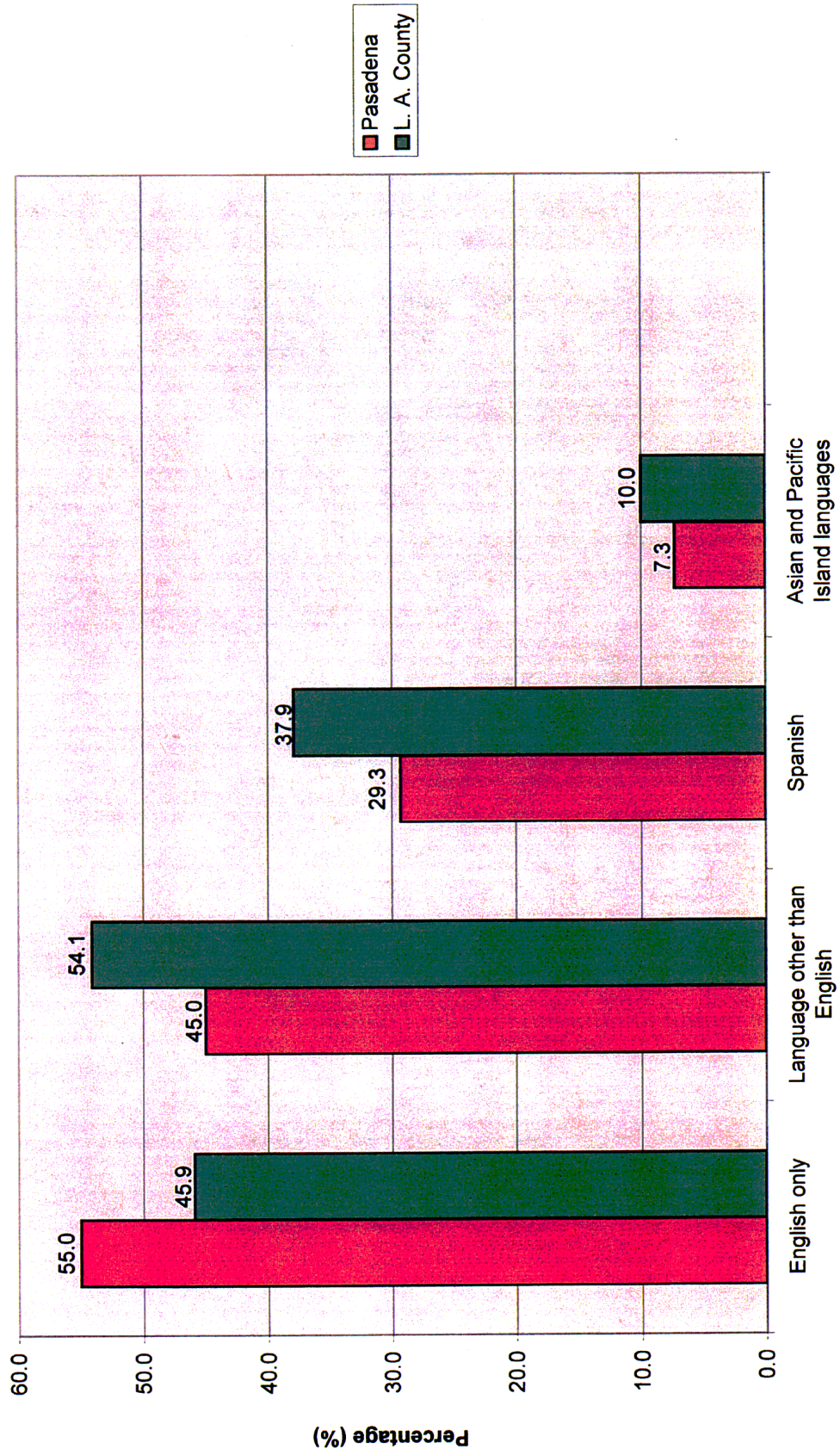

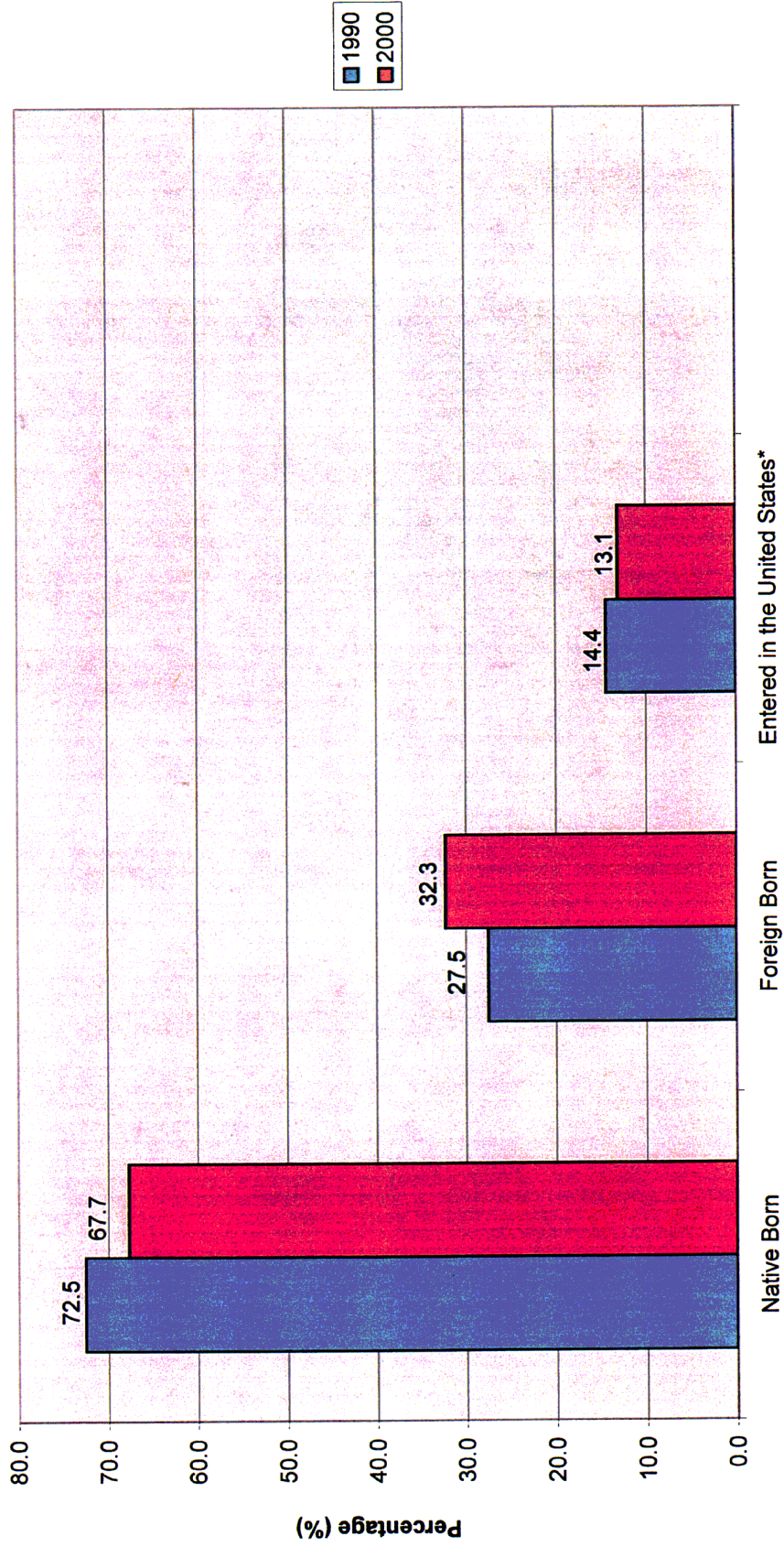

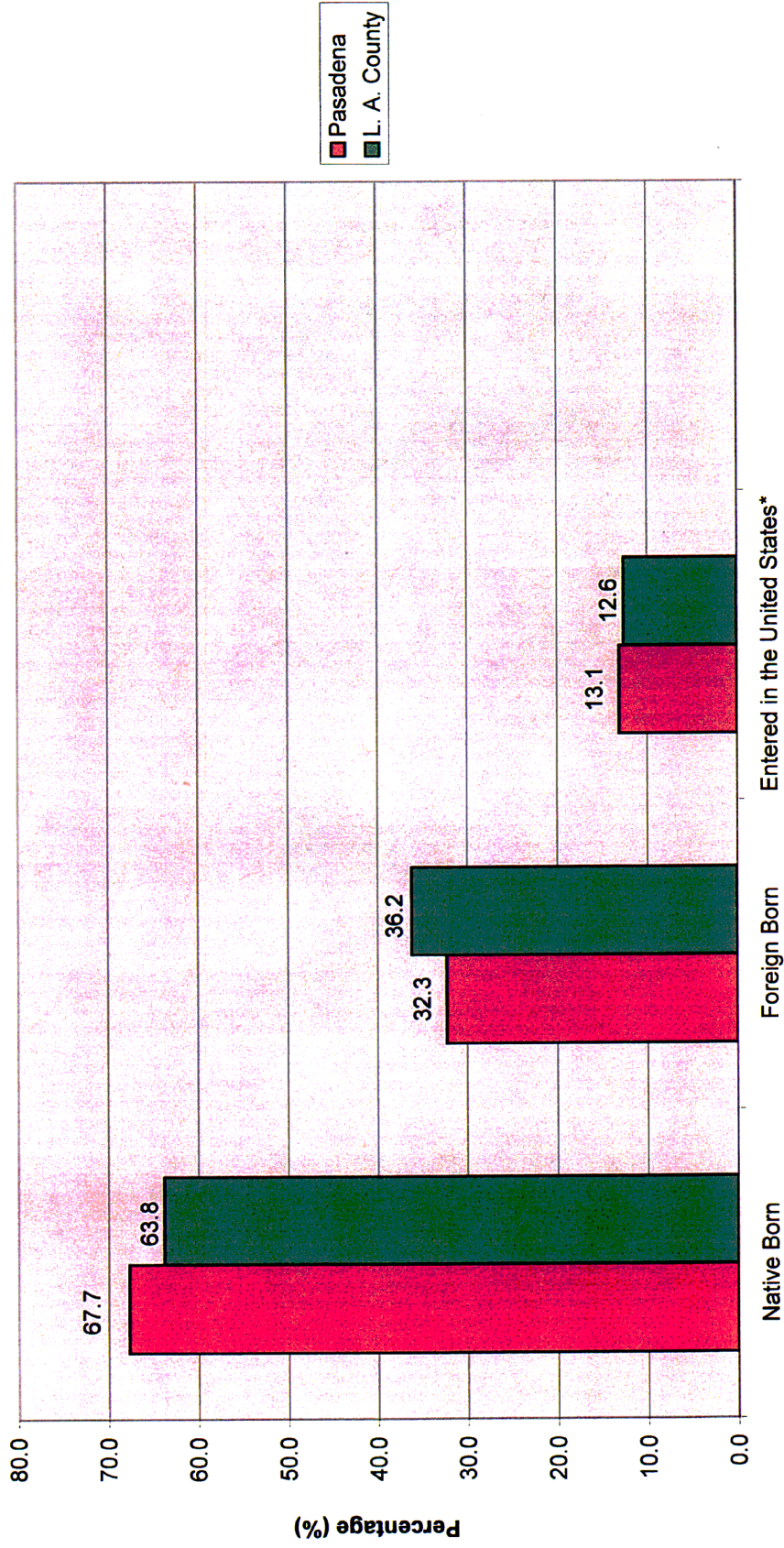

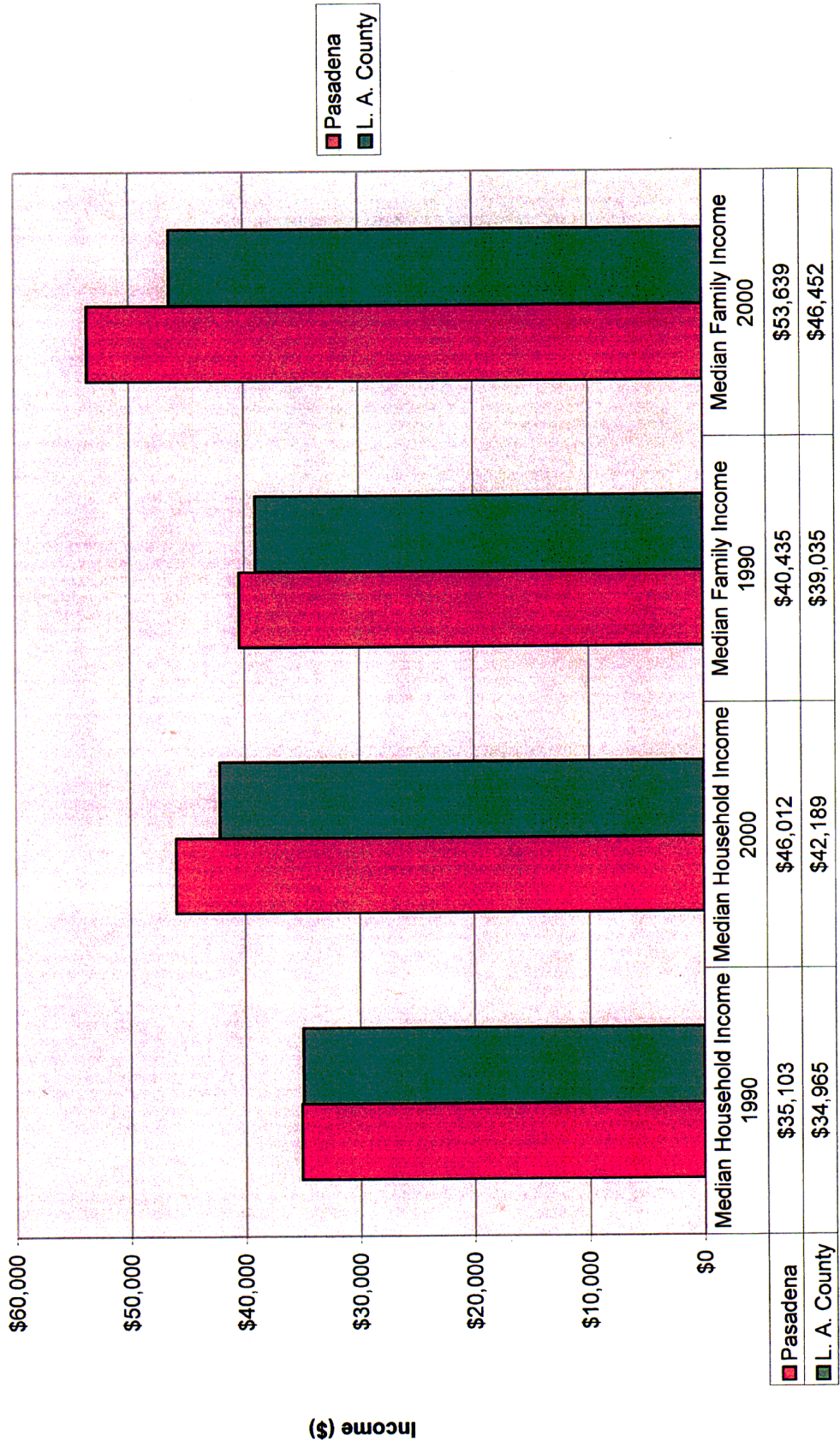

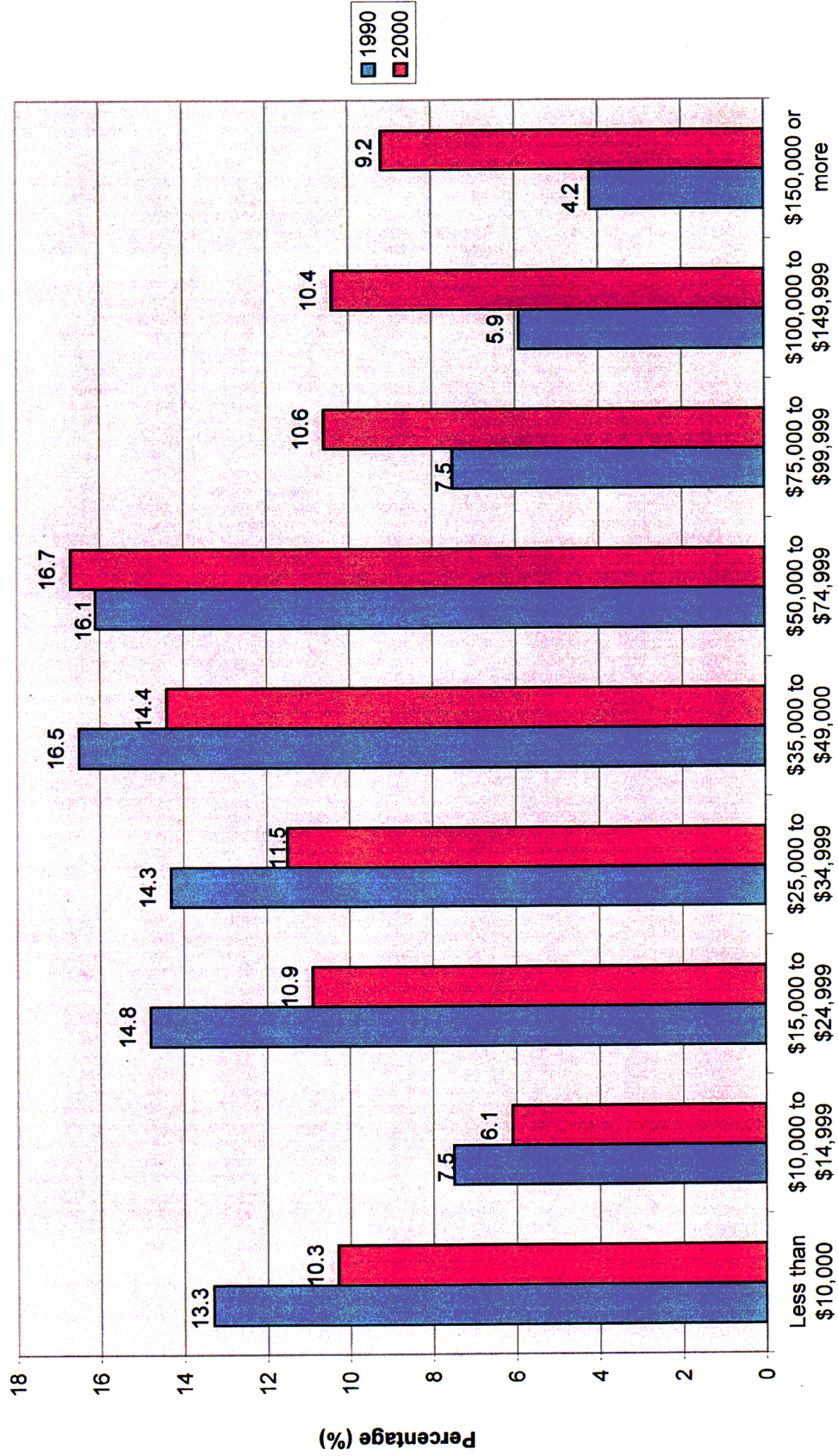

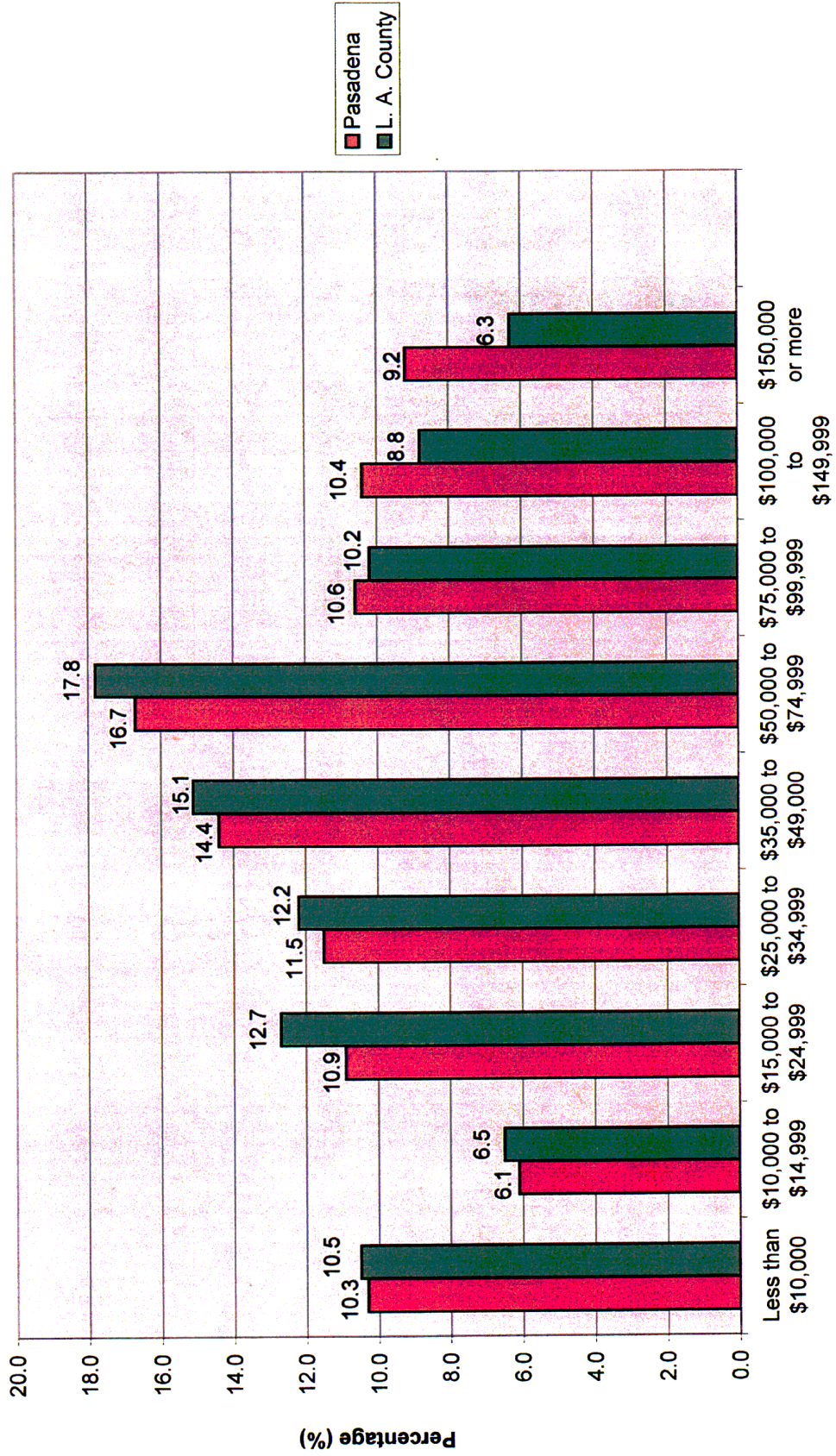
**Median Household Income and Median Family Income

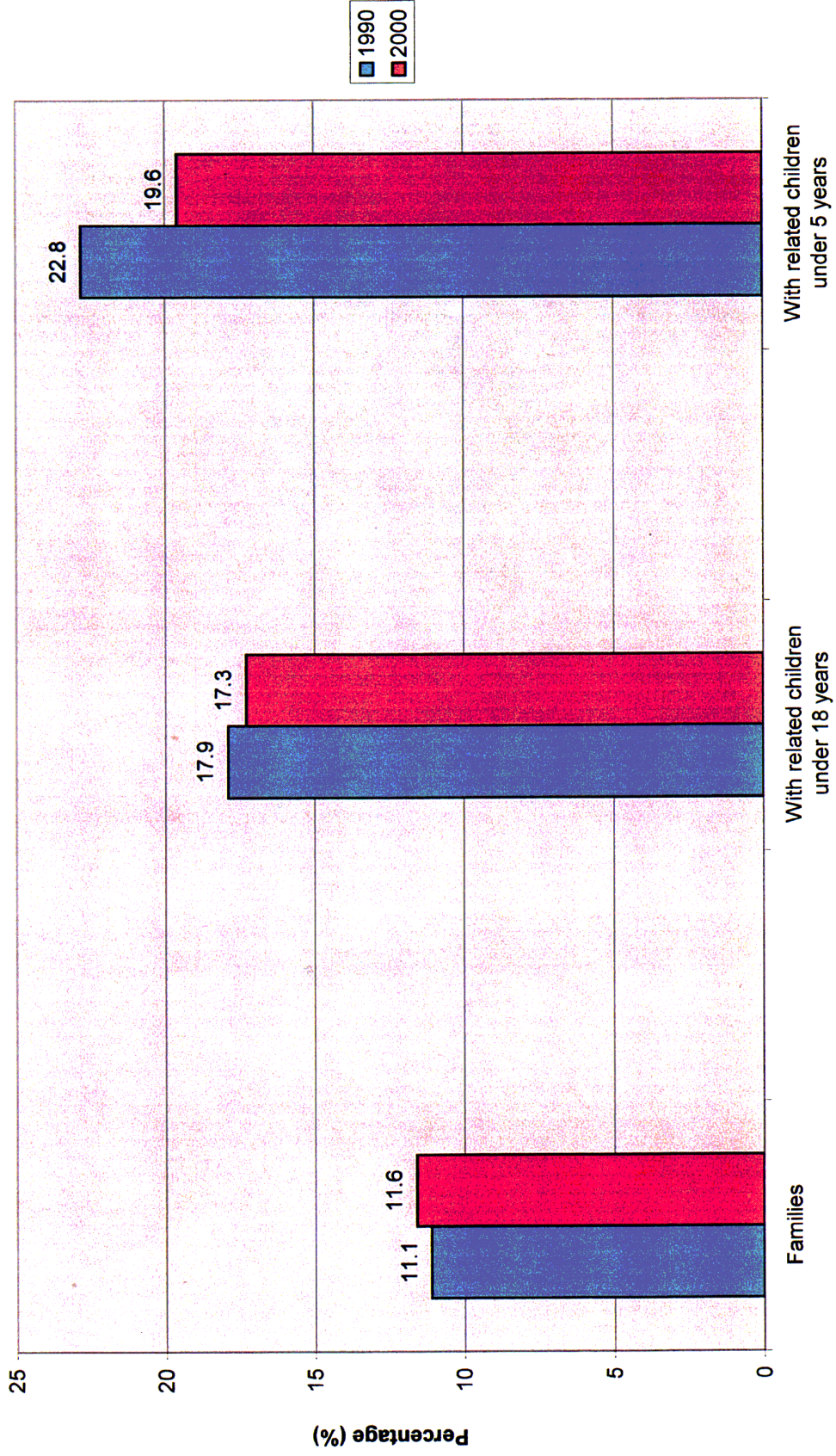

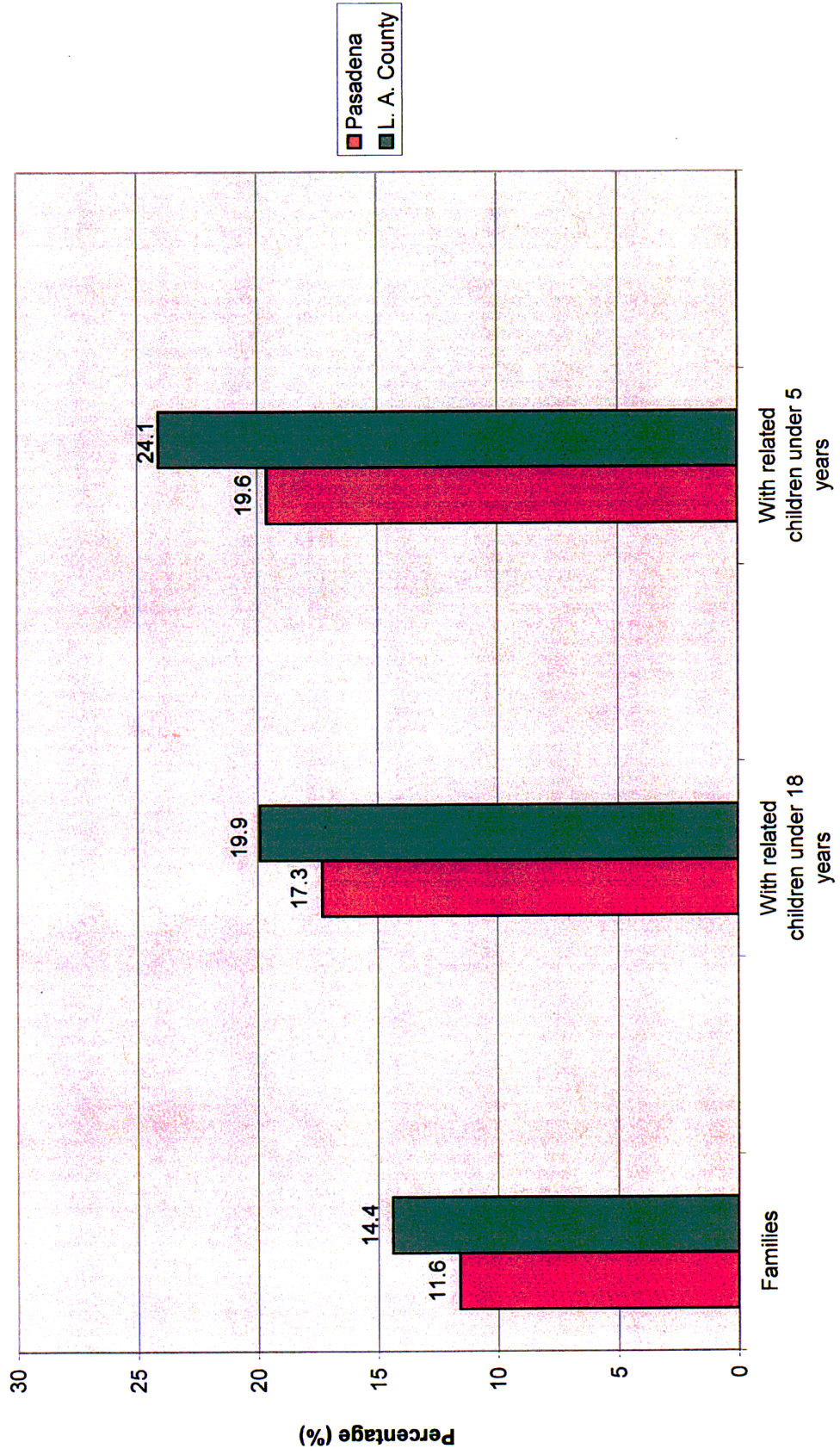

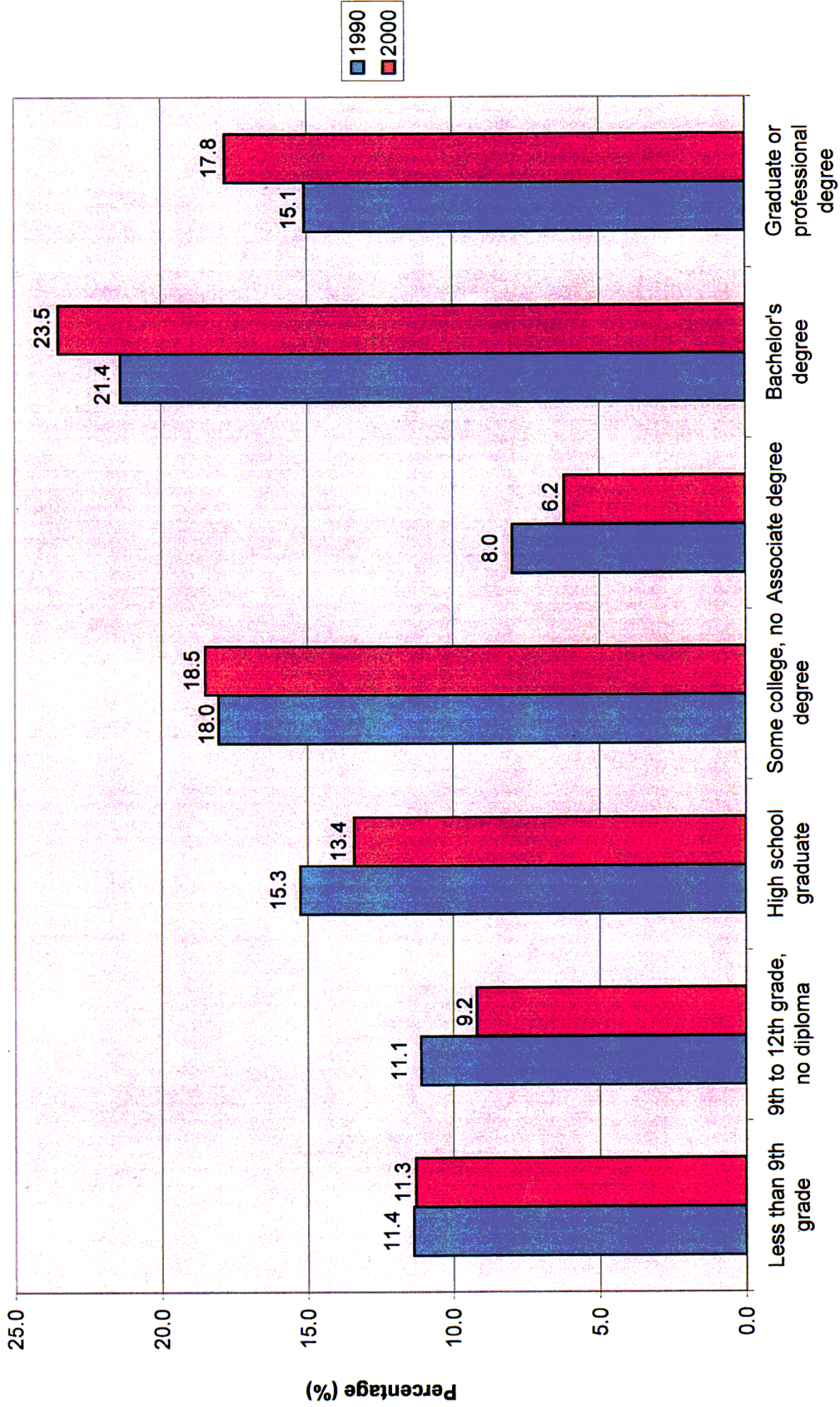

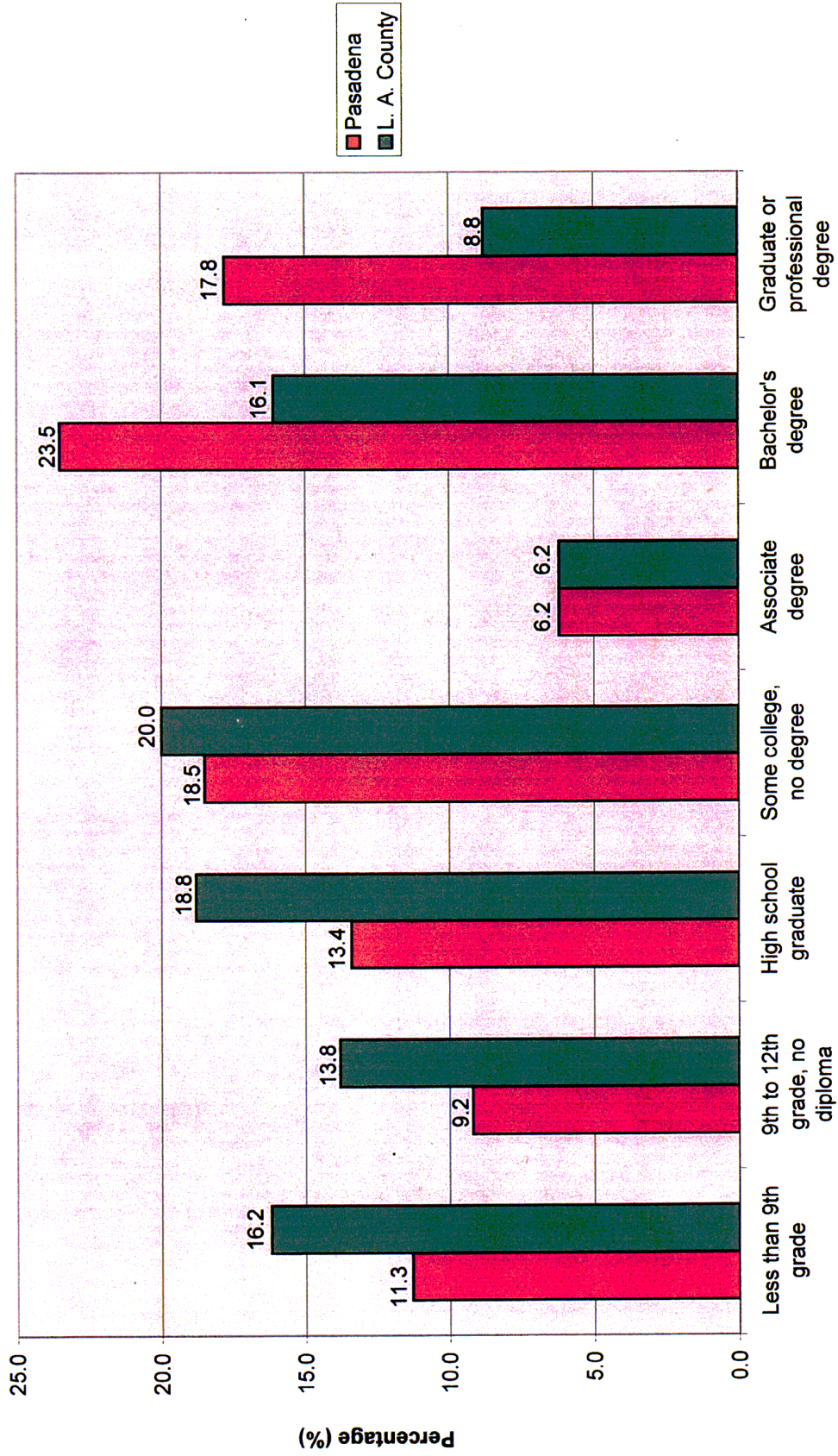

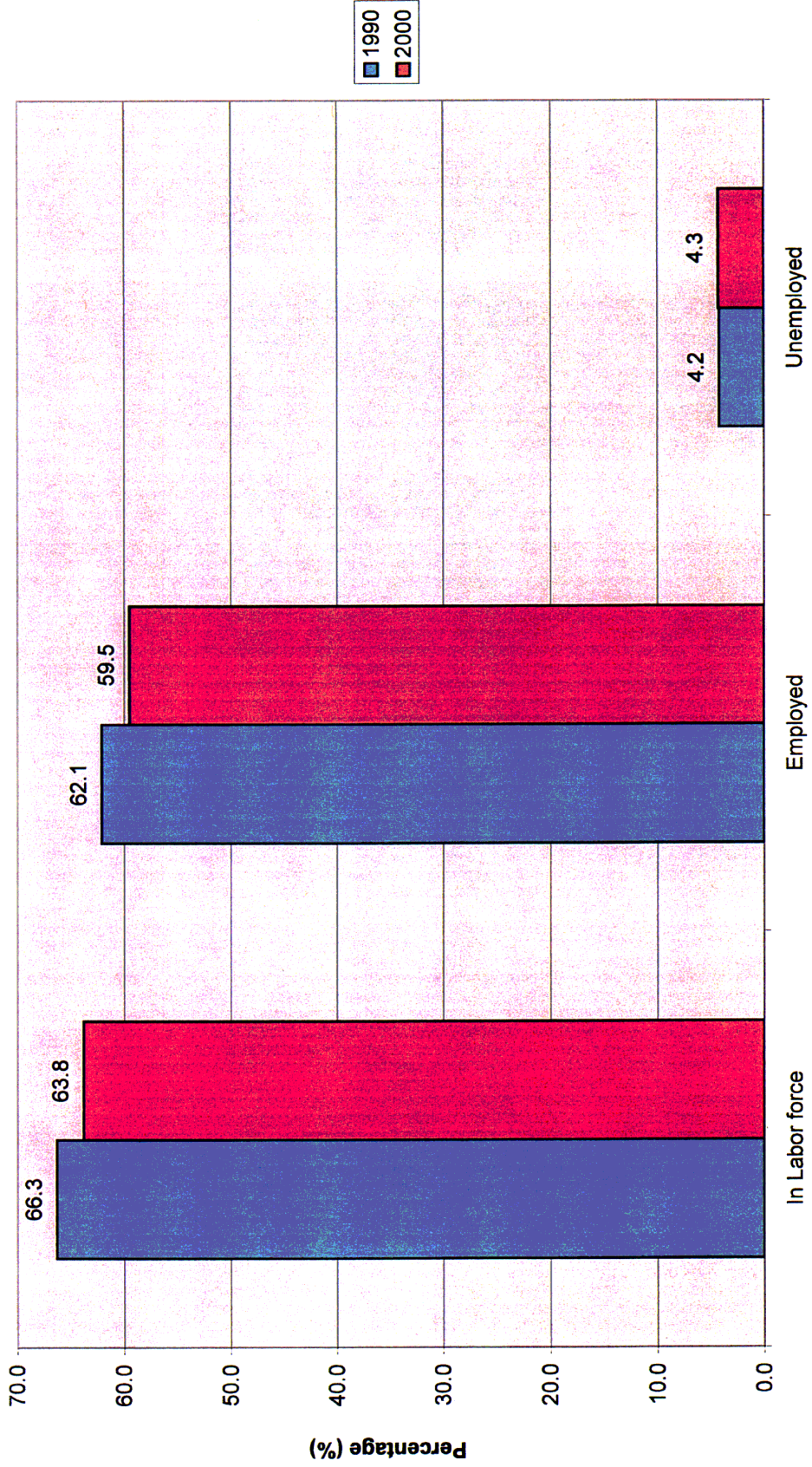

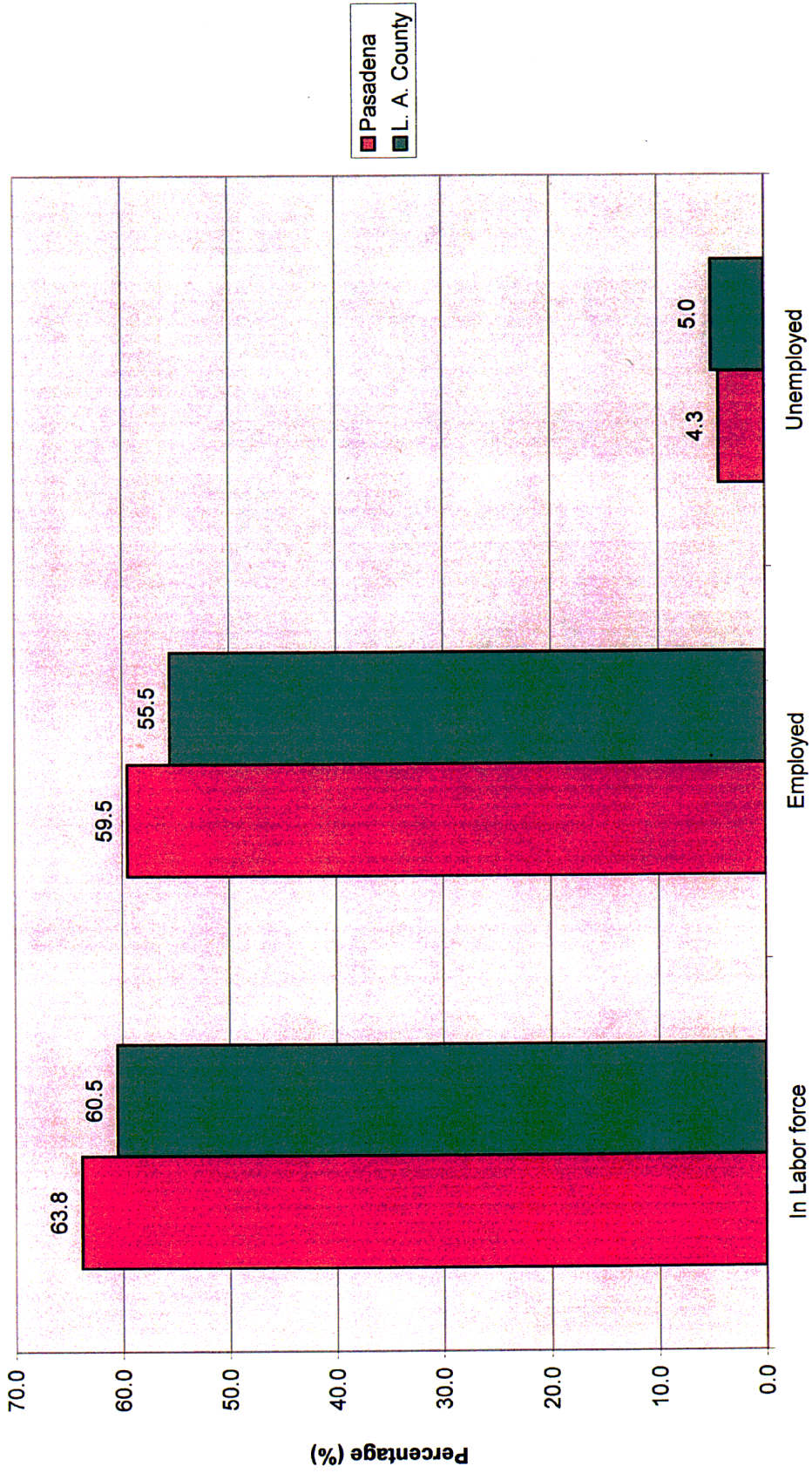

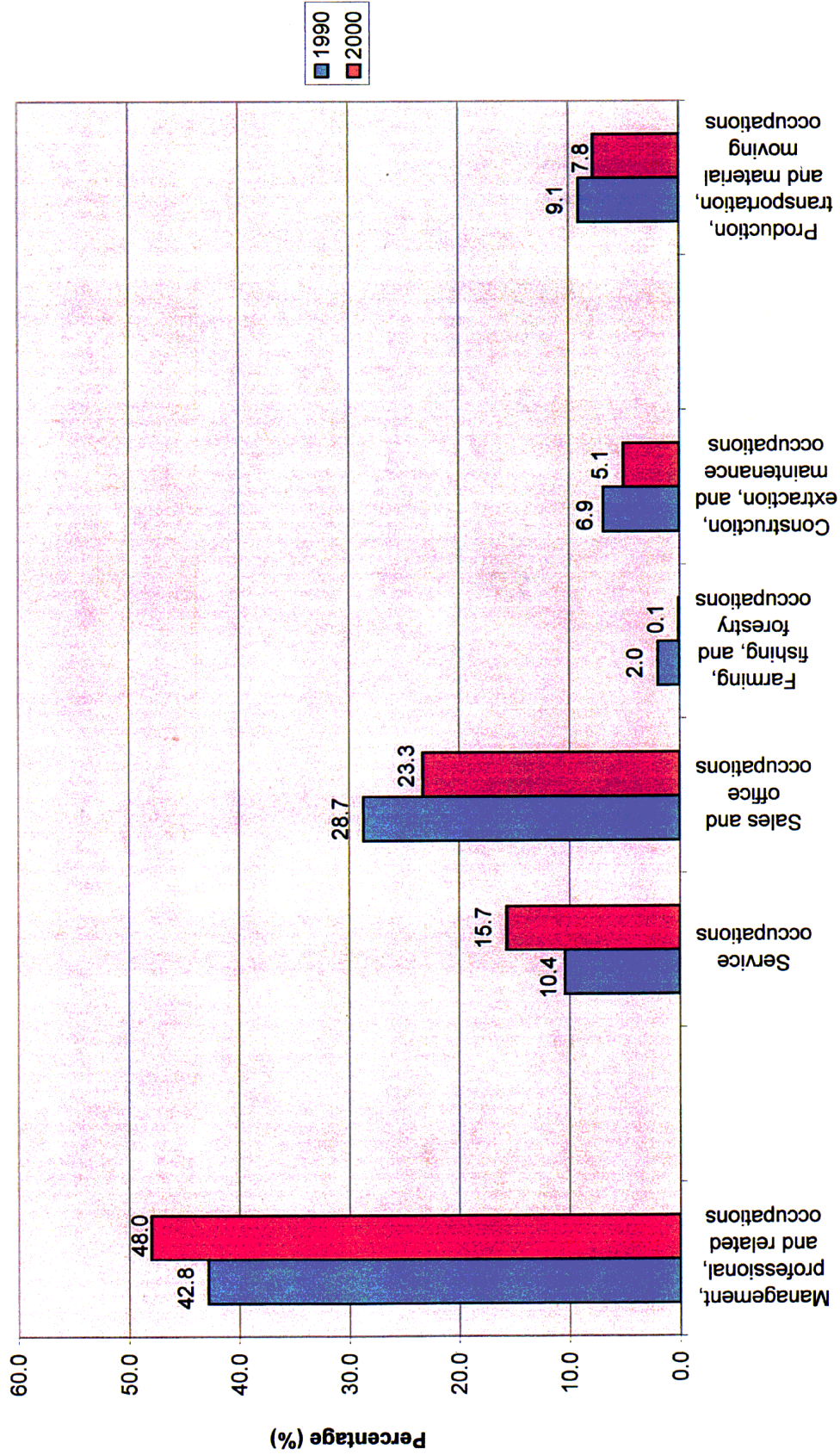

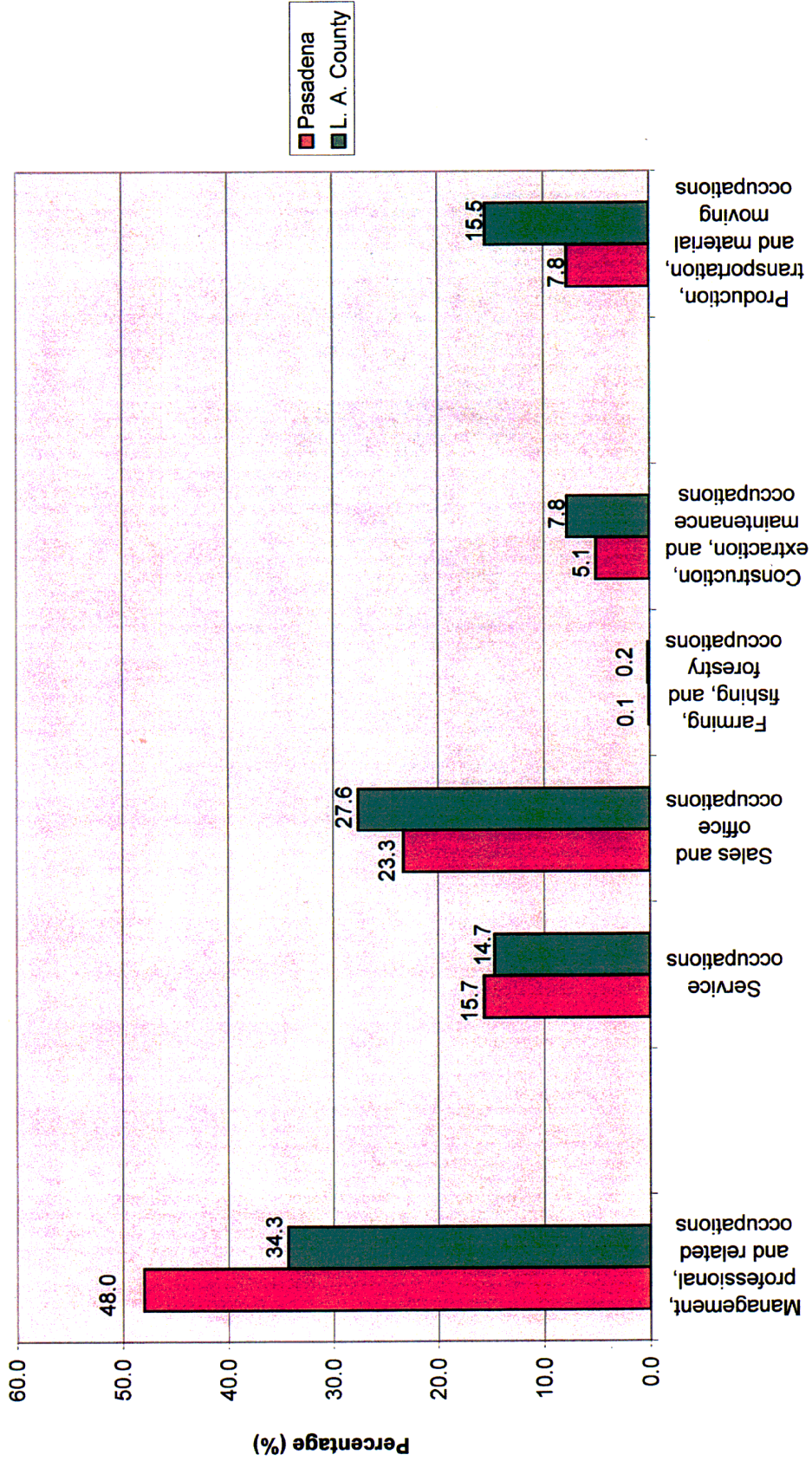

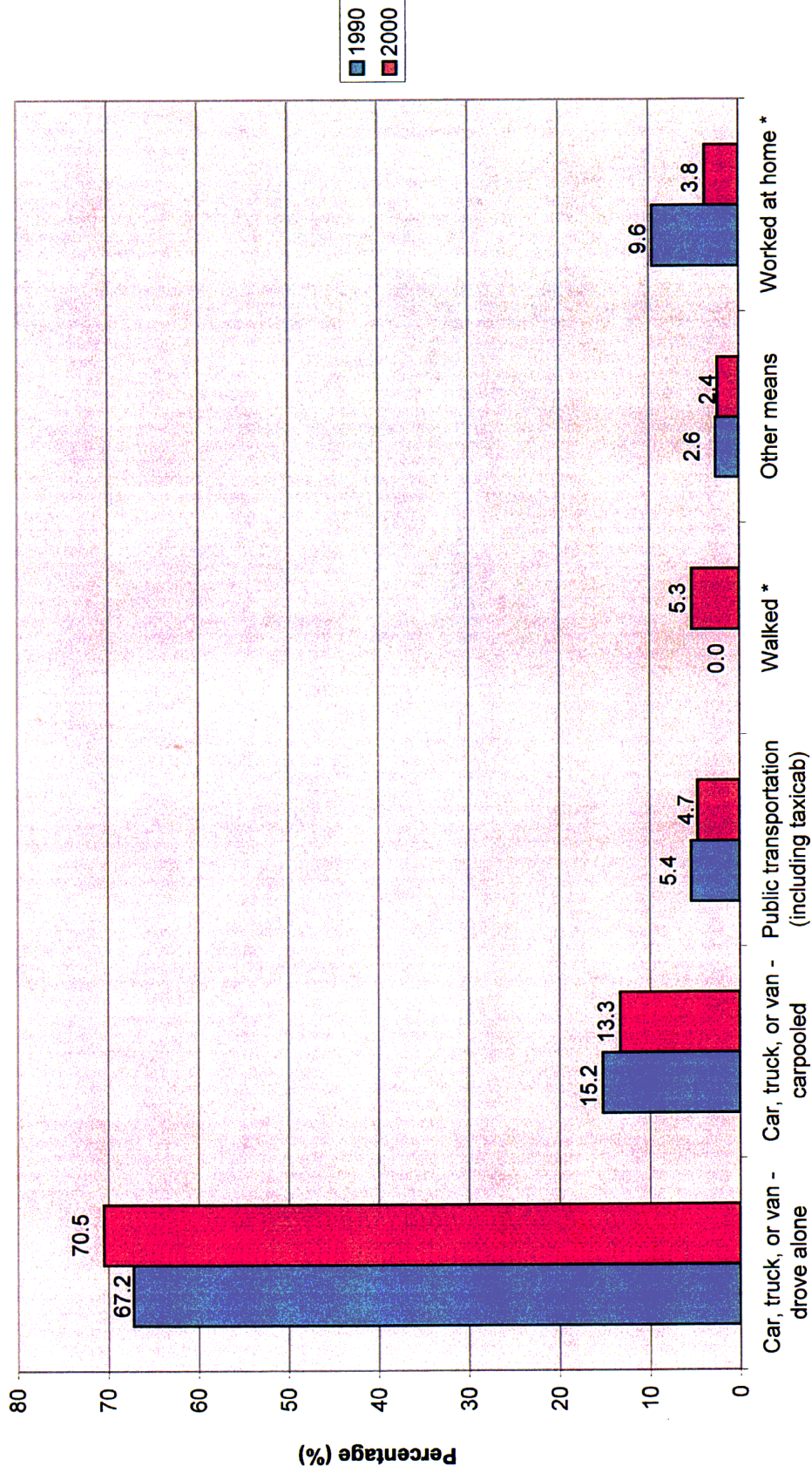

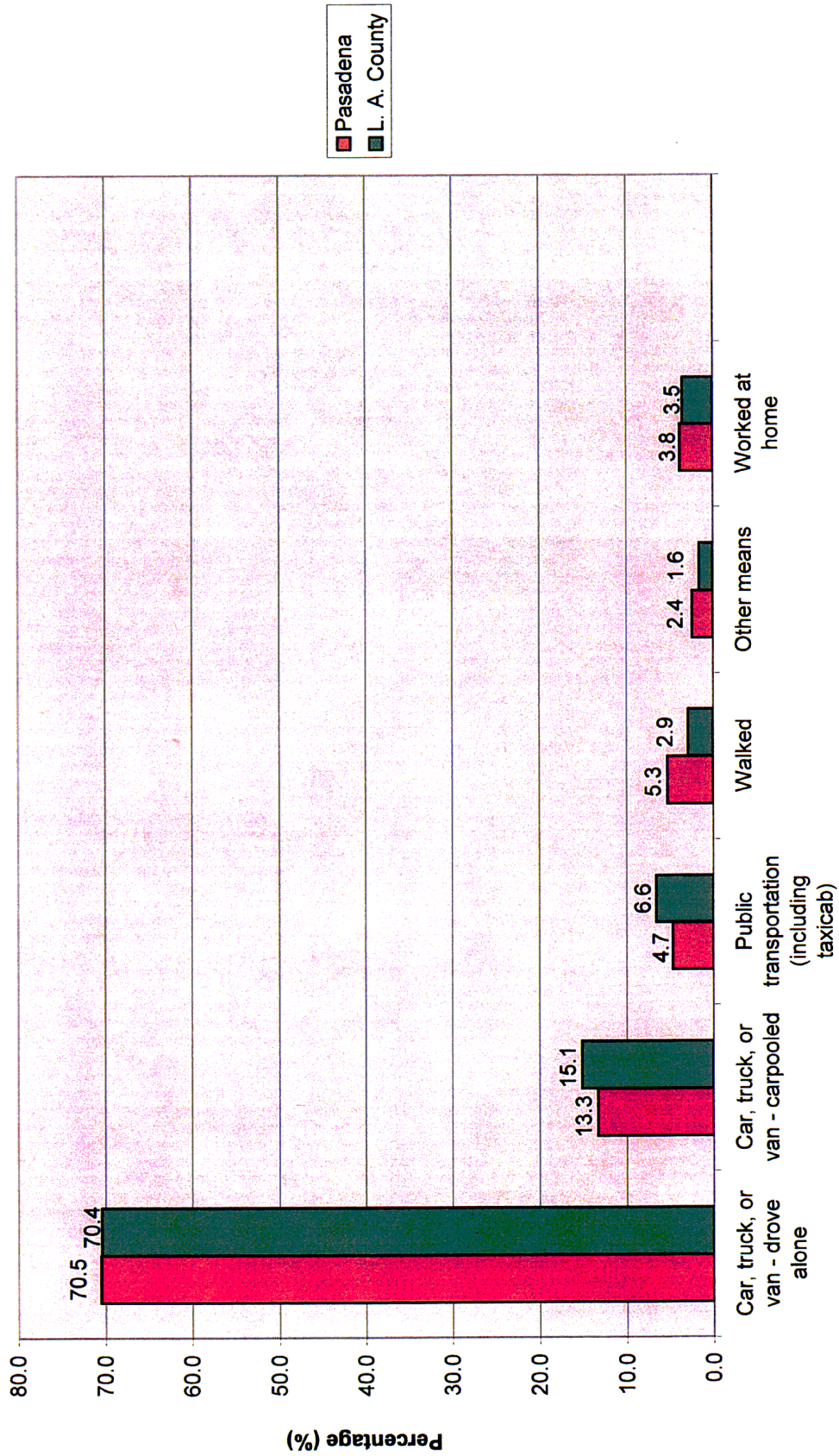

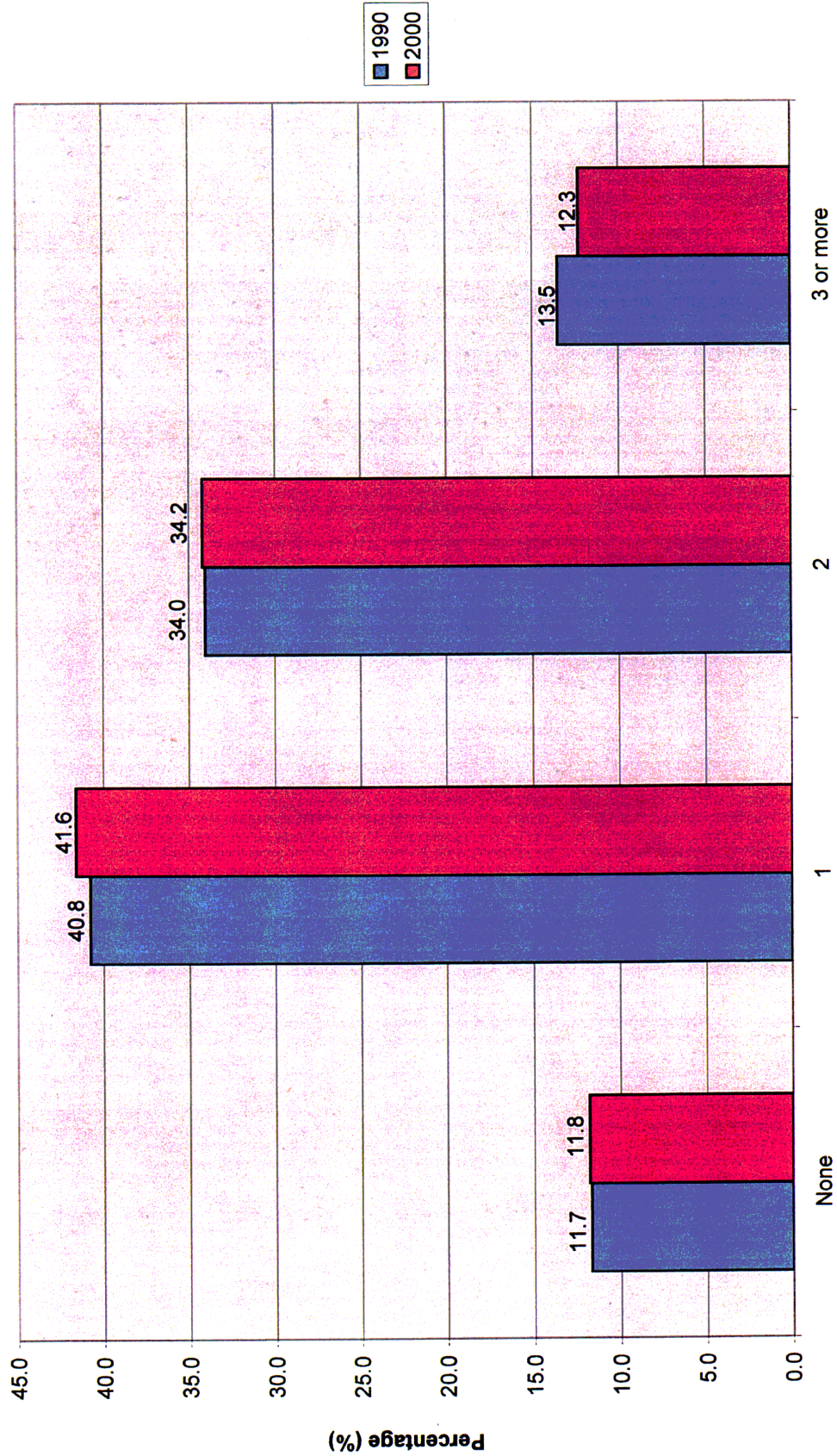

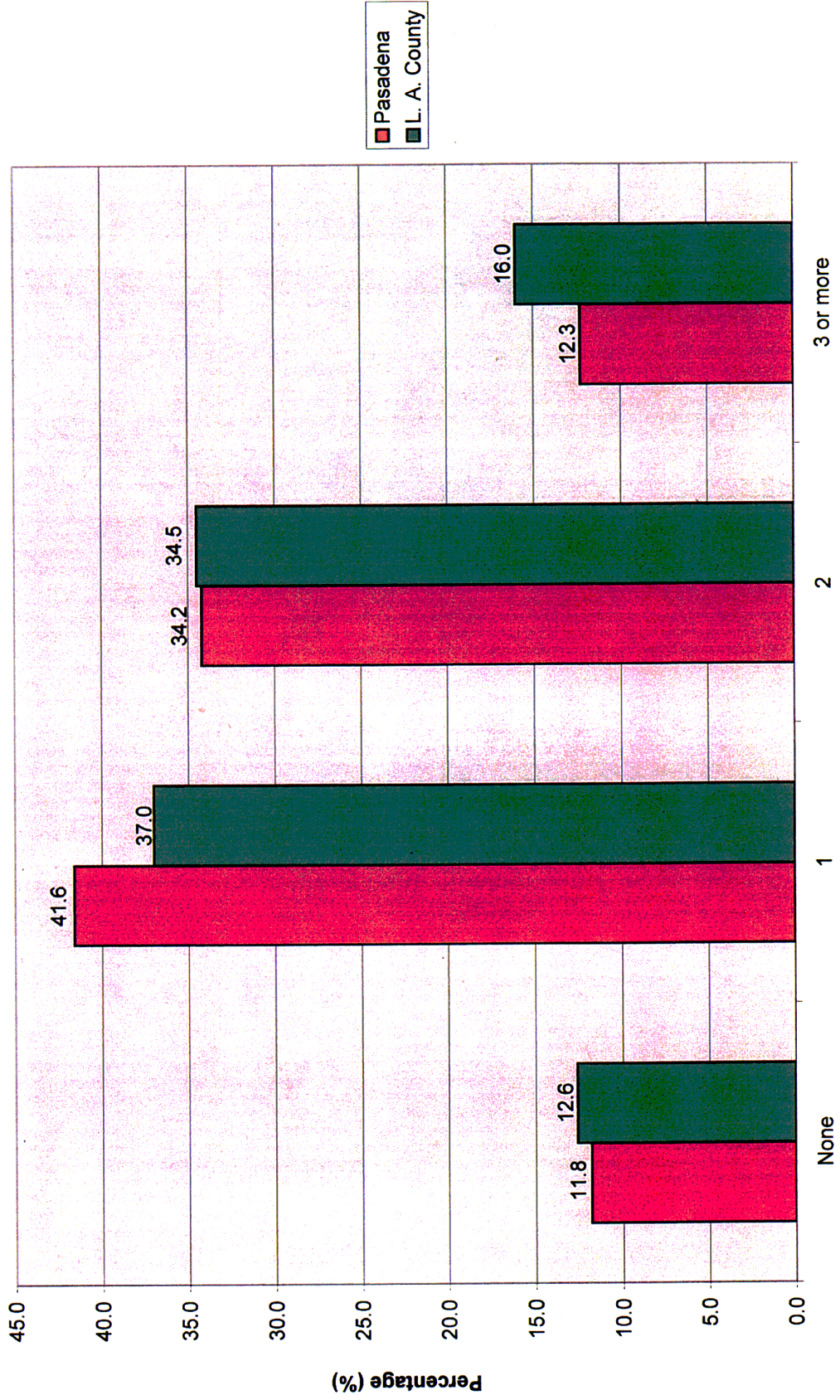

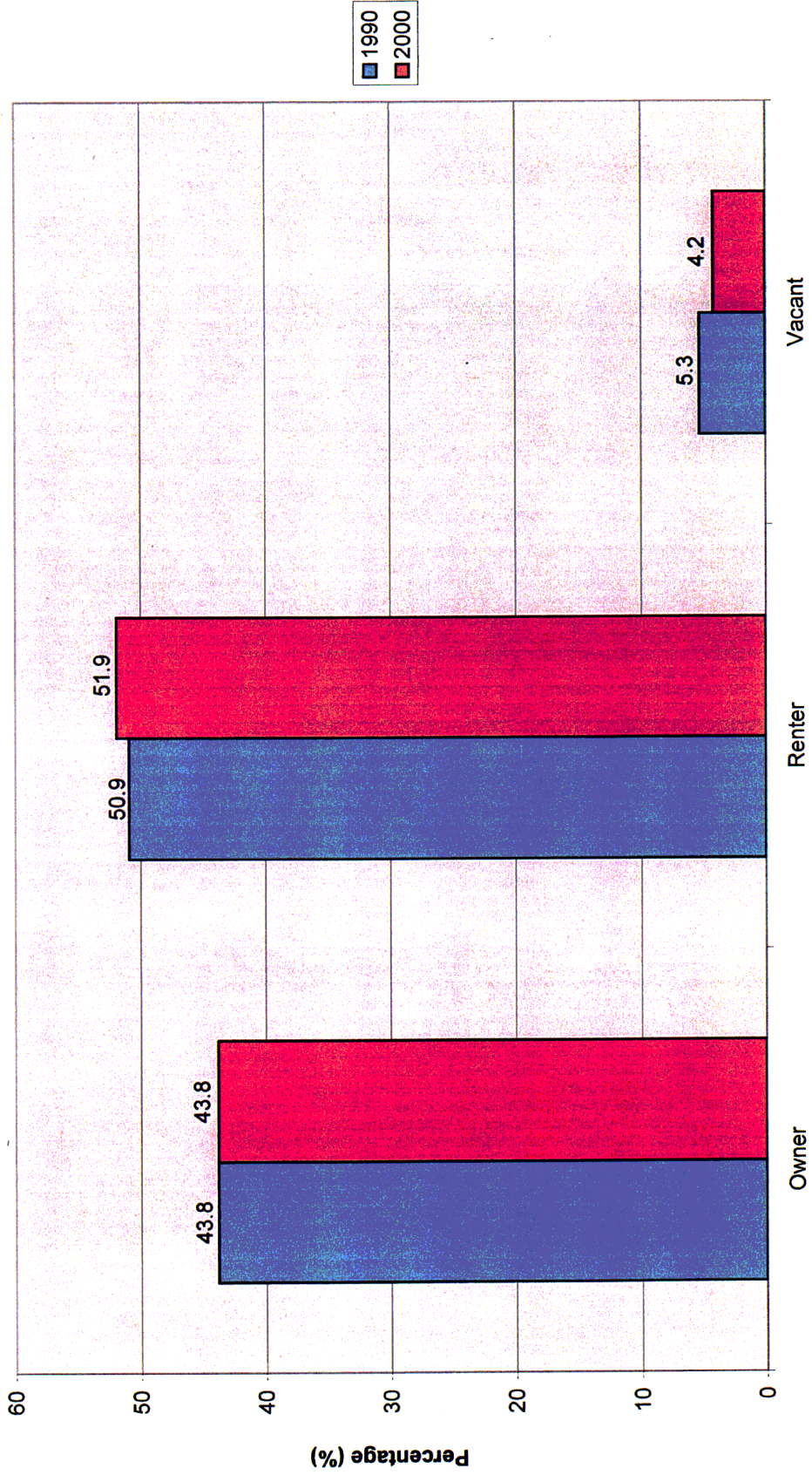

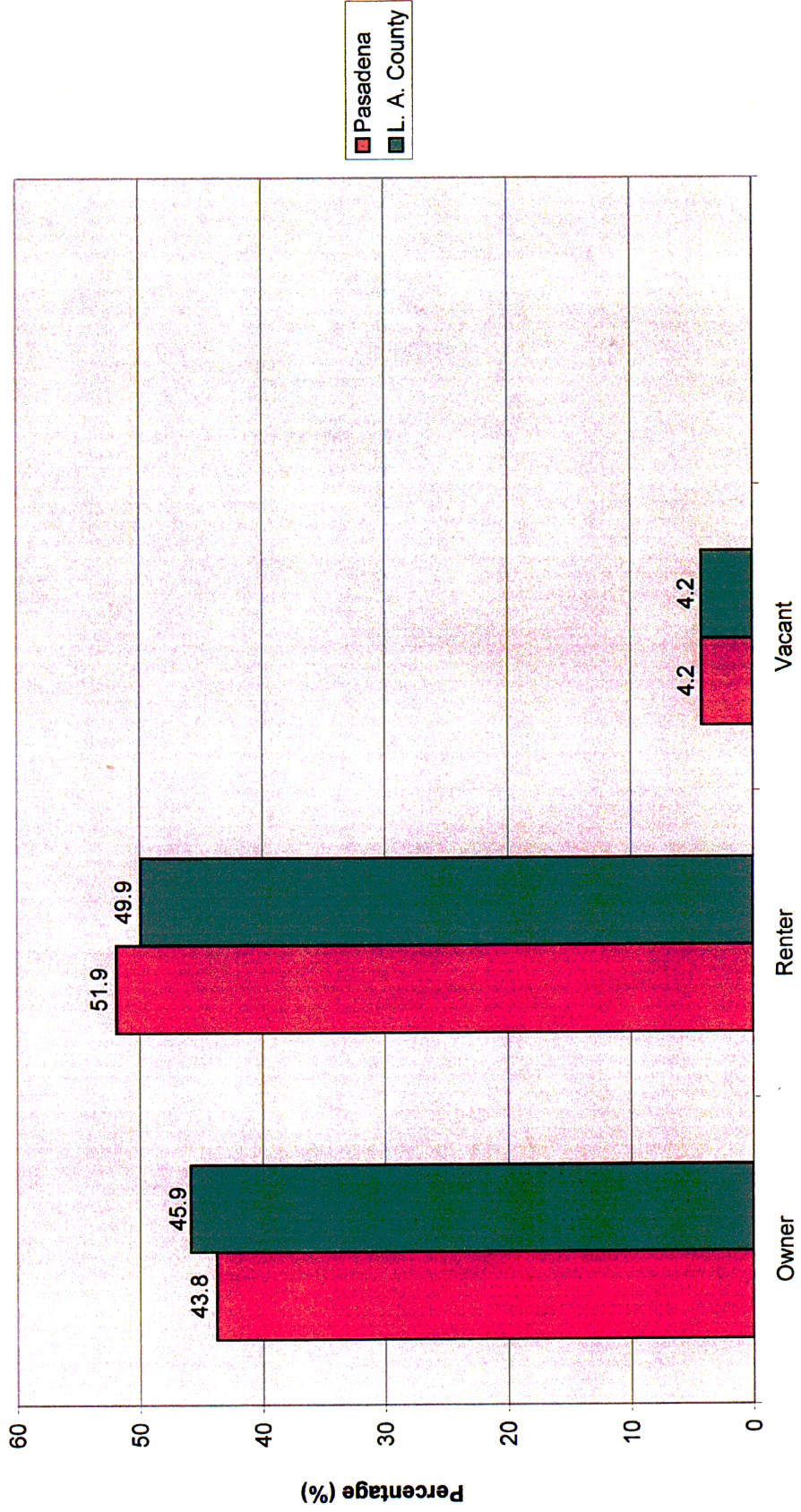

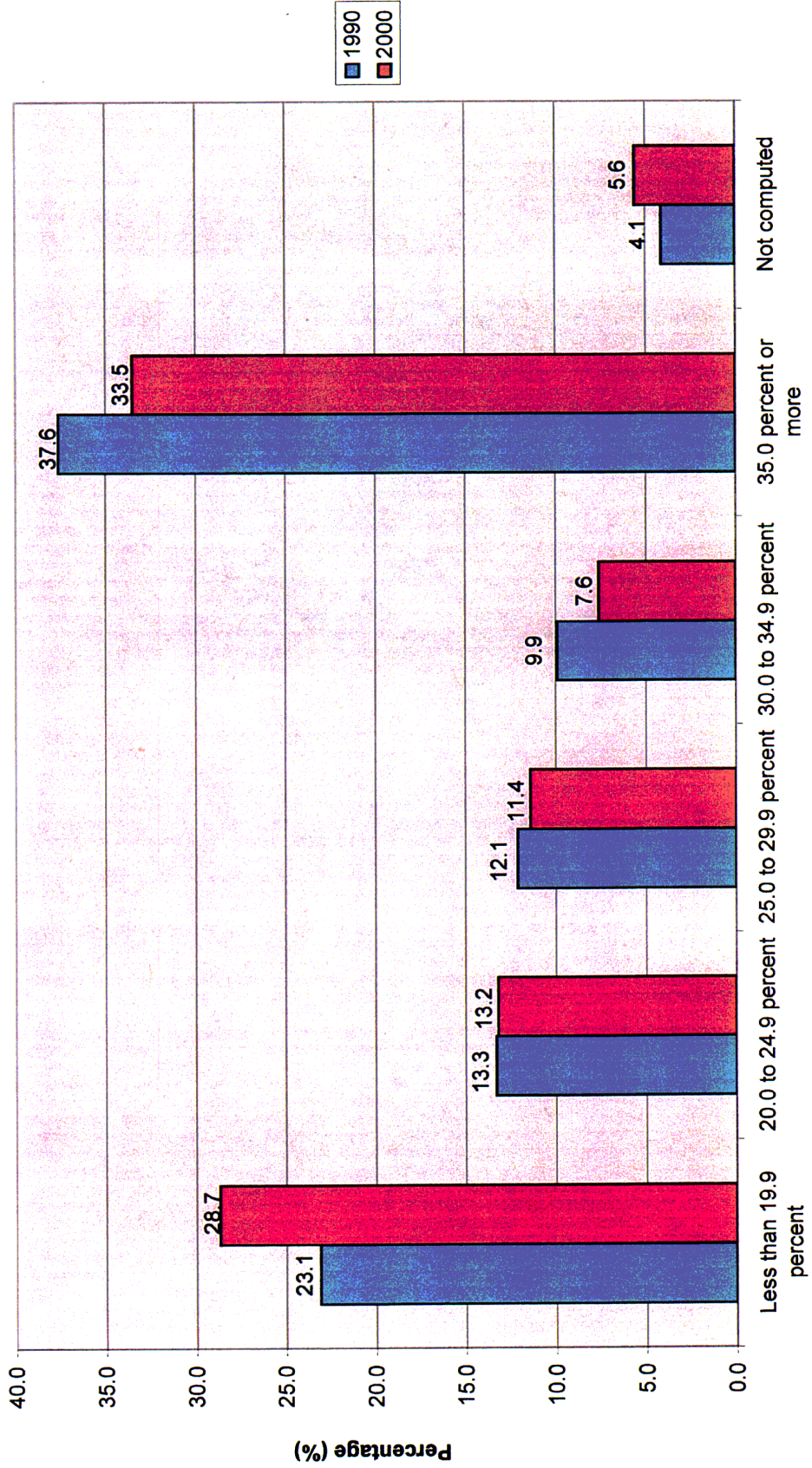

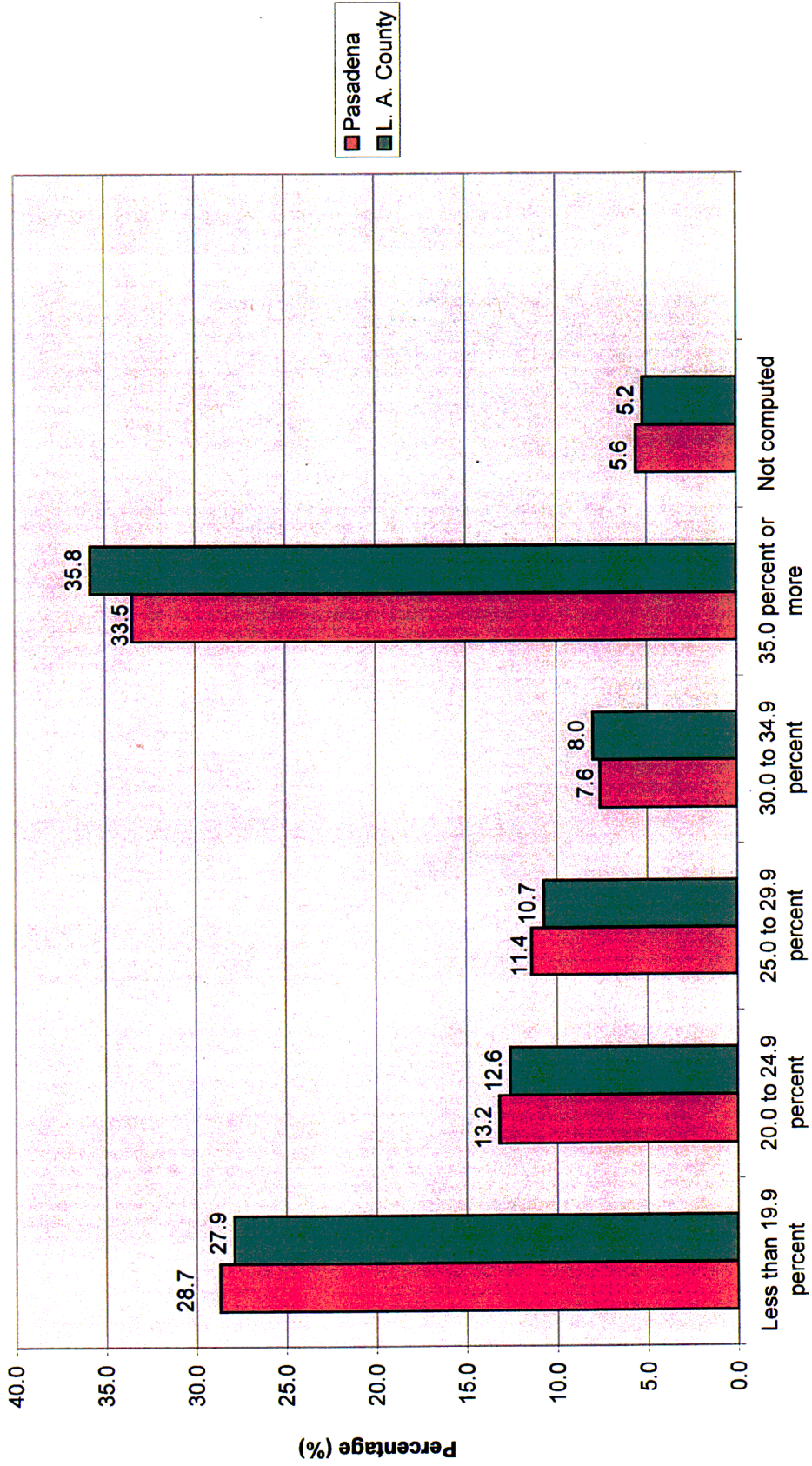

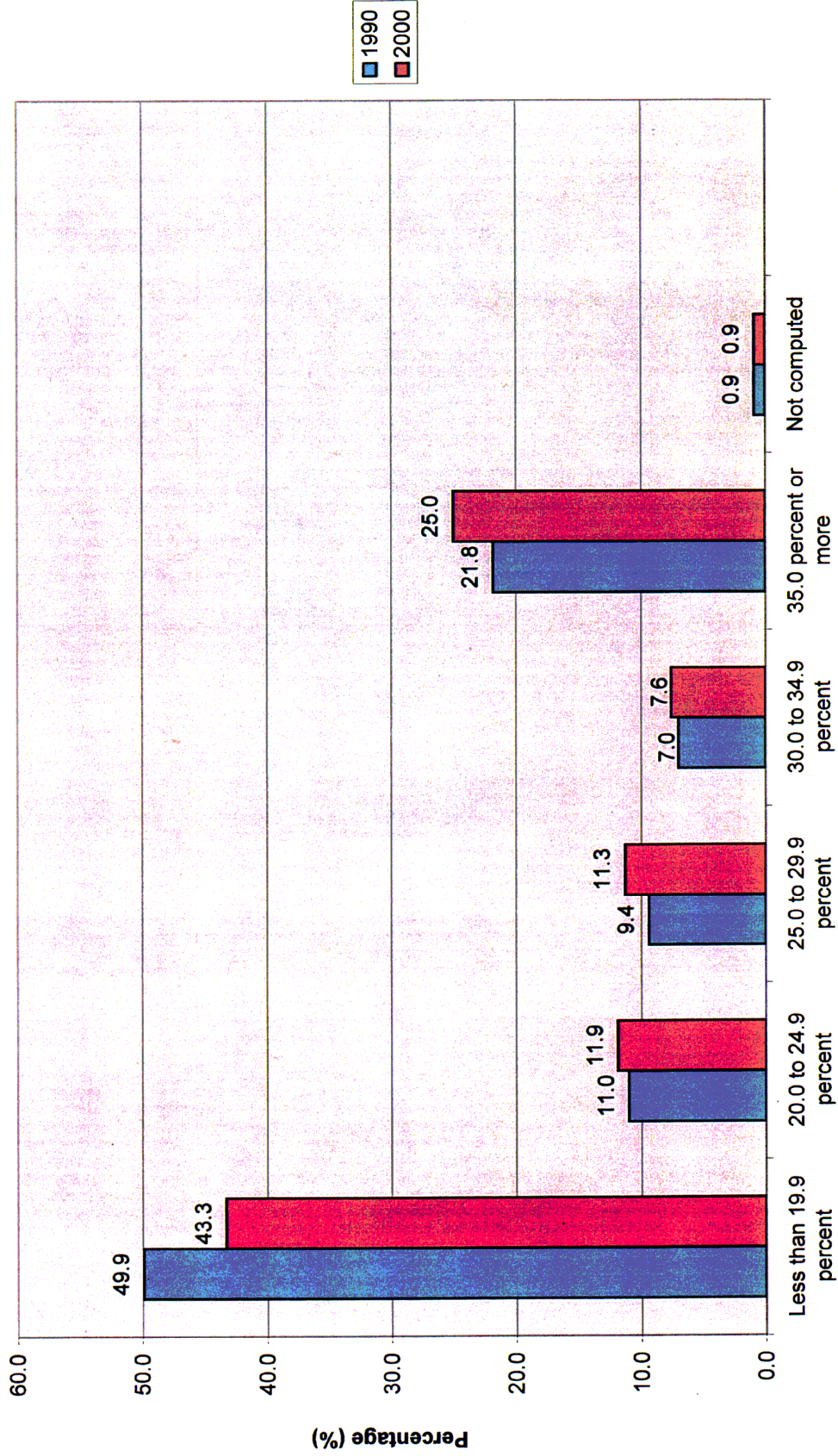
**Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income

 Pasadena for the Year 1990 and 2000**



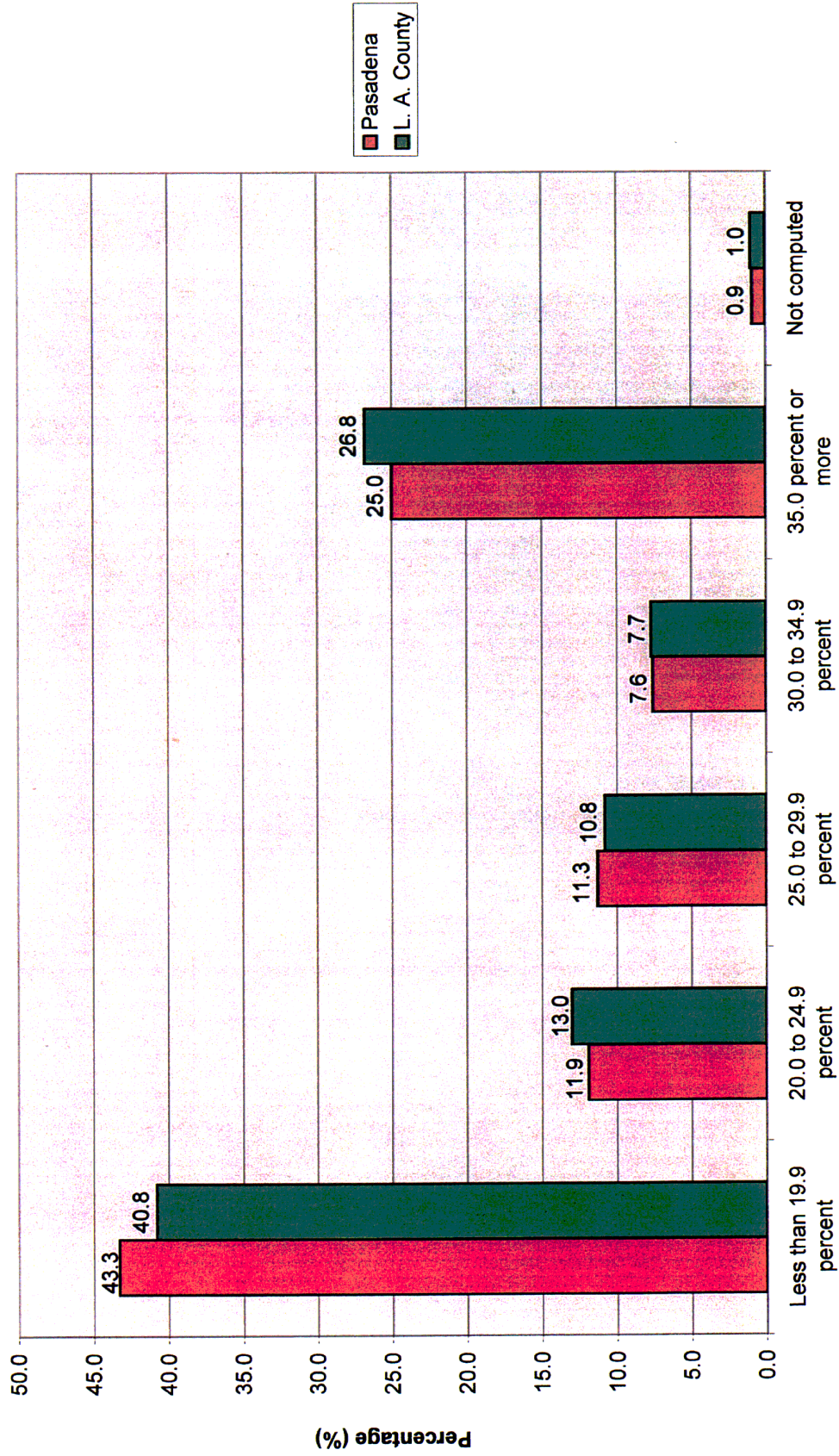
Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income

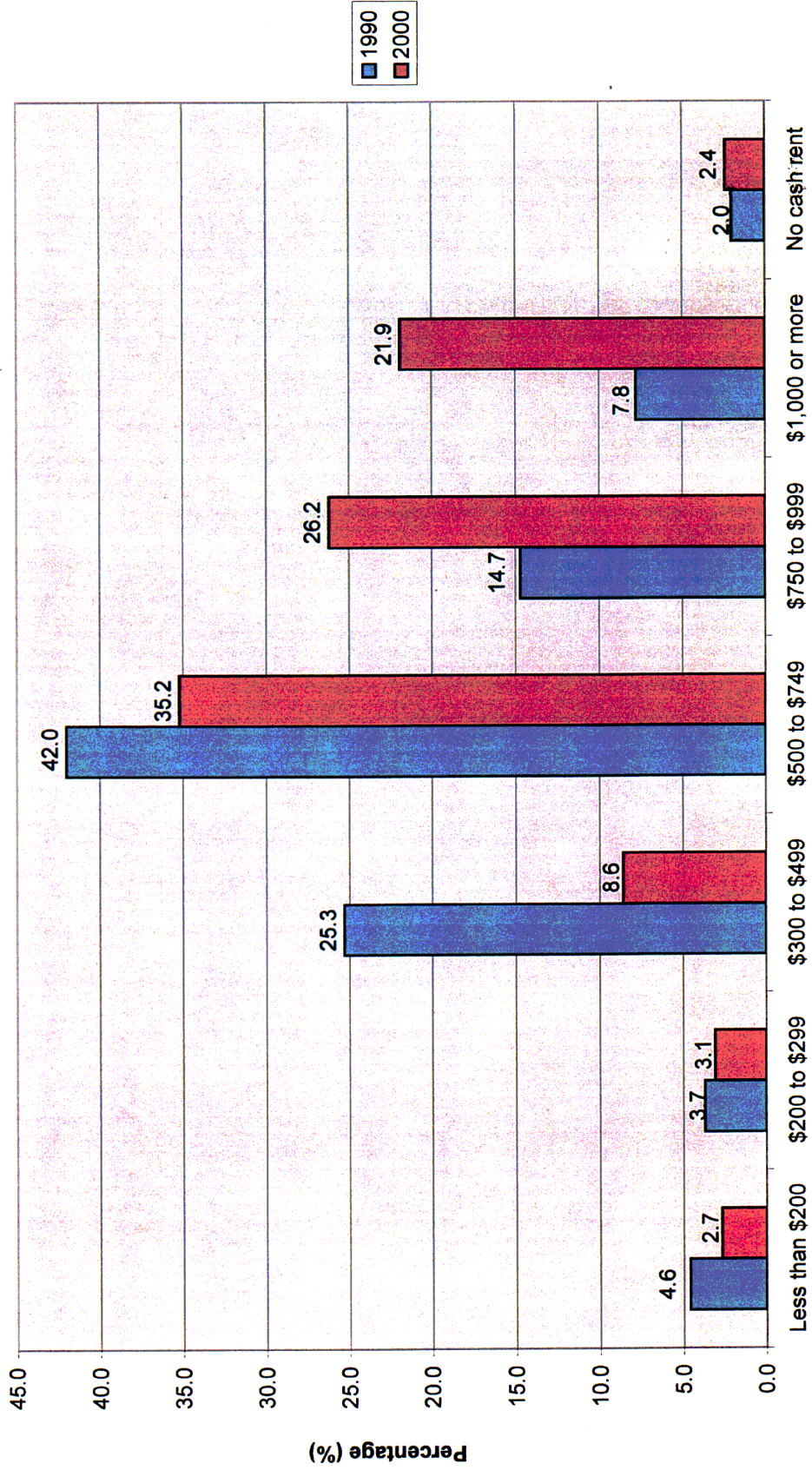

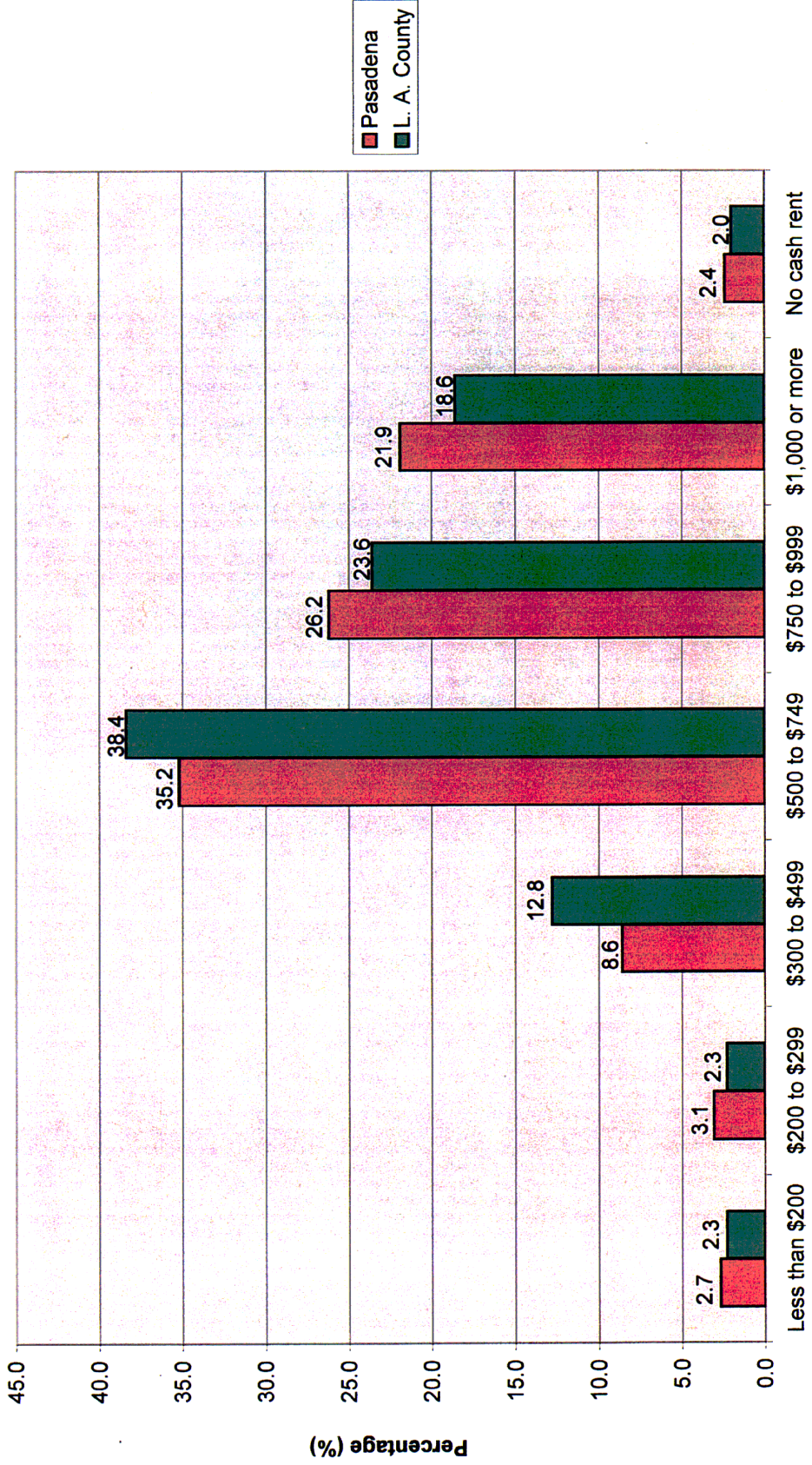
