# **RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council:

- (1) Accept the Certificate of Canvass.
- (2) Adopt a resolution declaring:
  - (a) The following persons are re-elected to the following offices:

Bill Bogaard Joyce Streator Mayor of the City of Pasadena Member of the City Council, District 1 Paul Little Member of the City Council, District 2 Steve Haderlein Member of the City Council, District 4 Steve Madison Member of the City Council, District 6

(b) The result of votes cast for Measure A (Charter Amendment to allow the City Council and the Board of Education the option to hold elections in which the primary or only method of voting is by mail, known as "all-mail" ballot elections) and Measure B (Charter Amendment to allow the spouse of a deceased Fire and Police Retirement System public safety member to continue to receive pension benefits if he/she remarries), are as follows:

## **BACKGROUND:**

The City of Pasadena held its Primary Nominating Election on Tuesday, March 4, 2003, for the office of Mayor and for members of the City Council, Districts 1, 2, 4 and 6. Pasadena City Charter Section 1204 provides that "Any person who, at the primary election, shall receive a majority of the total vote cast for candidates for said office shall be elected to such office."

At the Primary Nominating Election, Mayoral candidate Bill Bogaard received a majority of votes from voters within the City of Pasadena and was re-elected as Mayor for a full term of four years. City Council District 1 candidate Joyce Streator, District 2 candidate Paul Little, District 4 candidate Steve Haderlein, and District 6 candidate Steve Madison each received the majority of votes from their districts and were re-elected as members of the City Council, Districts 1, 2, 4 and 6, respectively.

Measure A, referenced above, submitted to both City of Pasadena and Pasadena Unified School District voters, failed with 49.0% in favor and 51.0% in opposition. Measure B, submitted to City of Pasadena voters, passed with 51.2% in favor and 48.8% in opposition.

Pursuant to Article VII of the Pasadena City Charter, the Primary Nominating Election for members of the Board of Education, Seats 2, 4 and 6, was consolidated with the City Primary Nominating Election. The official canvass results for the Pasadena Unified School District election are submitted directly to the Board of Education.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

The total cost of this election will be shared pro rata by the City of Pasadena and the Pasadena Unified School District, based on a formula to be established by the Registrar of Voters Office. The cost of this election will be tabulated upon receipt of all invoices, and the School District will be invoiced by the City for its pro rata share of costs.

There will be no City of Pasadena general municipal election, as the above-referenced Mayor and City Council candidates were all re-elected for their respective offices in the Primary Nominating Election by majority vote. There will be a Pasadena Unified School District General Election on April 15, 2003, for Board of Education Seat 4, as no candidate for this seat received a majority of votes in the Primary Nominating Election. The Pasadena Unified School District will be invoiced the full cost for its upcoming April 15, 2003 general election.

## **RESOLUTION NO.**

# A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PASADENA DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CITY'S CONSOLIDATED PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 4, 2003

WHEREAS, a Primary Nominating Election for the office of Mayor and a District Primary Nominating Election for members of the City Council in Districts 1, 2, 4 and 6 of the City of Pasadena was called by the City Council to be held on March 4, 2003, to be consolidated with the Pasadena Unified School District Primary Nominating Election for Board of Education Seats 2, 4 and 6, to be held on said date; and

WHEREAS, the Pasadena City Council and the Pasadena Board of Education ordered the submission to the qualified electors of the City of Pasadena and the Pasadena Unified School District at said Primary Nominating Election a question (Measure A) relating to whether the Pasadena City Charter shall be amended to allow the City Council and the Board of Education the option to hold elections in which the primary or only method of voting is by mail, known as "all-mail" ballot elections; and

WHEREAS, the Pasadena City Council ordered the submission to the qualified electors of the City of Pasadena at said Primary Nominating Election a question (Measure B) relating to whether the Pasadena City Charter shall be amended to allow the spouse of a deceased Fire and Police Retirement System (FPRS) public safety member to continue to receive pension benefits if he/she remarries; and

WHEREAS, the votes at said consolidated Primary Nominating Election have been canvassed by the City Clerk and a copy of said canvass is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, said City Clerk has certified the results of said canvass to the City Council of the City of Pasadena.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pasadena that:

1. The following be declared to be the results of the Primary Nominating Election for the office of Mayor and members of the City Council, Districts 1, 2, 4 and 6:

2. That Bill Bogaard, having received a majority of the total votes cast for candidate for the office of Mayor of the City of Pasadena, from which the candidate

sought nomination, hereby is declared to be re-elected as Mayor for a full term of four years.

- 3. That Joyce Streator, having received a majority of the total votes cast for candidate for the office of member of the City Council from District 1, from which the candidate sought nomination, hereby is declared to be re-elected as a member of the City Council from District 1 for a full term of four years.
- 4. That Paul Little, having received a majority of the total votes cast for candidate for the office of member of the City Council from District 2, from which the candidate sought nomination, hereby is declared to be re-elected as a member of the City Council from District 2 for a full term of four years.
- 5. That Steve Haderlein, having received a majority of the total votes cast for candidate for the office of member of the City Council from District 4, from which the candidate sought nomination, hereby is declared to be re-elected as a member of the City Council from District 4 for a full term of four years.
- 6. That Steve Madison, having received a majority of the total votes cast for candidate for the office of member of the City Council from District 6, from which the candidate sought nomination, hereby is declared to be re-elected as a member of the City Council from District 6 for a full term of four years.
- 7. The following be declared to be the result of the votes cast for Measure A, submitted to the voters of the City of Pasadena and the Pasadena Unified School District at the consolidated Primary Nominating Election held on March 4, 2003:

### **MEASURE A**

Shall the Pasadena City Charter be amended to allow the City Council and the Board of Education the option to hold elections in which the primary or only method of voting is by mail, known as "all-mail" ballot elections?

YES 6,861 (49.0%) NO 7,148 (51.0%)

That as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on Measure A did not vote in favor of it, and that the measure was not carried, and shall not be deemed adopted and ratified.
