**Subject:** Authorization to Enter into a Contract with Spiniello Companies, to Provide Labor and Materials for Water Main Line Installations in Orange Grove Boulevard, Marengo Avenue, Los Robles Avenue, and Orange Grove Boulevard/Colorado Boulevard for the Water and Power Department, Specification WD-03-02

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- (i) Accept the bid dated September 2, 2003 submitted by Spiniello Companies, in response to Specification WD-03-02 for providing labor and materials for Water Main Line Installations for Pasadena Water and Power;
- (ii) Reject all other bids; and
- (iii) Authorize a contract not to exceed \$2,431,340.

## BACKGROUND

Specification WD-03-02 provides for installation of water mains in Orange Grove Boulevard, Marengo Avenue, Los Robles Avenue, and Orange Grove Boulevard/Colorado Boulevard in Pasadena. This main replacement project is part of the Water System Master Plan recommendation that was completed and adopted by Council in 2003.

The Notice Inviting Bids for Specification WD-03-02 was published in the Pasadena Journal on August 7, 2003. In response to the Notice Inviting Bids, six contractors received the Specification. Bids were received from three contractors as follows:

Spiniello Companies	\$2,210,309.00
W.A. Rasic Construction Co., Inc.	\$3,481,570.94
Perry C. Thomas Construction, Inc.	\$3,588,378.00

Spiniello Companies, Inc. is the lowest responsive bidder and complies in all respects with the requirements of the Specification. Staff recommends that the City Council award a contract to Spiniello Companies, Inc. The engineer's estimate for this work is \$2,100,000. The award includes the bid price and a contingency of 10% to accommodate any necessary change orders.


Base Bid	\$ 2,210,309.00
10% Contingency	\$ 221,031.00
Total Contract Price	\$2,431,340 .00

The proposed contract is in compliance with the Competitive Bidding and Purchasing Ordinance P.M.C. 4.08.


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
