SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF CONTRACT NUMBER 18,408 WITH LINSOTT, LAW, & GREENSPAN ENGINEERS TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL TRAFFIC CONSULTANT SERVICES FOR THE ROSE BOWL REHABILITATION PROJECT

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council authorize the City manager to amend Contract No. 18,408 with Linscott, Law, & Greenspan Engineers to provide additional traffic consultant services associated with the preparation of the Rose Bowl Rehabilitation Project Environmental Impact Report (EIR) in the amount of \$18,500. The new total contract amount will be \$84,000.

BACKGROUND

On December 17, 2004, the City entered into a contract with Linscott, Law, & Greenspan Engineers (LLG) for an amount not to exceed \$65,500. This contract provides consulting services for analyses of the traffic impacts for the EIR for the Rose Bowl Rehabilitation Project.

The original contract scope was prepared for a project design that included a reduction in seating capacity at the Rose Bowl from approximately 93,000 to approximately 63,500 seats with a maximum of 21,000 on-site parking spaces. A revised design has been introduced that proposes a seating capacity of approximately 65,000 seats and a reduction in the number of parking spaces in the Arroyo to approximately 18,000. Increased seating for up to approximately 75,000 people is proposed for special events such as the Super Bowl or annual Rose Bowl game.

The request to increase the budget for this contact by an amount not to exceed \$18,500 is for the analysis required to provide the additional traffic consulting services for the EIR associated with the changes in seating capacity, number of on-site parking spaces, and additional meetings with the community and staff.

Based on the original project design, LLG completed approximately 75 percent of the traffic analyses pending review by staff and coordination of this study with the Draft EIR.

FISCAL IMPACT


All costs associated with the preparation of the EIR will be paid pursuant to the Agreement with the National Football League authorized by the Council on September 8, 2003.


