The afternoon mail brought a letter of resignation from commission Gerry Lewis. Her resignation drops the quorum for a commission meeting to 4. This means that anytime 4 commissioners gather to discuss business, either [1] the gathering needs to be posted as a meeting, or [2] one of the 4 must keep silent and not participate in the business.

Here is Gerry's letter:

"I have enjoyed being a Commissioner for the City of Pasadena and participating on the Accessibility and Disability Commission. As a commissioner I have learned so much about accessibility for the disabled. Unfortunately, I am unable to continue because my job has become increasingly demanding. It is impossible for me to attend a 3:30 pm Commission meeting on a regular basis. In addition, I am not able to attend sub-committee meetings within the commission structure due to the scheduled meeting time.

"Not being able to attend Commission and Committee meetings on a regular basis would cause me to miss out on important information. I wish the Commission well as they strive to make the city residents more aware of the accessibility problems for the disabled community.
