SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 18737  
WITH DYE AND BROWNING CONSTRUCTION, INC.  
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$29,628.63 FOR THE DRAINAGE  
IMPROVEMENTS OF FLAT STREETS – 2004 PROJECT

## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council:

Authorize the City Manager to execute an amendment to Contract No. 18737 with Dye and Browning Construction, Inc. for the Drainage Improvement of Flat Streets – 2004 project; to increase the total contract “Not to Exceed” amount from \$100,000 to \$129,628.63, an increase of \$29,628.63 for additional work required to complete the project.

## **BACKGROUND**

On December 20, 2004, the City Council approved the contract award to Dye and Browning Construction, Inc. providing for the drainage improvements on flat streets, including Ladera Street from El Molino Avenue to Lake Avenue, Brigden Road from Sierra Bonita Avenue to Allen Avenue, and Locust Street at Catalina Avenue.


The scope of work was increased during construction to correct previously unforeseen deficiencies on Ladera Street. Several areas of gutter were ponding water. It was necessary to reconstruct additional curb, gutter and driveway for proper drainage. Also, at Colorado Boulevard and Allen Avenue, a saturated subgrade required extensive removals and reconstruction. This condition was discovered during construction. The cost of the additional work is \$29,628.63. Therefore, it is recommended that the original contract “Not to Exceed” amount be increased from \$100,000 to \$129,628.63.

Construction was completed in March, 2005.


**FISCAL IMPACT**


