SUBJECT: REJECTION OF BIDS – FURNISHING AND DELIVERY OF AGGREGATE BASE, CEMENT SLURRY AND ASPHALT COLD MIX

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council reject all bids received on November 29, 2005.

BACKGROUND


Specifications for the furnishing and delivery of Aggregate Base, Cement Slurry and Asphalt Cold Mix were issued on November 10, 2005. Aggregate base is used by the City's Water Division construction crews to back fill excavations to avoid sink holes in the street after installation of pipe.

Only one response was received in the City Clerk's office on November 29, 2005. A review of the single bid revealed that the bidder did not follow bid specifications in the proposal, justifying the need for the bid to be rejected.

FISCAL IMPACT


The cost of reissuing and re-bidding the specifications is negligible.


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
