SUBJECT: RESOLUTION APPROVING PROGRAM SUPPLEMENT
AGREEMENT TO RECEIVE STATE REIMBURSEMENT FOR SAFE
ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT (CIP# 75601)

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

- (1) Adopt a resolution approving a Program Supplement Agreement to Administering Agency – State Agreement No. 000064 between the City of Pasadena and the State of California, for State Reimbursement covering construction for the Safe Routes to School Project, State Project No. SR2SL-5064 (042), Program Supplement Agreement No. B37.
- (2) Authorize the City Manager to execute the same on behalf of the City.

BACKGROUND:

The Safe Routes to School Project provides for improvements that will increase safety on routes to elementary and secondary schools in the City. The project will install additional sidewalk, gutter, and wheelchair access ramps; improve signage and install bulb-outs and in-pavement lighted crosswalks at eligible schools in Pasadena. No improvements will be done at the schools scheduled for closure by the Pasadena Unified School District.

The Department of Transportation has obtained authorization from the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to proceed with the construction of the Safe Routes to School Project. Caltrans also administers the Safe Routes to School Program funding. These funds are paid to the City of Pasadena pursuant to the provisions of Administering Agency –State Agreement for State Funded Projects No. 000064 which was entered into by the parties on October 15, 1999. In order to


obtain funds for a specific project it is necessary to execute a separate supplemental agreement for the project after it has been approved for funding by Caltrans.

The reimbursement amounts from the Safe Routes to School Program funds for the proposed Program Supplement Agreements No. B37 will provide reimbursement of up to \$396,000 in State funds for the construction of the Safe Routes to School Project.


FISCAL IMPACT:

The Safe Routes to School Project was funded through Caltrans' Safe Routes to School Program in the amount of \$396,000 and a City allocation of \$104,000 (\$44,000 City matching construction funds and \$60,000 for preliminary engineering).


