## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Open the public hearing on the City Manager's Recommended Fiscal Year 2007 Operating Budget; and
- 2. Continue this public hearing to each subsequent meeting of the City Council at 7:00 p.m. until June 19, 2006 or such other later date as the City Council may determine, and at which time the City Council will be asked to close the public hearing and formally adopt the Operating Budget.

#### BACKGROUND

The City of Pasadena Charter requires that the proposed Operating Budget for the upcoming fiscal year be submitted to the City Council on or before the third Monday in May. Through the above recommendation, the Council is requested to formally open the public hearing on the Recommended Operating Budget and refer it to the Finance Committee. Attachment A reflects the current schedule for departmental budget reviews.

Following the review by the Finance Committee, a final Recommended Operating Budget will be presented to the City Council for adoption.
