**TO:** CITY COUNCIL

**SUBJECT:** AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PACIFIC STATES CAST IRON PIPE COMPANY TO FURNISH AND DELIVER CEMENT-MORTAR LINED DUCTILE IRON PIPE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$550,000 PER YEAR

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1) Accept the bid dated July 18, 2006 submitted by Pacific States Cast Iron Pipe Company in response to Specification WD-06-01 for the Furnishing and Delivery of Cement-Mortar Lined Ductile Iron Pipe to Pasadena Water and Power (PWP).
- 2) Authorize the Purchasing Administrator to issue a purchase order for the first two-year period to Pacific States Cast Iron Pipe Company, with two optional one-year extensions. The Contract shall not exceed \$550,000 annually and any annual unit price increase shall not exceed the rate of the current Producer Price Index (P.P.I).

## BACKGROUND

Specification WD-06-01 provides for a contract to furnish and deliver Class 52 Cement-Mortar Lined Ductile Iron Pipe to the Water and Power Department.

As part of the City's Water Master Plan, the Water and Power Department's Water Division construction crews have a goal to replace 8 miles of old distribution mains under City streets each fiscal year.

The Notice Inviting Bids for Specification WD-06-01 was published in the Pasadena Journal on July 6, 2006 and on "Bids on Line". Each contractor had to bid on all five items specified in the Bid. In response to the Notice Inviting Bids, six contractors received the Specification and Bids were received from one contractor, Pacific States Cast Iron Pipe Company.

Pacific States Cast Iron Pipe Company is the only responsive bidder for all five bid items and complies in all respects with the requirements of the Specification.

16" Cement-Mortar Line Ductile Iron Pipe	\$37.51 per foot

Staff recommends that the City Council award a contract in the amount of \$550,000 to Pacific States Cast Iron Pipe Company.

The proposed contract is in compliance with the Competitive Bidding and Purchasing Ordinance P.M.C. 4.08.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

Sufficient funds are provided for in the Fiscal Year 2006 Water Capital Improvement Program Budget Number 1001-Distribution Mains (\$300,000) and 1019-Fire Protection System Improvements (\$250,000).


