Dear Councilmember Gordo,

I am writing to request that you accept my resignation as the Bungalow Heaven Landmark District representative on the Historic Preservation Commission and that you recommend that the City Council appoint Tina Miller to complete my term.

It has been an honor to serve the Commission but at the September 21, 2006, General Meeting of the Bungalow Heaven Neighborhood Association (BHNA), I was elected association President. I expect that my new position on the Board will require much time and attention, in addition to my "day job" and other civic activities in Pasadena. Additionally, being both president of the neighborhood association and the representative of the landmark district might be perceived as biased or appear as a conflict of interest in some cases, which my resignation will eliminate.
