**SUBJECT:** AUTHORIZE PURCHASE ORDER WITH HUNTINGTON BEACH HONDA FOR PURCHASE OF FIVE NEW REPLACEMENT POLICE MOTORCYCLES FOR A TOTAL OF \$99,097.45

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

1) Authorize the issuance of a purchase order to Huntington Beach Honda in an amount not to exceed \$99,097.45 for the purchase of five police motorcycles; and

2) Grant the proposed purchase order an exemption from competitive bidding pursuant to City Charter section 1002(H), Contracts with Other Governmental Entities or their Contractors for Labor, Material, Supplies or Services.

## BACKGROUND

Due to the unique nature of its operations, the Police Department requires specialized motorcycles designed to handle the demands of the job. The City of Mission Viejo has specifications for a heavy-duty police motorcycle. These specifications will increase the lifecycle to six years and 100,000 miles. The current lifecycle of police patrol motorcycles is three years and 50,000 miles. The proposed purchase will replace five motorcycles that have met or exceeded their useful lifecycle. The vehicle replacement/condition reports are attached.

On May 1, 2006, the City of Mission Viejo undertook a competitive bidding process for the purchase of three 2006 Honda Law Enforcement Motorcycles. As a result of the bid process, a purchase order was issued to Huntington Beach Honda. Huntington Beach Honda has offered to extend this 2006 bid price to the City of Pasadena for five additional police motorcycles due for replacement in FY2007. Purchasing the requested vehicles from Huntington Beach Honda would be in the City's best interest because it would expedite the delivery of the

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vehicles, thus reducing the time needed to place the vehicles in service by approximately three months. It will also save the City approximately \$990.97 per motorcycle in price increases for model year 2007 for a total savings of \$4,954.85.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

This equipment is a budgeted replacement and sufficient funds are available in the Equipment Replacement Fund, Budget Account 766300.
