#### **Ambassador Gardens**

Overall Concept and Design Principles

The Ambassador Gardens are a rare and unique historical gift to the residents of Pasadena, with Recreational and Open Space uses unlike any other facility in the City. The dedicated Open Space system consists of beautiful gardens, intimate courtyards, pathways and lawn areas celebrating the site's considerable historical and botanical resources. The following proposal identifies the basic concept for the gardens.

The plans are still in the early stages; design details and specific operational elements such as defined edges/limits, maintenance, and security will be addressed as the design evolves. The following design principles will be used to guide the design effort:

- The Ambassador Gardens will remain intact with the exception of some minor adjustments. In fact, integral pieces
  of the gardens that have deteriorated with age such as fountains, walkways, monuments, and landscape, will be
  renewed, enhanced, and committed to long-term maintenance for the gardens' continued health and the public's
  enjoyment.
- The current recreational activities of the existing Open Space, which consist of strolling, picnicking, reading, reflecting, jogging, and passive play will continue to be allowed.
- Educational signage shall be provided to enhance historical and botanical understanding of the gardens and to enhance the community's understanding of the special and historical nature of the Gardens.
- The entire campus will be carefully coordinated and integrated with the plans for the surrounding uses.
- The Gardens shall be visible and welcoming to the public as viewed from the perimeter streets.
- Existing pedestrian connections and openings, as identified on the plan, will remain and be enhanced.
- Restroom facilities, on-and off-street parking, site furnishings and signage shall be provided.
- Visual access shall be provided into the private open spaces in order to emphasize the expansiveness of the site
  open spaces and gardens.
- Accessible paths of travel through the Gardens shall be provided to the extent feasible.

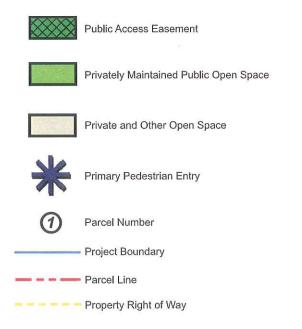
### Ambassador Gardens Descriptions and Usage

#### 1. Great Lawn and Mayfair Stream (91,371 SF / 2.10 AC)

Unique rolling, sloping, sprawling lawn containing some of the largest and most spectacular trees on the site. The Mayfair Stream begins at the top of this slope meandering down, running in and out between the Great Lawn and the Merritt Garden. Includes a linear corridor connecting Green Street to the Great Lawn.

Open public access with limitations.

Hours of operation: 7 AM to sunset daily.





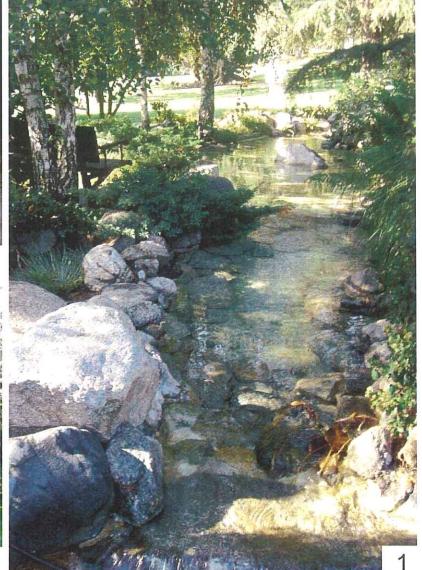




Preservation Diagram









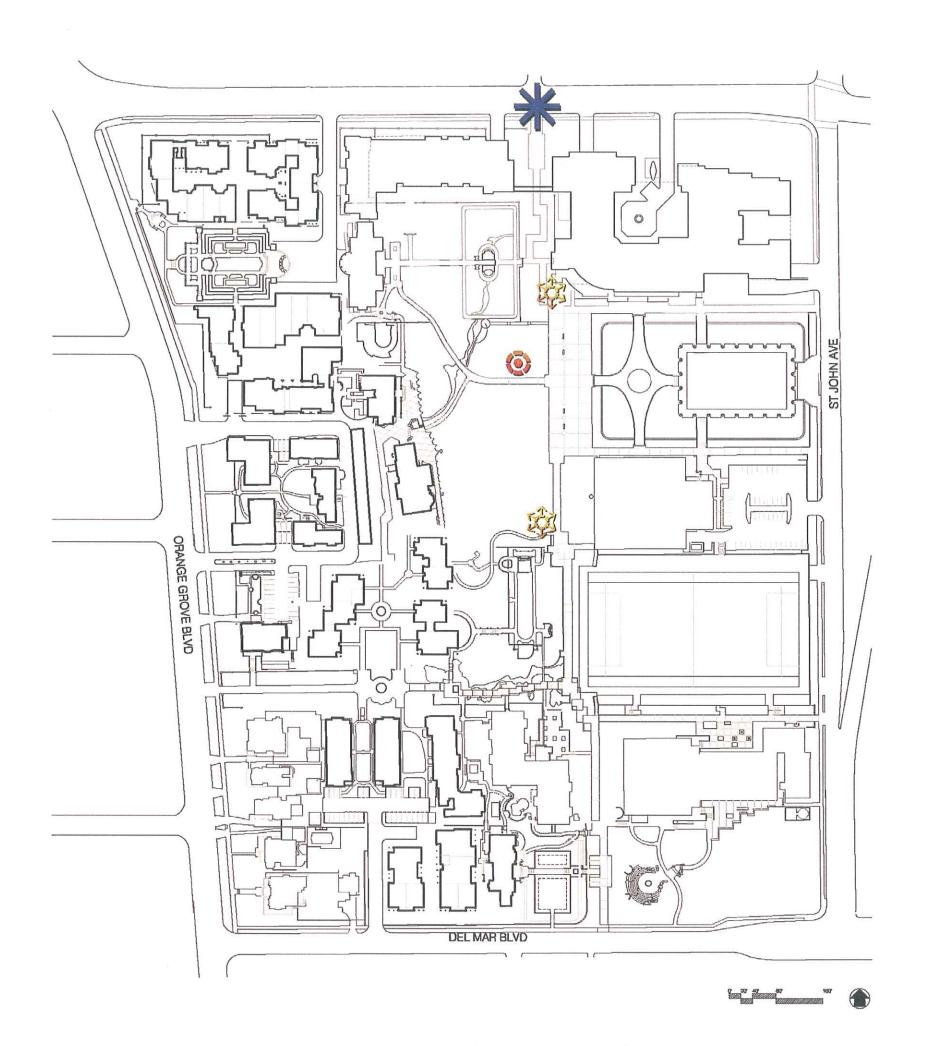
Ambassador Gardens Location Map

#### Primary Pedestrian Entry

Project Identity - announcing the name, "Ambassador Gardens", shall be provided at the Primary Pedestrian Entry areas as identified on the Diagram



#### Interpretive Stations

Kiosks providing the visitor with information about the historical and botanical resources of Ambassador Gardens.



#### Wayfinding

Signage shall be provided throughout the Gardens in logical locations, aiding in directing the user to the given amenities and destinations. Items such as: paths of travel, building and facilities, streets, parking, restrooms, overall site map, etc.

In addition, amenities and destination elements throughout Ambassador Gardens shall be identified with signage.

Signage is intended to be designed to reflect the same character as the existing site elements.

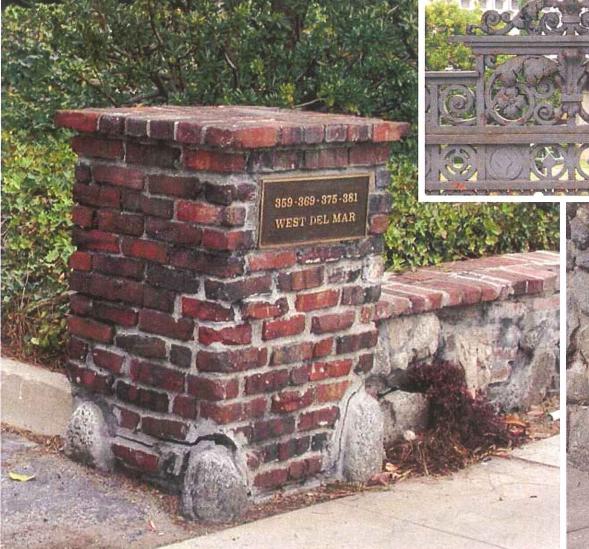


#### Signage Character

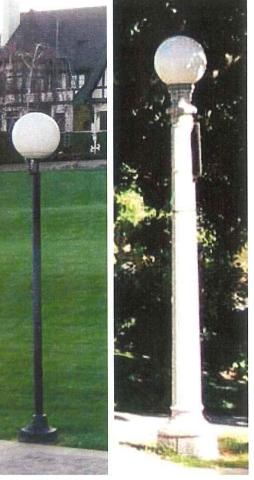

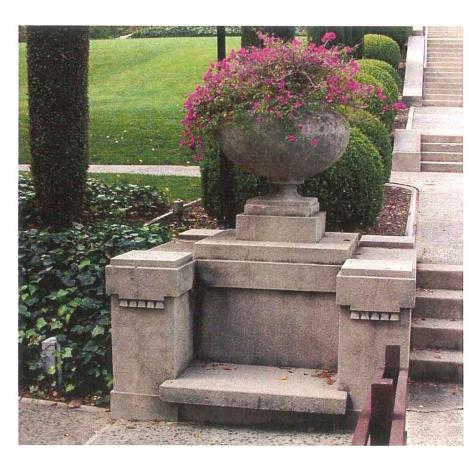


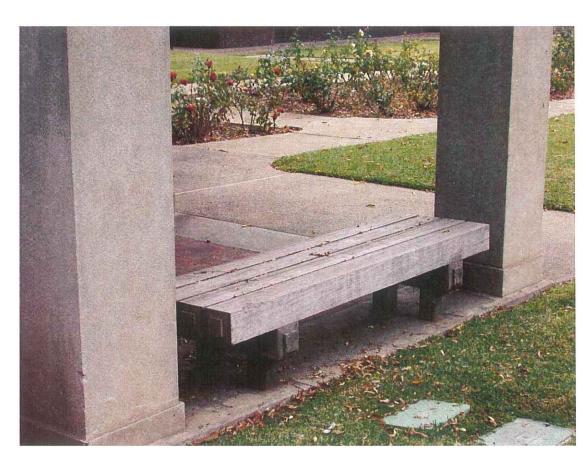




Site Furnishings

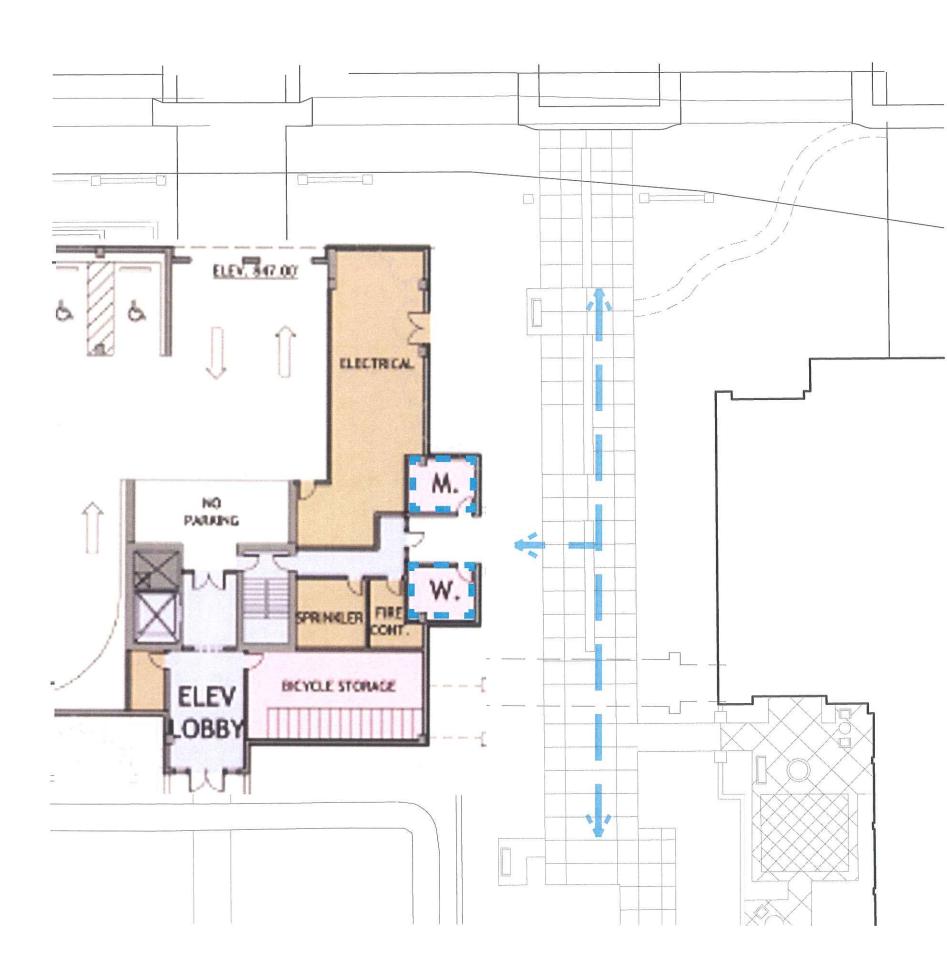
