#### CITY CLERK REPORTS ON MARCH 6, 2007 ELECTION RESULTS

The City Clerk reported that on March 6, 2007, Bill Bogaard was re-elected with 88.7% and was declared re-elected as Mayor of the City of Pasadena; Steve Haderlein was re-elected with 52.4% of the vote and was re-elected as member of the City Council, representing District 4; and Steve Madison was re-elected with 83.3% of the vote and was declared re-elected as member of the City Council, representing District 6. She noted on March 19<sup>th</sup>, the City Council adopted a resolution which declared these Primary Election results.

#### CITY CLERK REPORTS ON APRIL 17, 2007 RUN-OFF ELECTION RESULTS

The City Clerk further reported that at the General Election held on April 17, Jacque Robinson was elected with 52.9% of the vote and was declared elected as member of the City Council, representing District 1; and Margaret McAustin was elected with 60.8% of the vote and was declared elected as member of the City Council,

representing District 2. She noted that on April 30<sup>th</sup>, the City Council adopted a resolution which declared these results.

The City Clerk administered the oaths of office to re-elected Mayor Bill Bogaard, Councilmember Steve Haderlein, Councilmember Steve Madison, newly elected Councilmember Jacque Robinson and newly elected Councilmember Margaret Mc Austin.

STATEMENTS BY NEW

Councilmember Jacque Robinson introduced family members, her campaign manager, and guests. Jeanette Mann, member of Pasadena City College Board of Trustees, and member of 50-50 Coalition, congratulated Councilmembers Robinson and McAustin and announced that they had been presented with roses earlier in the meeting and that a rose would be distributed to every women in the audience.

Vice Mayor Madison expressed gratitude to former Councilmembers Streater and Little and commented on their intelligence, dedication and devotion. He congratulated the newly elected Councilmembers and stated he looks forward to working with them the next four years.
