**SUBJECT:** PUBLIC HEARING - FY 2009-2014 RECOMMENDED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET

## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Open the public hearing on the City Manager's Recommended FY 2009-2014 Capital Improvement Program Budget;
2. Continue this public hearing to each subsequent meeting of the Council at 7:30 pm until May 19, 2008 or such other later date as the City Council may determine, and at which time the City Council will be asked to close the public hearing and formally adopt the FY 2009-2014 Capital Improvement Program Budget; and
3. Refer the City Manager's Recommended FY 2009-2014 Capital Improvement Program Budget to the Finance Committee and direct the meetings be noticed as joint meetings between the Finance Committee and the City Council from April 21, 2008 to May 12, 2008.

## **BACKGROUND**

The City of Pasadena Charter requires that the proposed FY 2009-2014 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget for the upcoming fiscal year be submitted to the City Council. As part of the process of adoption, the City Council is requested to formally open the public hearing on the recommended Capital Improvement Program Budget and continue the public hearing weekly until the recommendation to adopt the FY 2009-2014 CIP is presented by the Finance Committee to the City Council.

The CIP budget identifies funding for major capital improvement projects throughout the City's infrastructure. The FY 2009 budget contains 323 projects with a total estimated cost of \$1,741,449,643, and a total recommended appropriation of \$89,839,860 to 100 projects as outlined on Attachment A. In addition, a total of 15 new projects have been added.

Copies of the Recommended FY 2009–2014 CIP have been placed in all the public libraries and in the City Clerk's office. The CIP hearings with the Finance Committee will be held on April 21, 2008, April 28, 2008, May 5, 2008 and are scheduled to conclude on May 12, 2008. All meetings will begin at 4:00 pm. Following the review by the Finance Committee, a final recommended Capital Improvement Program Budget is scheduled to be presented to the City Council for adoption on May 19, 2008, or shortly thereafter. The schedule for the Finance Committee's review of the CIP is listed below.



**FISCAL IMPACT**


The total recommended appropriations in the FY 2009 Capital Improvement Program are \$89,839,860.




