SUBJECT: COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM

CITY SET-ASIDE RECOMMENDATION (2008-2009)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended the City Council approve the 2008-2009 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program City Set-Aside of \$1,762,057 with an allocation of \$874,000 to three eligible City administered projects and \$888,057 to three mandatory projects (Section 108 Loan Repayment, Repayment to General Fund for Economic Development Loan to the Episcopal Housing Alliance and CDBG program administration)

BACKGROUND

The CDBG 2008-2009 program budget is \$2,460,824 (annual Entitlement of \$2,204,222, \$200,000 in current year program income and \$56,602 in reprogrammed 2006-2007 CDBG funds). The recommended 2008-2009 City Set-Aside is for seven non-public service projects in the amount of \$1,762,057 as listed below:

All proposed projects meet the local and U.S. Department of HUD defined threshold requirements. Each project complies with the established funding priorities and four projects represent continued funding of prior year's projects.

Exhibit "A" provides information regarding the projects' recommended funding, prior year funding, and brief project descriptions.

Upon approval of the recommended \$1,762,057 CDBG City Set-Aside, \$698,767 remains available for allocations by the Human Services Commission (\$360,653) and Northwest Commission (\$338,114).

FISCAL IMAPCT

The funds referenced in this report are federal dollars. Approval of the subject recommendation will augment services currently being provided by the City. The only impact to the City's General Fund as a result of this action is the repayment to the General Fund of \$93,070.
