SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF FINAL TRACT MAP NO. 070782. BEING A SIX-UNIT

CONDOMINIUM CONVERSION, AT 824-834 EAST CALIFORNIA

BOULEVARD

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1) Adopt a resolution to approve Final Tract Map No. 070782; and
- 2) Authorize the City Clerk to execute the Certificate on the map showing the City's approval of said map.

BACKGROUND:

The subject Final Tract Map, consisting of six residential condominium air parcels at 824-834 East California Boulevard, was reviewed and approved in tentative form by the Hearing Officer on July 15, 2009. The developer's engineer has completed the final map which has been reviewed by the City's consultant. Said map is now ready for City Council's approval prior to recordation in the office of the County Recorder. The developer has complied with or provided surety for all the conditions of approval required by the City. No additional discretionary actions were required.

The site is developed with six bungalows constructed in 1926, which have been used as commercial structures. Minor tenant improvements were undertaken to convert the bungalows to residential use. Permits were issued for the tenant improvements in November 2008 and construction was complete in October 2009.

The project consisting of six units is not subject to standards of the Inclusionary Housing Requirements, Chapter 17.42 of the PMC. The Inclusionary Housing Requirements are applicable to newly constructed residential dwelling units of ten or more, or subdivision maps consisting of ten or more residential lots. The project is not subject to the requirements of the Tenant Protection Ordinance – Pasadena Municipal Code (PMC) Chapter 9.75, per the Housing Rights Center, the City's TPO compliance contractor, as no housing units were removed from the rental market.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The developer has paid for all costs to prepare and process the subdivision documents. Approval of this action will generate additional revenue to the City in an amount to be determined later in the form of property taxes.
