

Re: Recommendations for City Council Meeting- 7-26-10- item 4 – Congestive  
Management Plan and Bicycle Master Plan

The Council should delay approval or cancel these two plans that include the roundabouts with access only for bicycles. The city is on notice of how dangerous these roundabouts are. Why follow this known danger and risk increase tort damages? Is the recreation of privileged citizens worth the potential costs?

Pasadena 2011 budget has \$724 million in spending minus \$212 million in revenue leaving us to pay \$512 million in the future. The Rose Bowl upgrade cost \$179 million or \$358 million with bond interest for a yearly return of \$3 million for this project. Cancel these projects: Rose Bowl upgrade (\$378 million), Top hat statue(\$1 million), and the recreational bike path and congestive management project (9 Million). Please restore the fire department services to previous levels for the safety of residents.

Oakland City Council President Janice Brunner said “ It's regrettable, but we had no choice” on laying off 80 Police Officers. Pasadena can avoid this situation in the future by reducing current and future spending items.
