### SUBJECT: SCHEDULE OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council reject all scheduled rate increases reflected in the attached Schedule of Taxes, Fees and Charges.

### ADVISORY COMMISSION/BOARD/CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE **RECOMMENDATION:**

On June 14, 2010, the Finance Committee held a public meeting to discuss the attached Schedule of Taxes, Fees and Charges and will provide an oral report on their discussion.

### **BACKGROUND:**

Section 1.08.060 of the Pasadena Municipal Code provides that all taxes, fees and charges referred to in the Code, will be adjusted on July 1 of each year to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) during the 12 months which ended the preceding March 1. Pursuant to California Government Code Section 53750, the City Council has the authority to increase taxes pursuant to a CPI adjustment formula that was in place prior to November 6, 1996. The City's CPI formula was adopted in 1978. The Municipal Code requires the Director of Finance to compute the changes and submit them for review. The Council may reject any or all of the recommended increases; however, it may not modify any adjustments before ordering the report filed. The actions to reject any one of the recommendations must be taken by June 30. At that time, changes that have not been rejected will automatically be implemented. The Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers in the Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County Metropolitan areas increased by 1.44% between March 1, 2009 and March 1, 2010.

In view of the current state of the economy, it is recommended that City Council exercise their discretion to reject all of the scheduled increases. The attached list shows the current rates of all taxes, fees and charges affected by these provisions, and

the adjusted rates that could take effect July 1, 2010, if not rejected. Any tax rate which is based upon a percentage is already shown as a no increase because under Proposition 218 these are subject to electoral approval. Further, the 2011 Grandstand Permit Application Tax, Rose Bowl Admission Tax, and Grandstand Seat Surcharge rates were approved by Council on December 14, 2009 with no increase.

Consideration of the Schedule of Taxes, Fees and Charges requires both the holding of a public meeting which is accomplished through the Finance Committee meeting of June 14, 2010 and a Public Hearing by the City Council on June 21, 2010.

#### **COUNCIL POLICY CONSIDERATION**

The City Council's Strategic Planning Goal of maintaining fiscal responsibility and stability will be advanced through annual review and consideration of the Schedule of Taxes, Fees and Charges.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Rejection of all scheduled rate adjustments would result in estimated revenues remaining the same as the prior year. This potential revenue has not been anticipated or included in the FY 2011 budget. The foregone increase in estimated annual revenues if all increases were to be approved would be the following amounts:

General Fund Sewer Construction and Maintenance Fund Library Special Tax Fund \$62,000 \$91,000 \$29,000
