TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING CHAPTER 2.65 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE REPEALING THE SUNSET CLAUSE FOR THE COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN

PURPOSE OF ORDINANCE:

The purpose of this ordinance is to eliminate the current sunset clause date of June 30, 2010, for the Commission on the Status of Women.

REASON WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:

The City Council directed preparation of this amendment at its meeting of March 22, 2010. Section 410 of the Pasadena City Charter requires that the municipal code be amended by ordinance.

PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENTS OR GROUPS AFFECTED:

This ordinance will continue the Commission on the Status of Women for an indefinite period.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Adoption of this ordinance will require continued staffing for the Commission.
