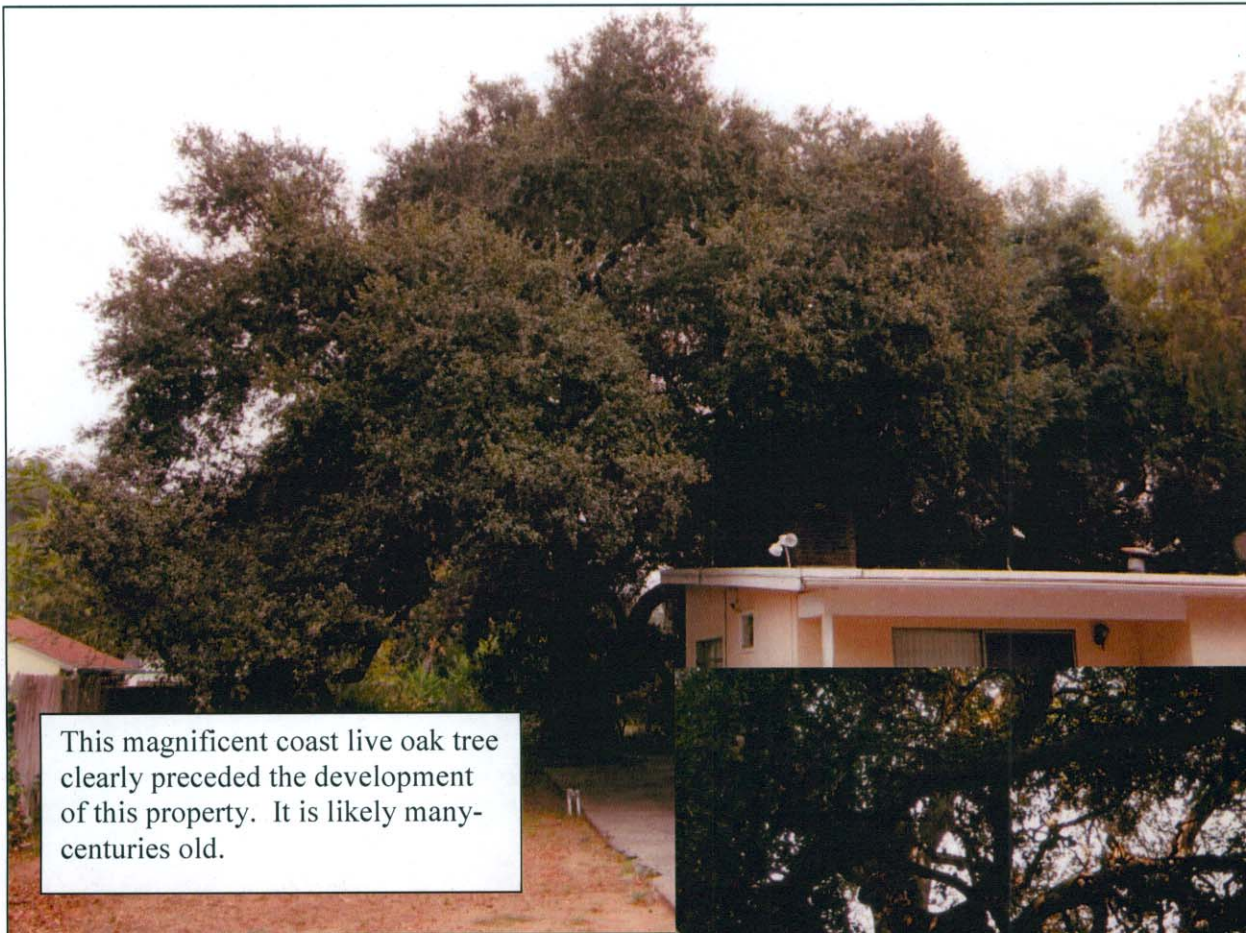
Australian tea tree - *Leptospermum laevigatum*



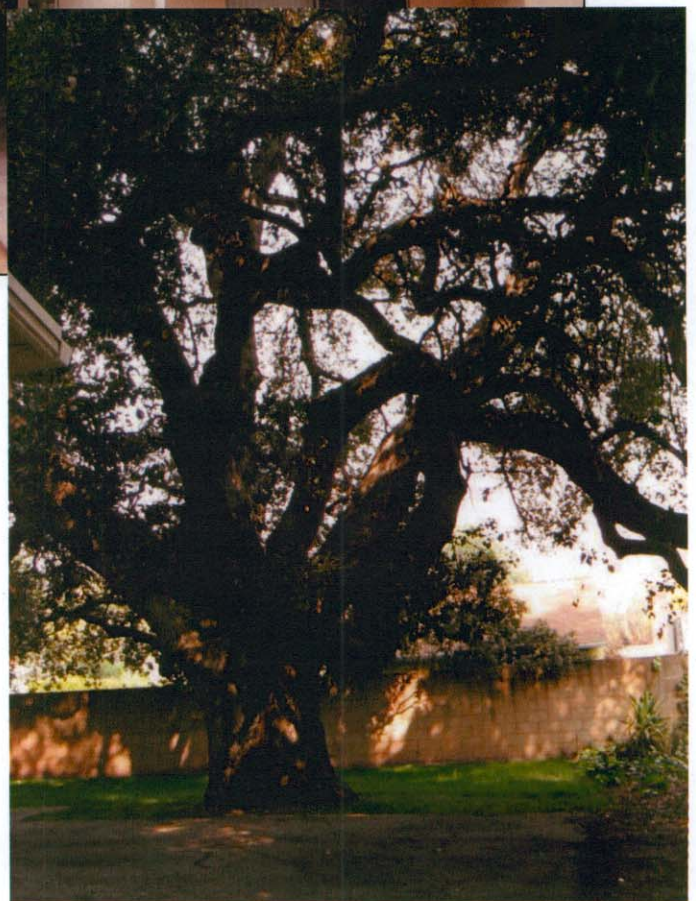
