

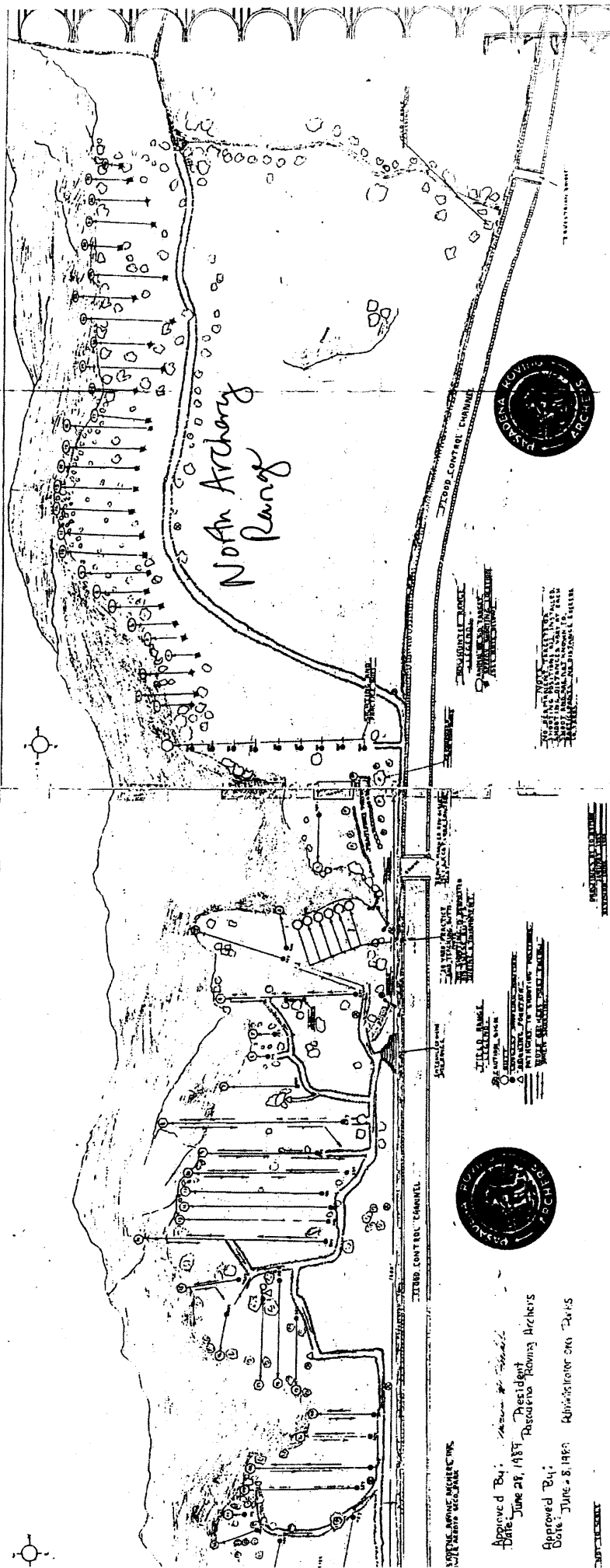

BACKGROUND

Staff recently met with the Pasadena Roving Archers to discuss their location and usage of the Lower Arroyo Seco. The Pasadena Roving Archers have agreed to remove the bales and targets from the north range and use these only during tournaments (approximately 4 - 6 times per year); this would mean that the shooting lanes would not need to be as broad and the northern range would have a more natural appearance.

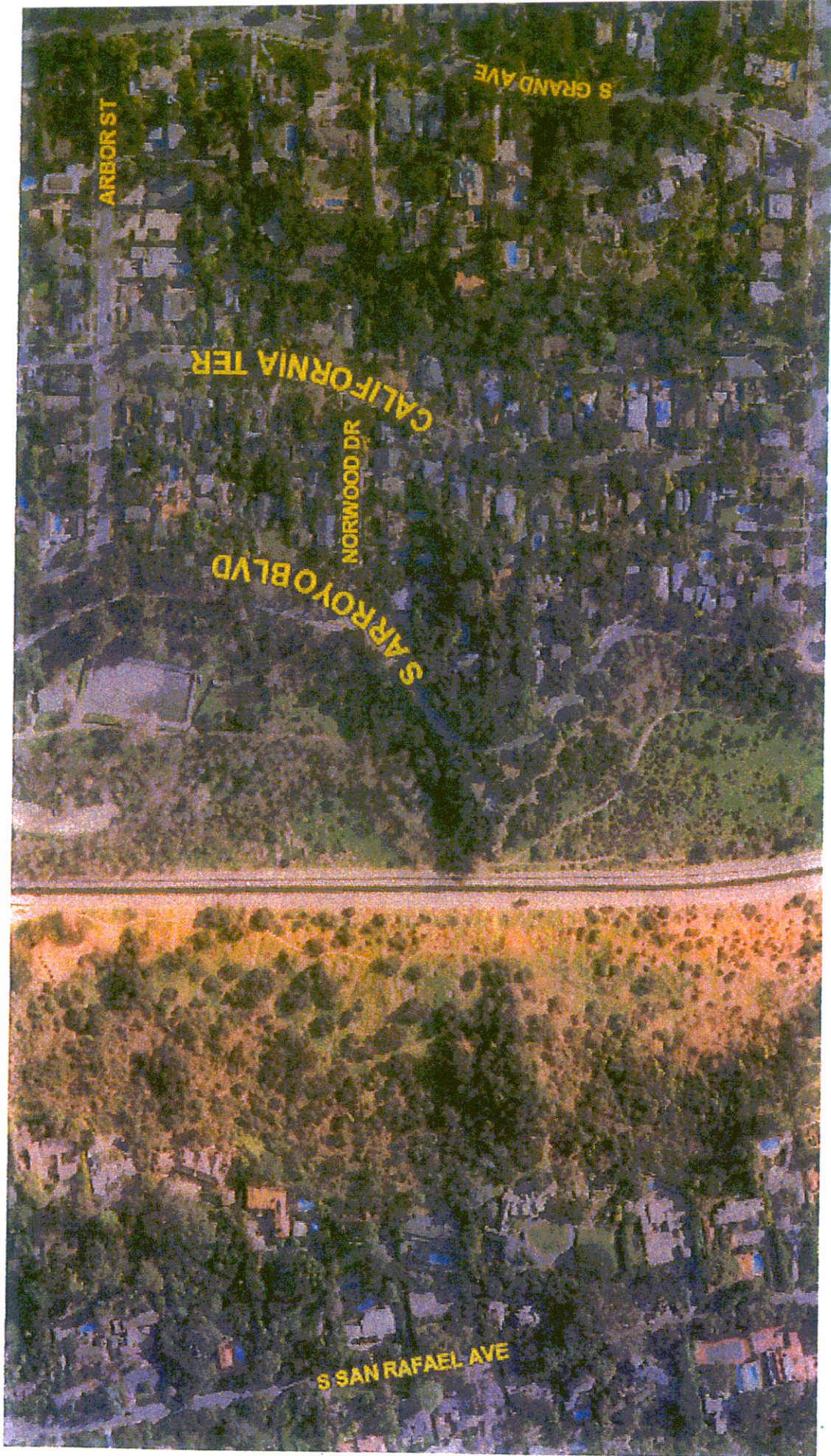
