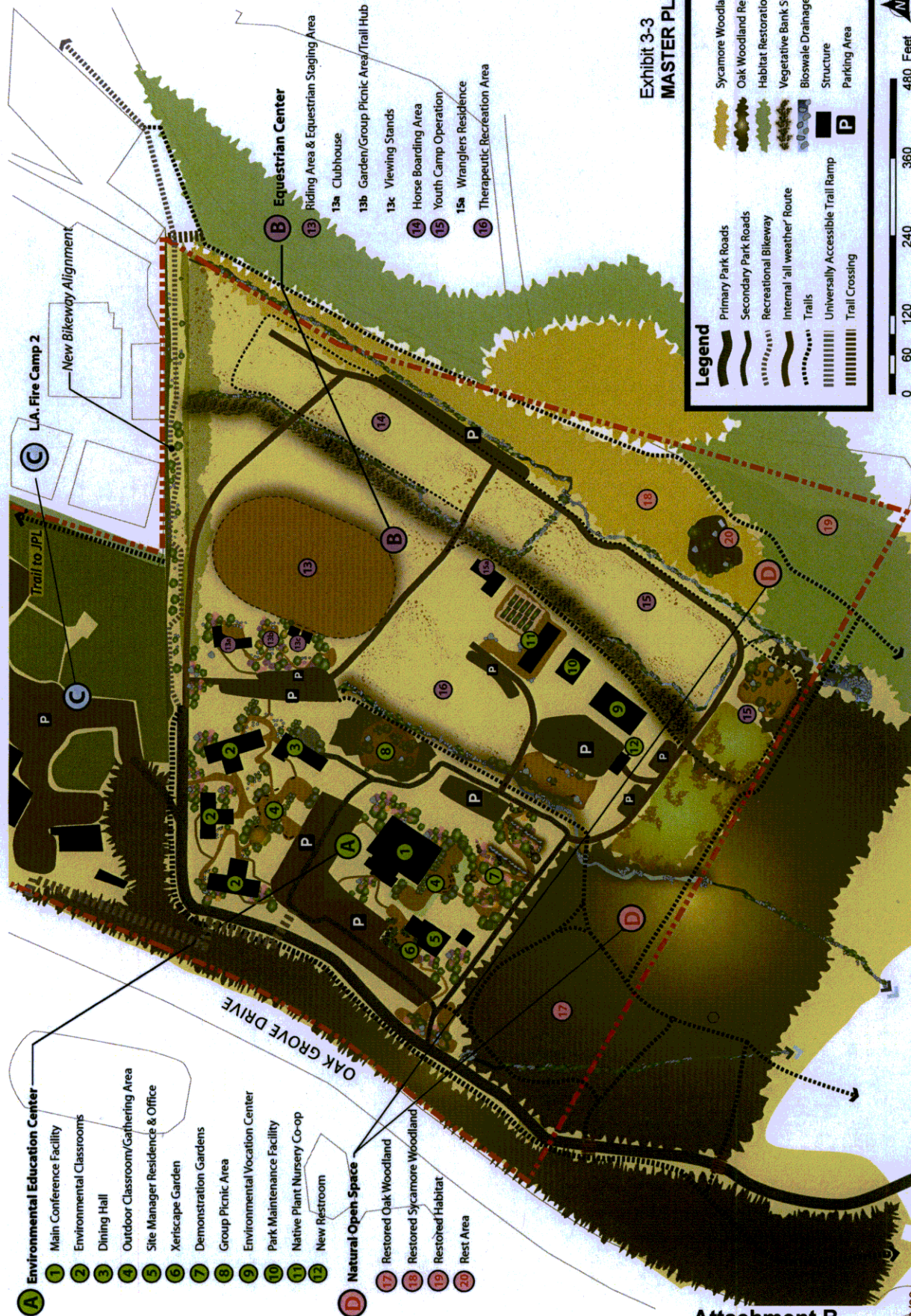


Exhibit 3-3

RE: MACH1 - Therapeutic Horseback Riding Program

The Department of Public Works recently completed a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for a therapeutic horseback riding program and is pleased to announce Move A Child Higher, Inc. (MACH1) has been selected as the most qualified applicant.

This program will be part of the Pasadena Equestrian Center in Hahamongna Watershed Park. MACH1's future location will be south of the large arena, as described in the Hahamongna Watershed Park Master Plan Addendum.

The City issued twenty-one RFQ packets directly to potential operators who met the established minimum criteria. In addition, the City published the RFQ online on the City's Bid Opportunities list. Two of the potential operators attended a mandatory pre-proposal meeting and finally, the City received a proposal from MACH1.

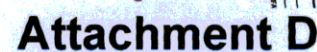
MACH1 is a Pasadena-based organization that has operated a successful therapeutic horseback riding program in Pasadena since 1996. MACH1 is certified as a Premier Accredited Center of Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship International and are a 501c3 non-profit organization. MACH1's current program is located in northern portion of the Hahamongna Watershed Park equestrian area.

MACH1 is currently preparing its Conditional Use Permit application. Staff is working with MACH1 to develop a lease agreement for the program location and an operating agreement to define the program specifics. The Department of Public Works will bring these items to City Council for consideration upon completion.

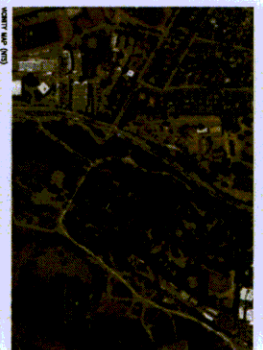
