Section 1. In conformance with Section 904 of the Charter of the City of Pasadena, the recommended FY 2017 – 2021 Capital Improvement Program Budget, as submitted by the City Manager, amended by the Finance Committee and reviewed by the City Council, is approved and adopted, and the City Clerk is directed to file a certified copy thereof in the Office of City Clerk and to file another copy, likewise certified, with the Director of Finance. The Capital Improvement Program for FY 2017 - 2021 is shown on Exhibit B which is attached hereto and made part hereof.

Section 2. The specific sums of money set forth opposite the names of funds, activities and projects as shown on Exhibit B are appropriated to these funds, activities and projects in order to carry out the approved Capital Improvement Program for FY 2017 – 2021 and shall go into effect immediately.
